#### 1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

Pre-Qualification Criteria:

- 1.1 Technical: Pre-Qualification criteria (Technical) for this enquiry is given in Annexure-B (available along with Specification document).

- 1.4 Bidder must not be admitted under Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process or Liquidation as on date, by NCLT or any adjudicating authority/authorities, and shall submit undertaking (Annexure-4) to this effect

Explanatory Notes for the PQR:

- i. 'Supplied' in PQR 1.1 means, bidder should have delivered the Item/material. Bidder shall submit the re levant documents against the above PQRs inclusive of Purchase order (wherein PO no., date, etc. is legible) along with proof of supply (i.e. Completion Certificate/ Copy of Invoices / LR Copies/ Store Receipt Vouche rs/ Payment Advice etc.) in the respective attachments in their offer in support of PQR. - v. Credentials furnished by the bidder against "PRE-QUALIFYING CRITERIA" shall be verified from the issuin g authority for its authenticity. In case, any credential (s) is/are found to be spurious, offer of the bidder is I iable to be rejected. BHEL reserves the right to initiate any further action as per extant guidelines for Susp ension of Business Dealings as applicable in BHEL.
- vi. In case of Two packet bidding System, Price Bids of only those bidders shall be opened who stand qualified after compliance of PQR 1.1 to 1.5 2.

#### SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

Supply of items/material shall be as per technical Specifications indicated in the enquiry. Technical Specific ation requirements are available in Specification document for the item(s). Unloading of materials at Desti nation / Site shall be in BHEL's scope. 3.

### TAXES & DUTIES:

4.1 The Supplier/Vendor shall pay all (save the specific exclusions as enumerated in this clause) taxes, fee s, license, charges, deposits, duties, tools, royalty, commissions, other charges, etc. which may be levied o n the input goods & services consumed and output goods & services delivered in course of his operations in executing the contract. In case BHEL is forced to pay any of such taxes/duties, BHEL shall have the right to recover the same from his bills or otherwise as deemed fit along with the applicable overheads @5% and interest on the total value (i. e. amount paid by BHEL + overhead)

However, provisions regarding GST on output supply (goods/service) and TDS/TCS as per Income Tax Act s hall be as per following clauses.

- 4.2 GST (Goods and Services Tax)
- 4.2.1 Rate quoted in GeM portal should be on FOR destination basis inclusive of all taxes, P&F, freight etc. Reimbursement of GST is subject to compliance of following terms and conditions. BHEL shall have the right to deny payment of GST and to recover any loss to BHEL on account of tax, interest, penalty etc. for noncompliance of any of the following condition.
- 4.2.2 The admissibility of GST, taxes and duties referred in this chapter or elsewhere in the contract shall be limited to direct transactions between BHEL & its Supplier/Vendor. BHEL shall not consider GST on any t ransaction other than the direct transaction between BHEL & its Supplier/Vendor.
- 4.2.3 Supplier/Vendor shall obtain prior written consent of BHEL before billing the amount towards such ta xes. Where the GST laws permit more than one option or methodology for discharging the liability of tax/le vy/duty, BHEL shall have the right to adopt the appropriate one considering the amount of tax liability on B HEL/Client as well as procedural simplicity with regard to assessment of the liability. The option chosen by BHEL shall be binding on the Contractor for discharging the obligation of BHEL in respect of the tax liability to the Supplier/Vendor.
- 4.2.4 Supplier/Vendor has to submit GST registration certificate of the concerned state. Supplier/Vendor also needs to ensure that the submitted GST registration certificate should be in active status during the entire contract period.
- 4.2.5 Supplier/Vendor has to issue Invoice/Debit Note/Credit Note indicating HSN/SAC code, Description, V alue, Rate, applicable tax and other particulars in compliance with the provisions of relevant GST Act and R ules made thereunder.
- 4.2.6 Supplier/Vendor has to submit GST compliant invoice within the due date of invoice as per GST Law. I

n case of delay, BHEL reserves the right of denial of GST payment if there occurs any hardship to BHEL in c laiming the input thereof. In case of goods, Supplier/Vendor has to provide scan copy of invoice & GR/LR/R R to BHEL before movement of goods starts to enable BHEL to meet its GST related compliances. Special c are should be taken in case of month end transactions.

- 4.2.7 Supplier/Vendor has to ensure that invoice in respect of such services which have been provided/completed on or before end of the month should not bear the date later than last working day of the month in which services are performed.
- 4.2.8 Subject to other provisions of the contract, GST amount claimed in the invoice shall be released on f ulfilment of all the following conditions by the Supplier/Vendor: -
- a) Supply of goods and/or services have been received by BHEL.
- b) Original Tax Invoice has been submitted to BHEL.
- c) Supplier/Vendor has submitted all the documents required for processing of bill as per contract/ purchas e order/ work order.
- d) In cases where e-invoicing provision is applicable, Supplier/Vendor is required to submit invoice in comp liance with e-invoicing provisions of GST Act and Rules made thereunder.
- e) Supplier/Vendor has filed all the relevant GST return (e.g. GSTR-1, GSTR-3B, etc.) pertaining to the invoice submitted and submit the proof of such return along with immediate subsequent invoice. In case of final invoice/ bill, contractor has to submit proof of such return within fifteen days from the due date of relevant return.
- f) Respective invoice has appeared in BHEL's GSTR 2A for the month corresponding to the month of invoice and in GSTR-2B of the month in which such invoices has been reported by the contractor along with status of ITC availability as "YES" in GSTR-2B. Alternatively, BG of appropriate value may be furnished which shall be valid at least one month beyond the due date of confirmation of relevant payment of GST on GST N portal or sufficient security is available to adjust the financial impact in case of any default by the Suppli er/Vendor.
- g) Supplier/Vendor has to submit an undertaking confirming the payment of all due GST

in respect of invoices pertaining to BHEL.

- 4.2.9 Any financial loss arises to BHEL on account of failure or delay in submission of any document as per contract/purchase order/work order at the time of submission of Tax invoice to BHEL, shall be deducted fro m Supplier/Vendor's bill or otherwise as deemed fit.
- 4.2.10 TDS as applicable under GST law shall be deducted from Supplier/Vendor's bill.
- 4.2.11 Supplier/Vendor shall comply with the provisions of e-way bill wherever applicable. Further whereve r provisions of GST Act permits, all the e-way bills, road permits etc. required for transportation of goods n eeds to be arranged by the contractor.
- 4.2.12 Supplier/Vendor shall be solely responsible for discharging his GST liability according to the provisions of GST Law and BHEL will not entertain any claim of GST/interest/penalty or any other liability on account of failure of Supplier/Vendor in complying the provisions of GST Law or discharging the GST liability in a manner laid down thereunder.
- 4.2.13 In case declaration of any invoice is delayed by the vendor in his GST return or any invoice is subse quently amended/altered/deleted on GSTN portal which results in any adverse financial implication on BHE L, the financial impact thereof including interest/penalty shall be recovered from the Supplier/Vendor's due payment.
- 4.2.14 Any denial of input credit to BHEL or arising of any tax liability on BHEL due to noncompliance of GS T Law by the Supplier/Vendor in any manner, will be recovered along with liability on account of interest a nd penalty (if any) from the payments due to the Supplier/Vendor.
- 4.2.15 In the event of any ambiguity in GST law with respect to availability of input credit of GST charged on the invoice raised by the contractor or with respect to any other matter having impact on BHEL, BHEL's decision shall be final and binding on the Supplier/Vendor.
- 4.2.16 Variation in Taxes & Duties:

Any upward variation in GST shall be considered for reimbursement provided supply of goods and services are made within schedule date stipulated in the contract or approved extended schedule for the reason so lely attributable to BHEL. However downward variation shall be subject to adjustment as per actual GST ap plicability.

In case the Government imposes any new levy/tax on the output service/goods after price bid opening, the same shall be reimbursed by BHEL at actual. The reimbursement under this clause is restricted to the dire ct transaction between BHEL and its Supplier/Vendor only and within the contractual delivery period only.

In case any new tax/levy/duty etc. becomes applicable after the date of Bidder's offer but before opening of the price Bid, the Bidder/ Supplier/Vendor must convey its impact on his price duly substantiated by docu mentary evidence in support of the same before opening of price bid. Claim for any such impact after opening the price bid will not be considered by BHEL for reimbursement of tax or reassessment of offer.

#### INSPECTION / INSPECTION & TESTING AT SUPPLIERS WORKS:

Inspection and testing requirements are to be carried out as per the specification standard and BHEL Tech nical specifications in the enquiry.

BHEL reserves the right to inspect the material during manufacturing and also to get tested the material u nder dispatch from third party. The test results of third party test shall be final and binding on the Supplier /Vendor.

BHEL will reserve the right to inspect/test the material during/after manufacturing at suppliers' works, and/ or at BHEL Site. In case of rejection at any stage, Supplier/Vendor shall be liable to replace the materials at his own cost. 7.

### **DELIVERY**:

Materials are to be supplied within the delivery period indicated in GeM bidding document.

#### NOTE:

- a). If the delivery of supply as detailed above gets delayed beyond the delivery period, the Supplier/Vendor shall request for a delivery extension and BHEL at its discretion may extend the Contract. However, if any 'Delivery extension' is granted to the Supplier/Vendor for completion of supply, due to backlog attributable to the Supplier/Vendor, then it shall be without prejudice to the rights of BHEL to impose LD for the delays attributable to the Supplier/Vendor
- b). In case BHEL increase the quantity during currency of the contract in line with quantity variation clause (Option clause in GeM bidding document), delivery extension shall be given for supply of these additional quantity. 8.

#### TRANSIT INSURANCE:

Transit Insurance of material is in Supplier/Vendor's scope. Supplier/Vendor shall insure the material at the ir cost for transportation. 9.

# a) PAYMENT TERMS:

#### BREACH OF CONTRACT. REMEDIES AND TERMINATION:

- 14.1 The following shall amount to breach of contract:
- I. Non-supply of material/ non-completion of work by the Supplier/Vendor within scheduled delivery/ completion period as per contract or as extended from time to time.
- II. The Supplier/Vendor fails to perform as per the activity schedule and there are sufficient reasons even b efore expiry of the delivery/ completion period to justify that supplies shall be inordinately delayed beyond contractual delivery/ completion period.
- III. The Supplier/Vendor delivers equipment/ material not of the contracted quality.
- IV. The Supplier/Vendor fails to replace the defective equipment/ material/ component as per guarantee cl ause.
- V. Withdrawal from or abandonment of the work by the Supplier/Vendor before completion as per contract.
- VI. Assignment, transfer, subletting of Contract by the Supplier/Vendor without BHEL's written permission r esulting in termination of Contract or part thereof by BHEL.
- VII. Non-compliance to any contractual condition or any other default attributable to Supplier/Vendor.
- VIII. Any other reason(s) attributable to Vendor towards failure of performance of contract.

In case of breach of contract, BHEL shall have the right to terminate the Purchase Order/ Contract either in whole or in part thereof without any compensation to the Supplier/Vendor.

IX. Any of the declarations furnished by the contractor at the time of bidding and/ or entering into the contract for supply are found untruthful and such declarations were

of a nature that could have resulted in non-award of contract to the contractor or could expose BHEL and/ or Owner to adverse consequences, financial or otherwise.

X. Supplier/Vendor is convicted of any offence involving corrupt business practices, antinational activities o r any such offence that compromises the business ethics of BHEL, in violation of the Integrity Pact entered into with BHEL has the potential to harm the overall business of BHEL/ Owner.

Note-Once BHEL considers that a breach of contract has occurred on the part of

14.2 Remedies in case of Breach of Contract.

i Wherein the period as stipulated in the notice issued under clause 14.1 has expired and Supplier/Vendor has failed to remedy the breach, BHEL will have the right to terminate the contract on the ground of "Breach of Contract" without any further notice to contractor.

ii Upon termination of contract, BHEL shall be entitled to recover an amount equivalent to 10% of the Cont ract Value for the damages on account of breach of contract committed by the Supplier/Vendor. This amount shall be recovered by way of encashing the security instruments like performance bank guarantee etc a vailable with BHEL against the said contract. In case the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount shall be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the Supplier/Vendor, retention amount, from the money due to the Supplier/Vendor etc. with BHEL) or the other legal remedies shall be pursued.

iii wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL agains t the said contract is 10% of the contract value or more, such security instruments to the extent of 10% contract value will be encashed. In case no security instruments are available or the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the 10% of the contract value or the balance am ount, as the case may be, will be recovered in all or any of the following manners:

iv In case the amount recovered as above is not sufficient to fulfil the amount recoverable then; a demand notice to deposit the balance amount within 30 days shall be issued to Supplier/Vendor.

v If Supplier/Vendor fails to deposit the balance amount within the period as prescribed in demand notice, following action shall be taken for recovery of the balance amount:

- a) from dues available in the form of Bills payable to defaulted Supplier/Vendor against the same contract.
- b) If it is not possible to recover the dues available from the same contract or dues are insufficient to meet the recoverable amount, balance amount shall be recovered from any money(s) payable to Supplier/Vend or under any contract with other Units of BHEL including recovery from security deposits or any other depo sit available in the form of security instruments of any kind against Security deposit or EMD.

vi In-case recoveries are not possible with any of the above available options, Legal action shall be initiate d for recovery against defaulted supplier/Vendor.

vii It is an agreed term of contract that this amount shall be a genuine pre-estimate of damages that BHEL would incur in completion of balance contractual obligation of the contract through any other agency and BHEL will not be required to furnish any other evidence to the Supplier/Vendor for the purpose of estimation of damages.

viii In addition to the above, imposition of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

If after the Designated Engineer has given written notice of this decision to the party and no intention to p ursue the dispute has been communicated to him by the affected party within 30 days from the receipt of such notice, the said decision shall become final and binding on the parties. In the event the Supplier/Vend or being dissatisfied with any such decision or if amicable settlement cannot be reached then all such disp uted issues shall be resolved through conciliation in terms of the BHEL Conciliation Scheme 2018 as per Cl ause 21.1

### 21.1 Conciliation:

Any dispute, difference or controversy of whatever nature howsoever arising under or out of or in relation to this Agreement (including its interpretation) between the Parties, and so notified in writing by either Part y to the other Party (the "Dispute") shall, in the first instance, be attempted to be resolved amicably in accordance with the conciliation procedure as per BHEL Conciliation Scheme 2018. The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory mo dification thereof and as provided in - "Procedure for conduct of conciliation proceedings" (as available in www.bhel.com)).

Note: Ministry of Finance has issued OM reference No. 1/2/24 dated 03.06.2024 regarding "Guidelines for A rbitration and Mediation in Contracts of Domestic Public Procurement. In the said OM it has been recomme nded that Government departments/

Entities/agencies are to encourage mediation under the Mediation Act. 2023. The said Act has not yet been notified by the Government. Therefore, the clause "Settlement of Disputes" shall be modified accordingly a s and when the Mediation Act 2023 gets notified.

#### 21.2 ARBITRATION:

- 21.2.1 Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case Parties are unable to reach amicable settlem ent (whether by Conciliation to be conducted as provided in Clause 14.1 herein above or otherwise) in res pect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any pr ovision of the Contract; or. in any manner touching upon the Contract (hereinafter referred to as the 'Dispute'), then, either Party may, refer the disputes to Madras High Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC) and such dispute to be adjudicated by Sole Arbitrator appointed in accordance with the Rules of said Arbitral Institution.
- 21.2.2 A party willing to commence arbitration proceeding shall invoke Arbitration Clause by giving notice to the other party in terms of section 21 of the Arbitration & Conciliation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Notice') before referring the matter to arbitral institution. The Notice shall be addressed to the Hea d of the Unit, BHEL, executing the Contract and shall contain the particulars of all claims to be referred to a rbitration with sufficient detail and shall also indicate the monetary amount of such claim including interes t, if any.
- 21.2.3 After expiry of 30 days from the date of receipt of aforesaid notice, the party invoking the Arbitration shall submit that dispute to the Arbitral Institution- Madras High Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC)- and that dispute shall be adjudicated in accordance with their respective Arbitration Rules. The matter shall be adjudicated by a Sole Arbitrator who shall necessarily be a Retd Judge having considerable experience in c ommercial matters to be appointed/nominated by the respective institution. The cost/expenses pertaining to the said Arbitration shall also be governed in accordance with the Rules of the respective Arbitral Institution. The decision of the party invoking the Arbitration for reference of dispute to Madras High Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC)- for adjudication of that dispute shall be final and binding on both the parties and shall not be subject to any change thereafter. The institution once selected at the time of invocation of dispute shall remain unchanged.
- 21.2.4 The fee and expenses shall be borne by the parties as per the Arbitral Institutional rules.
- 21.2.5 The Arbitration proceedings shall be in English language and the seat of Arbitration shall be Trichy.
- 21.2.6 Subject to the above, the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 and any amendment ther eof shall be applicable. All matters relating to this Contract and arising out of invocation of Arbitration clau se are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court(s) situated at Trichy.
- 21.2.7 Notwithstanding any reference to the Designated Engineer or Conciliation or Arbitration herein, a. t he parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under the Contract unless they otherwise agree. Settlement of Dispute clause cannot be invoked by the Contractor, if the Contract has been mutuall y closed or 'No Demand Certificate' has been furnished by the Contractor or any Settlement Agreement has been signed between the Employer and the Contractor.
- 21.2.8 It is agreed that Mechanism of resolution of disputes through arbitration shall be available only in the cases where the value of the dispute is less than Rs. 10 Crores.
- 21.2.9 In case the disputed amount Claim, Counter claim including interest is Rs. 10 crores and above, the parties shall be within their rights to take recourse to remedies other than Arbitration, as may be available to them under the applicable laws after prior intimation to the other party. Subject to the aforesaid conditions, provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any statutory modifications or re-enactme nt thereof as amended from time to time, shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause.
- 21.2.10 In case, multiple arbitrations are invoked (whether sub-judice or arbitral award passed) by any par ty to under this contract, then the cumulative value of claims (including interest claimed or awarded) in all such arbitrations shall be taken in account while arriving at the total claim in dispute for the subject contract for the purpose of clause 21.2.9. Disputes having cumulative value of less than 10 crores shall be resolved through arbitration and any additional dispute shall be adjudicated by the court of competent jurisdiction.

#### Force Majeure

- 23.1 "Force Majeure" shall mean circumstance which is:
- a) beyond control of either of the parties to contract,
- b) either of the parties could not reasonably have provided against the event before entering into the contract,
- c) having arisen, either of the parties could not reasonably have avoided or overcome, and
- d) is not substantially attributable to either of the parties And Prevents the performance of the contract, Su ch circumstances include but shall not be limited to:
- i War, hostilities, invasion, act of foreign enemies.
- ii Rebellion, terrorism, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power, or civil war.
- iii Riot, commotion or disorder by persons other than the contractor's personnel and other employees of the contractor and sub-contractors.
- iv Strike or lockout not solely involving the contractor's personnel and other employees of the contractor a nd sub-contractors.
- v Encountering munitions of war, explosive materials, ionizing radiation or contamination by radio-activity, except as may be attributable to the contractor's use of such munitions, explosives, radiation or radio- activity.
- vi Natural catastrophes such as earthquake, tsunami, volcanic activity, hurricane or typhoon, flood, fire, cy clones etc.
- vii Epidemic, pandemic etc.
- 23.2 The following events are explicitly excluded from Force Majeure and are solely the responsibilities of t he non-performing party: a) any strike, work-to-rule action, go-slow or similar labour difficulty (b) late delivery of equipment or material (unless caused by Force Majeure event) and (c) economic hardship.
- 23.3 If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances thereof within 15 (fifteen) days after the occurrence of such event.
- 23.4 The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed. The Time for Completion shall be extended by a period of time equal to period of delay caused due to such Force Majeure event.
- 23.5 Delay or non-performance by either party hereto caused by the occurrence of any event of Force Maj eure shall not
- i. Constitute a default or breach of the Contract.
- ii. Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost expense occasioned thereby, if and to the extent t hat such delay or non-performance is caused by the occurrence of an event of Force Majeure.
- 23.6 BHEL at its discretion may consider short closure of contract after 1 year of imposition of Force Majeu re in line with extant guidelines. In any case, Supplier/Vendor cannot consider deemed short-closure after 1 year of imposition of Force Majeure. 24.
