Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. 3. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

4. Short Duration Bid has been published by the Buyer with the approval of the Competent authority due to Emergency procurement of critical products/services.

1. STC (Special Terms Condition) for the Product Category "Unmanned Aerial Vehicle & Payload System for Surveillance"

A. The Following clarification may be applicable in case of type certificate requirements

1. Type Certificate: The possession of the Type Certificate by manufacturer/ OEM of the Products sold under the category is a Statutory requirement as per Drone rules 2021. Exemption if any Under Drone Rules 2021 may be seen.

2. Type Certificate (TC) scope limited to Civilian Drone: Type Certificate applies only to the Unmanned aircraft systems (UAS) / Unmanned aircraft Vehicle (UAV) used for Civilian Purpose.

3. Payload details to be verified From Type Certificate: The details of payload/ use case should be verified by the buyer from the relevant section of the Type Certificate.

B. The following clarifications shall be applicable for the parameters which are optional accessories/features kinds and enabled **Multi-Select** for seller.

1. Against the optional accessories/features kind of parameters which are multi-select for seller, buyer may

stipulate/select only required accessories/features at the time of creation of bid and same required accessories/features shall be verified before accepting of the stores. 2.1 Bidder's quoted/ accepted rates/ price shall be inclusive of all taxes including GST, Charges, Royalties, any State or Central Levy and other taxes for materials if any obtained for the work and for execution of the contract.

Any increase of above at any stage during execution of contract, including extension of the contract, shall have to be borne by successful bidder contractor. However, any increase of GST subsequent to due date of offer submission as per NIT & TCN, by statutory authority during contract period (including extension, if the same is not attributable to you), shall be reimbursed by BHEL on production of relevant supporting document to the satisfaction of BHEL.

2.8 Successful bidder to intimate immediately on the day of removal of goods (in case of any supply of goods) to BHEL along with all relevant details and send a scanned copy of Tax Invoice to BHEL through following communication mode for enabling BHEL to meet its GST related compliances.

Specific details of above shall be intimated to successful bidder by BHEL at appropriate juncture.

2.9 In case of delay in submission of above-mentioned documents on the date of dispatch, BHEL may incur penalty/ interest for not adhering to Invoicing Rules under GST Law. The same will be liable to be recovered from successful bidder, in case such delay is not attributable to BHEL.
