- 1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchas preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local contents shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountar a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible bid. Non Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro at small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.
- 2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry o Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bic wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid fo supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Part Quantity Bidding

Buyer has allowed part quantity bidding, bidders can offer maximum quantity that they can deliver keeping in mind their capacity and delivery period requirements. The offer quantity has to be more than minimum bid quantity as specified by the Buyer in the bid. Offers with quantity less than Minimum are liable to be rejected. It may however b noted that there is no guarantee that full offer quantity will be ordered by the buyer. Quantity to be ordered by the buyer will depend on various factors including the Ranking of the bidder, Offered quantity, Splitting criteria indicated the buyer in the bid and the requirement of the buyer to have multiple sources of supply for ensuring supply chain ϵ Sellers would be notified about likely order quantity or range of possible order quantity at the time of price match request made by the buyer. ward of contract will be subject to acceptance of price match request along with min / n offer quantity as decided by the Buyer.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has

relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which wo be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices receiv in Bid / RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 2! percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracter rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Generic

Bidder shall submit the following documents along with their bid for Vendor Code Creation:

- a. Copy of PAN Card.
- b. Copy of GSTIN.
- c. Copy of Cancelled Cheque.
- d. Copy of EFT Mandate duly certified by Bank.

Risk Purchase:

In case of abnormal delays (beyond the maximum late delivery period as per LD clause supplies / defective supplies or non-fulfilment of any other terms and conditions give Purchase Order, BHEL may cancel the Purchase Order in full or part thereof, and may make the purchase of such material from elsewhere / alternative source at the risk cost of the supplier. BHEL will take all reasonable steps to get the material from alterr source at optimum cost. If bidder does not agree to the above Risk Purchase Clause, B reserves the right to reject the offer. In case for compelling reasons BHEL accepts the c without acceptance of this clause by the bidder and in the eventuality of Risk Purchappropriate action will be taken as per BHEL extant rules. This will be without prejudicany other right of BHEL under the contract or under General Law.

Action against Bidders / vendor / supplier / contractor in case of default:

In order to protect the commercial interests of BHEL, BHEL shall take action aga suppliers / contractors by way of suspension of business dealings, who either fai perform or are in default without any reasonable cause, cause loss of business/ mor reputation, indulge in malpractices, cheating, bribery, fraud or any other misconduc formation of cartels so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price etc.

Suspension of Business Dealings could be in the form of "Hold" or "Banning" a supp contractor or a bidder and shall be as per "Guidelines for Suspension of Business Deali with Suppliers/ Contractors" available at BHEL's website "https://www.bhel.com/guidelinesuspension-business-dealings-supplierscontractors"

4. Certificates

Bidder's offer is liable to be rejected if they don't upload any of the certificates / documents sought in the Bid document, ATC and Corrigendum if any.

5. Generic

Supplier shall ensure that the Invoice is raised in the name of Consignee with GSTIN of Consignee only.

6. Generic

While generating invoice in GeM portal, the seller must upload scanned copy of GST invoice and the screensh GST portal confirming payment of GST.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority Buyer Organization. Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity/restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and/or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause incorporated by the Buyer such as demanding Tender Sample, incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to make in India Policy, mandating any Brand names or Foreign Certification, changing the default time period for Acceptance of material or payment timeline governed by OM of Department of Expenditure shall be null a void and would not be considered part of bid. Further any reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses shall also be null and void. If any seller has any objection/grievance agains these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller with days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations. Also, GeM does not permit collection of Tender fee / Auction fee case of Bids / Forward Auction as the case may be. Any stipulation by the Buyer seeking payment of Tender Fee / Auction fee through ATC clauses would be treated as null and void.

This Bid is also governed by the General Terms and Conditions

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which share border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority. While participating in bid, Bidder has to undertake complication and any false declaration and non-compliance of this would be a ground for immediate termination of the contract and further legal action in accordance with the laws.
