^{1.} If the bidder is a Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria,

the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer. 2. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore):Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. Description:

Supply of Reciprocating Air Compressor and its down stream systems, spare parts and AMC of compressor

1) Pre-Qualification Criteria:

1a) Prior Experience:

Bidder to submit at least one PO copy/Tax invoice/Completion certificate for Reciprocating air -compressor with minimum capacity of 200cfm or higher within last 5 years from the date of enquiry.

1b) Relaxation of Norms for Startups:

The condition of Prior Turnover and prior experience is relaxed for all startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR,2005 and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms for startups issued from time to time.

2) Payment term:

100% Basic payment shall be made within the stipulated days as mentioned below from the date of completion of entire scope (i.e supply & commissioning) at BHEL Energy system facility, Nacharam, Hyderabad-500076 and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) by supplier.

Type of bidder:

- A. For Micro & Small enterprises (MSEs) payment will be made within 45 days
- B. For Medium Enterprises will be made within 60 days
- C. Non MSMEs will be made within 90 days

However, GST Portion of Invoice shall be released only upon:

- i) Vendor declaring the Invoice in their GSTR-1.
- ii) Receipt of Goods and Tax Invoice by BHEL.
- iii) Confirmation of Payment of GST thereon by vendor on GSTN.

- 3) AMC Payment Terms: "Half yearly basis".
 - Payment will be made within 30 days after completion of each period on submission of Invoic e for that period, duly certified by BHEL engineer on satisfactory completion of service. GST will be reimbursed only after submission of proof of payment of GST to government.
- **4) Compliance on restrictions under Rule 144 (XI) of the GFR:** Submit the Annexure A which is attached in ATC document.
- **5) Technical Specification:** Bidder shall submit compliance on attached BHEL Technical specification (Annexure-1) uploaded in Buyer Specification Document
- **Terms of Delivery:** Shall be F.O.R BHEL Energy systems facility, C/o IICT pilot plant chemic al complex, Road no 7, Nacharam Industrial Area, Nacharam, Hyderabad 500076.
- 7) Vendor has to submit this GeM bid document duly signed and stamped on all pages. By sub mitting signed GeM bid document it affirms that vendor has accepted to all the terms and conditions mentioned in this bid such as Payment terms, delivery period, PBG etc.

- 9) Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination: In case of breach of contract, wherever t he value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL again st the said contract is at least 10% of the contract value, the same be encashed. In case the v alue of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the contract or, ret ention amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies be pursued. Further, levy of liquidated dam ages, debarment, termination, de scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisio ns of the contract.
- 10) Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):

PBG of 10% of (supply & commissioning value + Spares value) is to be submitted by the succ essful vendor and shall be kept valid up to guarantee period. Expiry of claim period may be k ept 3-6 months after validity date. PBG shall be from one of the Consortium banks of BHEL or from a reputed bank and confirmed by any Consortium bank of BHEL. The offers of the suppli ers not accepting to this clause will be rejected.

11) Interest of delayed submission of PBG: Bidder has to submit performance bank guaran tee (PBG) with-in 15 days date of completion of Commissioning.

In case of delay in submission of PBG, enhanced performance security which would include in terest (Repo rate \pm 4%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if p erformance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of p erformance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/contract, from the bill s along with due interest.

12) Security deposit for AMC Contract:

The total amount of Security Deposit should not be less than five percent (5%) of the AMC contract value which shall be submitted by Successful bidder before start of AMC Contract.
