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1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will

be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

1) INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS

- a) Bidder shall submit Categorical Confirmation of Pre-Qualification Criteria, Special Terms and Conditions and TDC (Technical Delivery Conditions). Vendor shall comply to all the additional clauses mentioned in GeM Bid Document. The offers of those Vendors who do not comply with all the Clauses in total are likely to be rejected. Documents submitted with the offer shall be signed and stamped on each page by authorised representative of the vendor.
- b) Bidder shall follow GeM general terms and conditions(<https://gem.gov.in/page/detail/34>) and submit the offer.
- c) All the terms and conditions mentioned in Special terms and conditions, PQC (Pre-qualification Criteria) & TDC (Technical Delivery Conditions) shall supersede any other similar terms quoted elsewhere.
- d) QUOTED PRICE: - Bidder shall quote the Price inclusive of Freight, P&F, Transit Insurance, Inspection charges (if applicable), GST, GeM transaction charges after order placement and any other taxes.

3) TDC (TECHNICAL DELIVERY CONDITIONS): - As per TDC - WE9018B3 REV No.02 dated: 10-12-2021

4) SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS:

- 1) Brand Name (to be specified)' flux coated stick electrodes of Low Alloy steel for shielded metal arc welding conforming to ASME SEC.II Part C 2019 SFA 5.5 E9018B3 specification and meeting technical delivery conditions.
- 2) **QUALITY PLAN:** Vendor' has to submit the quality plan along with technical offer.
- 3) **EVALUATION:** - Tender shall be evaluated on package wise basis.
- 4) **GUARANTEE CERTIFICATE:** Vendor should guarantee the material against all design and manufacturing defects and for performance for a period of 18 months from the date of last dispatch or 12 months from the date of commissioning whichever is earlier. If any defect is noticed during the above period, the same shall be rectified / replaced free of cost on FOR delivery location within a period of 2 weeks.
- 5) The vendor must be in a position to replace materials if it is found defective during shop use within a period of 2 weeks of reporting within the guarantee period.
- 6) The supplied material will be tested for performance before accepting/ clearance of the materials.
- 7) **RISK PURCHASE CLAUSE:** The delivery period stated shall be realistic and shall be strictly adhered to. If the deliveries are not maintained and if on the account, this company is forced to buy the materials elsewhere to avoid any loss or damage that the company may sustain thereby the purchaser is entitled to procure the material at the risk and cost of the seller, which shall be recovered from them out of due of this PO / Contract, any other PO / Contract with BHEL and balance amount if any shall be required to be

deposited by the vendor.

8) All Other clauses shall be as per GeM General terms and conditions.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specification and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null and void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents / clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection / grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
