1. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. - 3.9 In case of delay in submission of above-mentioned documents on the date of dispatch, BHEL may incur penalty/ interest for not adhering to Invoicing Rules under GST Law. The same will be liable to be recovered from successful bidder, in case such delay is not attributable to BHEL.
- 3.10 In case of raising any Supplementary Tax Invoice (Debit / Credit Note), suc cessful bidder shall issue the same containing all the details as referred to in Se ction 34 read with Section 31 of GST Act & Rules referred there under.

- II. Contractor shall report to BHEL in writing any damages to material duri ng transit and on receipt. The above report shall be as prescribed by BHEL site management. Any consequential loss arising out of non-compliance of this stipulation will be borne by contractor.
- III. For lodging/ processing of insurance claim the contractor will submit ne cessary documents. BHEL will reserve the right to recover the loss from th e contractor as detailed below in case the damage/loss is due to negligenc e/ carelessness on the part of the contractor. 6. Purchase Preference (Centre)

Purchase preference to Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs): Purchase preference will be given to MSEs as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods.
