1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .In case Buyer has selected Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises clause in the bid, the same will get precedence over this clause.

2. Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer)of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 100%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst first 50% of the technically qualified bidders arranged in the

order of prices from lowest to highest. Number of sellers eligible for participating in RA would be rounded off to next higher integer value if number of technically qualified bidders is odd (e.g. if 7 bids are technically qualified, then RA will be conducted amongst L-1 to L-4). In case number of technically qualified bidders are 2 or 3, RA will be between all without any elimination. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, then minimum N sellers would be taken to RA round. In case Primary products of only one OEM are left in contention for participation in RA based on lowest 50% bidders qualifying for RA, the number of sellers qualifying for RA would be increased to get at least products of one more OEM (directly participated or through its reseller) if available. Further, if bid(s) of any seller(s) eligible for MSE preference is / are coming within price band of 15% of Non MSE L-1 or if bid of any seller(s) eligible for Make in India preference is / are coming within price band of 20% of non MII L-1, then such MSE / Make in India seller shall also be allowed to participate in the RA process.

1. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

INSTRUCTIONS TO BIDDERS: -

- 1) Bidder shall submit Categorical Confirmation of PQC, Technical Specifications and Special Terms and Conditions. Bidder shall comply to all the additional clauses mentioned in GeM Bid Document. The offers of those bidders who do not comply with all the Clauses in total are likely to be rejected. Documents submitted with the offer shall be signed and stamped on each page by authorised representative of the vendor.
- 2) Pre- qualification criteria: The supplier need to meet all the requirements mentioned in Pre-Qualification Criteria and submit all the supporting documents along with technical bid. Offers without supporting documents in line with requirement shall not be considered for scrutiny. Further evaluation shall be done based on Pre-Qualification Criteria.
- 3) Bidder shall follow GeM general term and conditions and submit the offer. <https://gem.gov.in/page/detail/34>.
- 4) All the terms and conditions mentioned in PQC, Technical Specifications and Special terms and conditions shall supersede any other similar terms quoted elsewhere.
- 5) QUOTED PRICE: - Bidder shall quote the Price inclusive of Freight, P&F, Transit Insurance, Installation, Commissioning, Training, GST, GeM transaction charges and other any charges as per GeM rules.

SPECIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS

A. PAYMENT TERMS: -

- a) **For Supply of materials:** 80% of total order value shall be made (as stipulated in below table) from the date of receipt and acceptance of all the materials at BHEL, HPVP, Stores.
- b) **For Installation, Commissioning and Prove out of CNC Vertical Milling machine:** 20% of total order value shall be made (as stipulated in below table) from the date of completion of Installation, commissioning and Prove out of CNC Vertical Milling machine against submission of invoice with certification from BHEL HPVP regarding completion of work.

- B. DELIVERY PERIOD:** Delivery period for execution of the order shall be 6 weeks (42 days). Detailed break up of delivery for each activity is as follows:

For supply of all the materials -

The acceptable Delivery period shall be within 4 weeks (28 Days) from the date of PO

to date of receipt of material at BHEL-HPVP stores.

For Installation, Commissioning and Prove out of the CNC Vertical Milling Machine -

The acceptable execution period shall be within 2 weeks (14 Days) from the date of site readiness communication to the date of completion certificate/MOM from BHEL HPVP.

C. PERFORMANCE BANK GUARANTEE:

- a) In the event of an order, Vendor shall furnish Performance Bank Guarantee from any of our consortium banks ((List of consortium banks and PBG Format will be provided after placement of order).
- b) Performance Bank Guarantee shall be submitted for 10% of order value along with invoice for last dispatch valid till end of guarantee period with a claim period of 12 months thereafter.
- c) Vendor to instruct their PBG issuing bank to send the Original Performance Bank Guarantee directly to BHEL-HPVP-Visakhapatnam.

D. GUARANTEE TERMS: Vendor should guarantee the material against all design and manufacturing defects and for performance for a period of 18 months from the date of last dispatch or 12 months from the date of commissioning whichever is earlier. If any defect is noticed during the above period, the same shall be rectified / replaced free of cost on FOR, BHEL, HPVP, Visakhapatnam basis within a reasonable time.

E. LINKING UP OF OLD ISSUES: In case if bidder has any outstanding problems with earlier supplies, bidder should not linkup against this enquiry or PO at later stages.

F. CONFLICT OF INTEREST AMONG BIDDERS / AGENTS:

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with others bidders. Such conflict of Interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of procuring Entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) They have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b) They receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
- c) They have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
- d) They have relationship with each other, directly or through common third Parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
- e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-assembly/Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or
- f) In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their Principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorize only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:
 - 1) The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
 - 2) Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal;

or

- g) A bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the design or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the bid; or

In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing units, or more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit should quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders must proactively declare such sister/ common business/ management units in same/ similar line of business.”

G. All Other clauses shall be as per GeM General terms and conditions.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.

In terms of GeM GTC clause 26 regarding Restrictions on procurement from a bidder of a country which shares a land border with India, any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
