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1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria". If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would also be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.

2. Experience Criteria: In respect of the filter applied for experience criteria, the Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through reseller(s)} should have regularly, manufactured and supplied same or similar Category Products to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company for number of Financial years as indicated above in the bid document before the bid opening date. 3. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

5. Past Performance: The Bidder or its OEM {themselves or through re-seller(s)} should have supplied same or similar Category Products for 80% of bid quantity, in at least one of the last three Financial years before the bid opening date to any Central / State Govt Organization / PSU / Public Listed Company. Copies of relevant contracts (proving supply of cumulative order quantity in any one financial year) to be submitted along with bid in support of quantity supplied in the relevant Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category related to primary product having highest bid value should meet this criterion.

1. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

2.GUARANTEEE: The performance of the total crane and the components/ sub-assemblies/ bought-out items shall be guaranteed for a minimum period of twelve months from the date of performance acceptance at BHEL works or 18 months from the date of supply whichever is earlier.

3.PRE-DESPATCH INSPECTION: Schedule of stage inspection as per technical specification 10.0 to be strictly adhered to, prior to despatch from the supplier's works.

4. Operation and Instruction manuals (O&M manuals): Each crane shall be provided with three copies of Erection, Operation and maintenance manual as per technical specification Sl. No. 12.0

5.COMMISSIONING: Erection and commissioning of the crane to be done by the supplier as per Technical specification Sl. No. 11.1 & 11.2

6. DETAILS ON CAPACITY /SUPPLY AND E&C- PERFORMANCE OF THE VENDOR: The following details shall be filled by the vendor in the Annexure III (attached with this tender) and submitted along with Technical Bid (Part-I) :

(a) Capacity details in Part (A) are about the Manufacturing Capacity (Major Machine: category-wise & number-wise), No. of Machines supplied during last 5 years, Outstanding Order Book position, Liquidation Plan of all machines including BHEL machines under consideration for ordering. Wherever possible, efforts are to be made to contact some of the references of past supplies given.

(b) The Performance details of supplies to BHEL will be sought in Part (B) for the POs placed by BHEL which can be verified; hence submission of these information by vendors is mandatory. BHEL will reserve the right to reject the offer, if past performance of the bidder is evaluated to be unsatisfactory and / or false information is given by the bidder.

The actual / likely Supply and E&C period vis-à-vis scheduled Supply and E&C period (delay for reasons attributable to vendor only to be considered) shall be considered for all the machines against the POs placed by BHEL during last 5 years (limited to 5 latest executed POs) and all POs overdue for Supply and/or E&C.

For purpose of calculation of Delivery Index in case of overdue POs, the delay period for Supply and/or E&C will be reckoned from the date of bid opening of the tender under evaluation. In case of two-part bid, part-I (i.e Techno-Commercial Bid) shall be considered as date of bid opening. Early Supply and/or E&C vis-à-vis scheduled dates will not be entitled for any consideration for calculation of Delivery Index. Delay in E&C shall be applicable only in such cases where E&C period has been mentioned in the PO.

In case a PO includes more than one machine, then all the machines of the PO shall be considered for calculation of Delivery Index.

If DELIVERY INDEX of any bidder is = 0.20, then the particular offer shall become liable for rejection.

However, BHEL reserves the right to accept offers with DELIVERY INDEX = 0.20 against justified reasons.

7. All the documents required as in Bid Specific Additional Scope of Work (PQC / Performance certificate, Technical Specification, Self declaration format for local content), capacity details shall be filled , signed

and affixed with company stamp shall be attached during submission of Bid document.

2. **Bidder financial standing:** The bidder should not be under liquidation, court receivership or similar proceedings, should not be bankrupt. Bidder to upload undertaking to this effect with bid.
3. Bidders are advised to check applicable GST on their own before quoting. Buyer will not take any responsibility in this regards. GST reimbursement will be as per actuals or as per applicable rates (whichever is lower), subject to the maximum of quoted GST %.
4. While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screenshot of GST portal confirming payment of GST.
5. Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:
 - a. Copy of PAN Card.
 - b. Copy of GSTIN.
 - c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
 - d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.
6. **End User Certificate:** Wherever Bidders are insisting for End User Certificate from the Buyer, same shall be provided in Buyer's standard format only.
7. Data Sheet of the product(s) offered in the bid, are to be uploaded along with the bid documents. Buyers can match and verify the Data Sheet with the product specifications offered. In case of any unexplained mismatch of technical parameters, the bid is liable for rejection.
8. For hazardous chemical/item, all precautionary measure as per regulation from the point of transportation/ handling/ storage/ safety/ health/ environment to be undertaken/ specified before dispatch. During dispatch, proper symbol for the hazard/ MSDS/ Batch No./ date of manufacturing/ Gross Weight/ Net Weight/ shelf Life etc are to be written/ printed/ pasted on the body of the packing.
9. Installation, Commissioning, Testing, Configuration, Training (if any - which ever is applicable as per scope of supply) is to be carried out by OEM / OEM Certified resource or OEM authorised Reseller.
10. Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.
11. **Upload Manufacturer authorization:** Wherever Authorised Distributors are submitting the bid, Manufacturers Authorisation Form (MAF)/Certificate with OEM details such as name, designation, address, e-mail Id and Phone No. required to be furnished along with the bid.

Bidder to indicate bid number and name of bidding entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer along with bid.
13. Bidders can also submit the EMD with Account Payee Demand Draft in favour of BHEL Trichy payable at Trichy.
Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the DD along with bid and has to ensure delivery of hardcopy to the Buyer within 5 days of Bid End date / Bid Opening date.
14. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. 15. Purchase Preference linked with Local Content (PP-LC) Policy:

The bid clause regarding "Preference to Make In India products" stands modified in this bid and shall be governed by the PPLC Policy No. FP-20013/2/2017-FP-PNG dated 17.11.2020 issued by MoP&NG as amended up to date. Accordingly, bidders with Local Content less than or equal to 20% will be treated as "Non Local Supplier". The prescribed LC shall be applicable on the date of Bid opening. Sanctions on the bidders for false / wrong declaration or not fulfilling the Local Content requirement shall be as per the

PPLC policy. Further following additional provisions are added in the certification and verification of local content provision of the Preference to Make in India clause:

- i. In case of foreign bidder, certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of their own office or subsidiary in India giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable. In case office or subsidiary in India does not exist or Indian office/subsidiary is not required to appoint statutory auditor or cost auditor, certificate from practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant giving the percentage of local content is also acceptable.
 - ii. Along with Each Invoice: The local content certificate (issued by statutory auditor on behalf of procuring company) shall be submitted along with each invoice raised. However, the % of local content may vary with each invoice while maintaining the overall % of local content for the total work/purchase of the pro-rata local content requirement. In case, it is not satisfied cumulatively in the invoices raised up to that stage, the supplier shall indicate how the local content requirement would be met in the subsequent stages.
 - iii. The bidder shall submit an undertaking from the authorized signatory of bidder having the Power of Attorney along with the bid stating the bidder meets the mandatory minimum LC requirement and such undertaking shall become a part of the contract.
