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- 1. If the bidder is a Micro or Small Enterprise as per latest definitions under MSME rules, the bidder shall be exempted from the requirement of "Bidder Turnover" criteria and "Experience Criteria" subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. In case any bidder is seeking exemption from Turnover / Experience Criteria, the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption must be uploaded for evaluation by the buyer.
- 2. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
- 4. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. Also this is not going to be used as a criteria in determining reasonableness of quoted prices which would be determined by the buyer based on its own assessment of reasonableness and based on competitive prices received in Bid / RA process.

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. The delivery period of quantity shall commence from the last date of original delivery order and in cases where option clause is exercised during the extended delivery period the additional time shall commence from the last date of extended delivery period. The additional delivery time shall be (Increased quantity \div Original quantity) \times Original delivery period (in days), subject to minimum of 30 days. If the original delivery period is less than 30 days, the additional time equals the original delivery period. The Purchaser may extend this calculated delivery duration up to the original delivery period while exercising the option clause. Bidders must comply with these terms.

1. **Pre-Qualification Criteria:**

- 1.1 Technical: Pre-Qualification criteria (Technical) for this enquiry is given in Annexure-B (a vailable along with Specification document).

- 1.4 Bidder must not be admitted under Corporate Insolvency Resolution Process or Liquidati on as on date, by NCLT or any adjudicating authority/authorities, and shall submit undert aking (Annexure-4) to this effect.
- 1.5 Customer Approval: NA

Explanatory Notes for the PQR:

- i. 'Supplied' in PQR 1.1 means, bidder should have delivered the Item/material. Bidder shall submit the relevant documents against the above PQRs inclusive of Purchase order (wherein PO no., date, etc. is legible) along with proof of supply (i.e. Completio n Certificate/ Copy of Invoices / LR Copies/ Store Receipt Vouchers/ Payment Advice et c.) in the respective attachments in their offer in support of PQR. The "Contract" referr ed in Technical PQR may be Rate Contract/ Framework Agreement/ Purchase Order/ W ork Order.

- iv. If Financial Statements are not required to be audited statutorily, then instead of audit ed Financial Statements, Financial Statements are required to be certified by Chartere d Accountant.
- v. Credentials furnished by the bidder against "PRE-QUALIFYING CRITERIA" shall be verified from the issuing authority for its authenticity. In case, any credential (s) is/are found to be spurious, offer of the bidder is liable to be rejected. BHEL reserves the right to initiate any further action as per extant guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings as applicable in BHEL.
- vi. In case of Two packet bidding System, Price Bids of only those bidders shall be opened who stand qualified after compliance of PQR 1.1 to 1.5

2. SCOPE OF SUPPLY:

Supply of items/material shall be as per technical Specifications indicated in the enquiry. Technical Specification requirements are available in Specification document for the item(s). Unloading of materials at Destination / Site shall be in BHEL's scope.

3. PRICE BASIS:

The quote shall be on FOR- Destination basis delivery to BHEL Stores (Pls. refer consignee ad dress in GeM bidding document).

4. TAXES & DUTIES:

4.1 The Supplier/Vendor shall pay all (save the specific exclusions as enumerated in this cla use) taxes, fees, license, charges, deposits, duties, tools, royalty, commissions, other charg es, etc. which may be levied on the input goods & services consumed and output goods & services delivered in course of his operations in executing the contract. In case BHEL is forced to pay any of such taxes/duties, BHEL shall have the right to recover the same from his bills or otherwise as deemed fit along with the applicable overheads @5% and interest on the total value (i. e. amount paid by BHEL + overhead)

However, provisions regarding **GST** on output supply (goods/service) and TDS/TCS as per Inc ome Tax Act shall be as per following clauses.

4.2 GST (Goods and Services Tax)

- **4.2.1** Rate quoted in GeM portal should be on FOR destination basis inclusive of all taxes, P &F, freight etc. Reimbursement of GST is subject to compliance of following terms and con ditions. BHEL shall have the right to deny payment of GST and to recover any loss to BHEL on account of tax, interest, penalty etc. for non-compliance of any of the following condition.
- **4.2.2** The admissibility of GST, taxes and duties referred in this chapter or elsewhere in the contract shall be limited to direct transactions between BHEL & its Supplier/Vendor. BHEL sh all not consider GST on any transaction other than the direct transaction between BHEL & its Supplier/Vendor.
- **4.2.3** Supplier/Vendor shall obtain prior written consent of BHEL before billing the amount t owards such taxes. Where the GST laws permit more than one option or methodology for di scharging the liability of tax/levy/duty, BHEL shall have the right to adopt the appropriate on e considering the amount of tax liability on BHEL/Client as well as procedural simplicity with regard to assessment of the liability. The option chosen by BHEL shall be binding on the Con tractor for discharging the obligation of BHEL in respect of the tax liability to the Supplier/Ve ndor.
- **4.2.4** Supplier/Vendor has to submit GST registration certificate of the concerned state. Sup plier/Vendor also needs to ensure that the submitted GST registration certificate should be in active status during the entire contract period.
- **4.2.5** Supplier/Vendor has to issue Invoice/Debit Note/Credit Note indicating HSN/SAC code, Description, Value, Rate, applicable tax and other particulars in compliance with the provisi ons of relevant GST Act and Rules made thereunder.
- **4.2.6** Supplier/Vendor has to submit GST compliant invoice within the due date of invoice a s per GST Law. In case of delay, BHEL reserves the right of denial of GST payment if there o ccurs any hardship to BHEL in claiming the input thereof. In case of goods, Supplier/Vendor has to provide scan copy of invoice & GR/LR/RR to BHEL before movement of goods starts to enable BHEL to meet its GST related compliances. Special care should be taken in case of m onth end transactions.
- **4.2.7** Supplier/Vendor has to ensure that invoice in respect of such services which have bee n provided/completed on or before end of the month should not bear the date later than last working day of the month in which services are performed.
- $\textbf{4.2.8} \ \ \text{Subject to other provisions of the contract, GST amount claimed in the invoice shall be released on fulfilment of all the following conditions by the Supplier/Vendor:$
 - a) Supply of goods and/or services have been received by BHEL.

- b) Original Tax Invoice has been submitted to BHEL.
- c) Supplier/Vendor has submitted all the documents required for processing of bill as per contract/ purchase order/ work order.
- d) In cases where e-invoicing provision is applicable, Supplier/Vendor is required to sub mit invoice in compliance with e-invoicing provisions of GST Act and Rules made ther eunder.
- e) Supplier/Vendor has filed all the relevant GST return (e.g. GSTR-1, GSTR-3B, etc.) per taining to the invoice submitted and submit the proof of such return along with imme diate subsequent invoice. In case of final invoice/ bill, contractor has to submit proof of such return within fifteen days from the due date of relevant return.
- f) Respective invoice has appeared in BHEL's GSTR 2A for the month corresponding to the month of invoice and in GSTR-2B of the month in which such invoices has been r eported by the contractor along with status of ITC availability as "YES" in GSTR-2B. A lternatively, BG of appropriate value may be furnished which shall be valid at least o ne month beyond the due date of confirmation of relevant payment of GST on GSTN portal or sufficient security is available to adjust the financial impact in case of any d efault by the Supplier/Vendor.
- g) Supplier/Vendor has to submit an undertaking confirming the payment of all due GST in respect of invoices pertaining to BHEL.
- **4.2.9** Any financial loss arises to BHEL on account of failure or delay in submission of any d ocument as per contract/purchase order/work order at the time of submission of Tax invoic e to BHEL, shall be deducted from Supplier/Vendor's bill or otherwise as deemed fit.
- **4.2.10** TDS as applicable under GST law shall be deducted from Supplier/Vendor's bill. **4.2.11** Supplier/Vendor shall comply with the provisions of e-way bill wherever applicable. F urther wherever provisions of GST Act permits, all the e-way bills, road permits etc. required for transportation of goods needs to be arranged by the contractor.
- **4.2.12** Supplier/Vendor shall be solely responsible for discharging his GST liability accordin g to the provisions of GST Law and BHEL will not entertain any claim of GST/interest/penalty or any other liability on account of failure of Supplier/Vendor in complying the provisions of GST Law or discharging the GST liability in a manner laid down thereunder.
- **4.2.13** In case declaration of any invoice is delayed by the vendor in his GST return or any i nvoice is subsequently amended/altered/deleted on GSTN portal which results in any advers e financial implication on BHEL, the financial impact thereof including interest/penalty shall be recovered from the Supplier/Vendor's due payment.
- **4.2.14** Any denial of input credit to BHEL or arising of any tax liability on BHEL due to nonc ompliance of GST Law by the Supplier/Vendor in any manner, will be recovered along with li ability on account of interest and penalty (if any) from the payments due to the Supplier/Vendor
- **4.2.15** In the event of any ambiguity in GST law with respect to availability of input credit of GST charged on the invoice raised by the contractor or with respect to any other matter having impact on BHEL, BHEL's decision shall be final and binding on the Supplier/Vendor.

4.2.16 Variation in Taxes & Duties:

Any upward variation in GST shall be considered for reimbursement provided supply of goods and services are made within schedule date stipulated in the contract or approved ex tended schedule for the reason solely attributable to BHEL. However downward variation sh all be subject to adjustment as per actual GST applicability.

In case the Government imposes any new levy/tax on the output service/goods after price bid opening, the same shall be reimbursed by BHEL at actual. The reimbursement under this clause is restricted to the direct transaction between BHEL and its Supplier/Vendor only and within the contractual delivery period only.

In case any new tax/levy/duty etc. becomes applicable after the date of Bidder's offer but before opening of the price Bid, the Bidder/ Supplier/Vendor must convey its impact on his price duly substantiated by documentary evidence in support of the same before opening of price bid. Claim for any such impact after opening the price bid will not be considered by BHE L for reimbursement of tax or reassessment of offer.

4.3 Income Tax:

TDS/TCS as applicable under Income Tax Act, 1961 or rules made thereunder shall be dedu cted/collected from Supplier/Vendor's bill.

6. INSPECTION / INSPECTION & TESTING AT SUPPLIERS WORKS:

Inspection and testing requirements are to be carried out as per the specification standard a nd BHEL Technical specifications in the enquiry.

BHEL reserves the right to inspect the material during manufacturing and also to get tested the material under dispatch from third party. The test results of third party test shall be final and binding on the Supplier/Vendor.

BHEL will reserve the right to inspect/test the material during/after manufacturing at suppli ers' works, and/or at BHEL Site. In case of rejection at any stage, Supplier/Vendor shall be li able to replace the materials at his own cost.

7. **DELIVERY:**

Materials are to be supplied within the delivery period indicated in GeM bidding document.

NOTE:

- **a).** If the delivery of supply as detailed above gets delayed beyond the delivery period, the Supplier/Vendor shall request for a delivery extension and BHEL at its discretion may extend the Contract. However, if any 'Delivery extension' is granted to the Supplier/Vendor for completion of supply, due to backlog attributable to the Supplier/Vendor, then it shall be without prejudice to the rights of BHEL to impose LD for the delays attributable to the Supplier/Vendor
- **b).** In case BHEL increase the quantity during currency of the contract in line with quantity variation clause (Option clause in GeM bidding document), delivery extension shall be give n for supply of these additional quantity.

8. TRANSIT INSURANCE:

Transit Insurance of material is in Supplier/Vendor's scope. Supplier/Vendor shall insure the material at their cost for transportation.

- IX. Any of the declarations furnished by the contractor at the time of bidding and/ or en tering into the contract for supply are found untruthful and such declarations were of a nature that could have resulted in non-award of contract to the contractor or could expose BHEL and/ or Owner to adverse consequences, financial or otherwise.
- X. - ii Upon termination of contract, BHEL shall be entitled to recover an amount equivalent to 10% of the Contract Value for the damages on account of breach of contract com mitted by the Supplier/Vendor. This amount shall be recovered by way of encashing t he security instruments like performance bank guarantee etc available with BHEL ag ainst the said contract. In case the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount shall be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the Supplier/Vendor, retention amount, from the money due to the Supplier/Vendor etc. with BHEL) or the other legal remedies shall be pursued.
- iii wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL against the said contract is 10% of the contract value or more, such securit y instruments to the extent of 10% contract value will be encashed. In case no securit y instruments are available or the value of the security instruments available is less th an 10% of the contract value, the 10% of the contract value or the balance amount, as the case may be, will be recovered in all or any of the following manners:
- iv In case the amount recovered as above is not sufficient to fulfil the amount recoverab le then; a demand notice to deposit the balance amount within 30 days shall be issued to Supplier/Vendor.
- v If Supplier/Vendor fails to deposit the balance amount within the period as prescribed in demand notice, following action shall be taken for recovery of the balance amount:
 - a) from dues available in the form of Bills payable to defaulted Supplier/Vendor against the same contract.
 - b) If it is not possible to recover the dues available from the same contract or dues a re insufficient to meet the recoverable amount, balance amount shall be recovere d from any money(s) payable to Supplier/Vendor under any contract with other U nits of BHEL including recovery from security deposits or any other deposit availa ble in the form of security instruments of any kind against Security deposit or EM D.

- vi In-case recoveries are not possible with any of the above available options, Legal action shall be initiated for recovery against defaulted supplier/Vendor.
- vii It is an agreed term of contract that this amount shall be a genuine pre-estimate of d amages that BHEL would incur in completion of balance contractual obligation of the c ontract through any other agency and BHEL will not be required to furnish any other e vidence to the Supplier/Vendor for the purpose of estimation of damages.

Settlement of Dispute

21.

If any dispute or difference of any kind whatsoever shall arise between BHEL and the Suppli er/Vendor, arising out of the contract for the performance of the work whether during the pr ogress of contract termination, abandonment or breach of the contract, it shall in the first pl ace referred to Designated Engineer for amicable resolution by the parties. Designated Engineer (to be nominated by BHEL for settlement of disputes arising out of the contract) who w ithin 60 days after being requested shall give written notice of his decision to the contractor . Save as hereinafter provided, such decision in respect of every matter so referred shall for thwith be given effect to by the Supplier/Vendor who shall proceed with the work with all due diligence, whether he or BHEL desires to resolve the dispute as hereinafter provided or no t.

If after the Designated Engineer has given written notice of this decision to the party and no intention to pursue the dispute has been communicated to him by the affected party within 30 days from the receipt of such notice, the said decision shall become final and binding on the parties. In the event the Supplier/Vendor being dissatisfied with any such decision or if a micable settlement cannot be reached then all such disputed issues shall be resolved through conciliation in terms of the BHEL Conciliation Scheme 2018 as per Clause 21.1

21.1 Conciliation:

Any dispute, difference or controversy of whatever nature howsoever arising under or out of or in relation to this Agreement (including its interpretation) between the Parties, and so notified in writing by either Party to the other Party (the "Dispute") shall, in the first instance, be attempted to be resolved amicably in accordance with the conciliation procedure as per BHEL Conciliation Scheme 2018. The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification thereof and as provided in - "Procedure for conduct of conciliation proceedings" (as available in www.bhel.com)).

Note: Ministry of Finance has issued OM reference No. 1/2/24 dated 03.06.2024 regarding "Guidelines for Arbitration and Mediation in Contracts of Domestic Public Procurement. In the said OM it has been recommended that Government departments/

Entities/agencies are to encourage mediation under the Mediation Act. 2023. The said Act h as not yet been notified by the Government. Therefore, the clause "Settlement of Disputes" shall be modified accordingly as and when the Mediation Act 2023 gets notified.

21.2 ARBITRATION:

- 21.2.1 Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case Parties are unable to reach a micable settlement (whether by Conciliation to be conducted as provided in Clause 14.1 herein above or otherwise) in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out o f the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the Contract; or, the re spective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any pr ovision of the Contract; or. in any manner touching upon the Contract (hereinafter r eferred to as the 'Dispute'), then, either Party may, refer the disputes to **Madras Hi gh Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC)** and such dispute to be adjudicated by So le Arbitrator appointed in accordance with the Rules of said Arbitral Institution.
- 21.2.2 A party willing to commence arbitration proceeding shall invoke Arbitration Clause by giving notice to the other party in terms of section 21 of the Arbitration & Concili ation Act, 1996 (hereinafter referred to as the 'Notice') before referring the matter to arbitral institution. The Notice shall be addressed to the Head of the Unit, BHEL, executing the Contract and shall contain the particulars of all claims to be referred to arbitration with sufficient detail and shall also indicate the monetary amount of such claim including interest, if any.
- 21.2.3 After expiry of 30 days from the date of receipt of aforesaid notice, the party invokin g the Arbitration shall submit that dispute to the Arbitral Institution- Madras High Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC)- and that dispute shall be adjudicated in acc ordance with their respective Arbitration Rules. The matter shall be adjudicated by a Sole Arbitrator who shall necessarily be a Retd Judge having considerable experienc e in commercial matters to be appointed/nominated by the respective institution. The cost/expenses pertaining to the said Arbitration shall also be governed in accordance with the Rules of the respective Arbitral Institution. The decision of the party invoking the Arbitration for reference of dispute to Madras High Court, Arbitration Centre (MHCAC)- for adjudication of that dispute shall be final and binding on both the parties and shall not be subject to any change thereafter. The institution once se lected at the time of invocation of dispute shall remain unchanged.
- 21.2.4 The fee and expenses shall be borne by the parties as per the Arbitral Institutional rules.
- 21.2.5 The Arbitration proceedings shall be in English language and the seat of Arbitration shall be **Trichy**.

- 21.2.6 Subject to the above, the provisions of Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 and any a mendment thereof shall be applicable. All matters relating to this Contract and arisi ng out of invocation of Arbitration clause are subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of the Court(s) situated at **Trichy**.
- 21.2.7 Notwithstanding any reference to the Designated Engineer or Conciliation or Arbitrati on herein, a. the parties shall continue to perform their respective obligations under the Contract unless they otherwise agree. Settlement of Dispute clause cannot be in voked by the Contractor, if the Contract has been mutually closed or 'No Demand Ce rtificate' has been furnished by the Contractor or any Settlement Agreement has be en signed between the Employer and the Contractor.
- 21.2.8 It is agreed that Mechanism of resolution of disputes through arbitration shall be available only in the cases where the value of the dispute is less than Rs. 10 Crores.
- 21.2.9 In case the disputed amount Claim, Counter claim including interest is Rs. 10 crores and above, the parties shall be within their rights to take recourse to remedies other than Arbitration, as may be available to them under the applicable laws after prior i ntimation to the other party. Subject to the aforesaid conditions, provisions of the Ar bitration and Conciliation Act, 1996 and any statutory modifications or re-enactment thereof as amended from time to time, shall apply to the arbitration proceedings un der this clause.
- 21.2.10 In case, multiple arbitrations are invoked (whether sub-judice or arbitral award pass ed) by any party to under this contract, then the cumulative value of claims (including interest claimed or awarded) in all such arbitrations shall be taken in account while arriving at the total claim in dispute for the subject contract for the purpose of clause 21.2.9. Disputes having cumulative value of less than 10 crores shall be resolved through arbitration and any additional dispute shall be adjudicated by the court of competent jurisdiction.

21.3 In case of Contract with Public Sector Enterprise (PSE) or a Government De partment, the following shall be applicable:

22. **JURISDICTION**

Subject to clause 21 of this contract, the Civil Court having original Civil Jurisdiction at Tiruc hirappalli, Tamilnadu shall alone have exclusive jurisdiction in regard to all matters in respect of the Contract.

 - ii Rebellion, terrorism, revolution, insurrection, military or usurped power, or civil war.

Riot, commotion or disorder by persons other than the contractor's pers onnel and other employees of the contractor and sub-contractors. Strike or lockout not solely involving the contractor's personnel and oth er employees of the contractor and sub-contractors. Encountering munitions of war, explosive materials, ionizing radiation o r contamination by radio-activity, except as may be attributable to the c ontractor's use of such munitions, explosives, radiation or radio- activit vi Natural catastrophes such as earthquake, tsunami, volcanic activity, hu rricane or typhoon, flood, fire, cyclones etc. Epidemic, pandemic etc. 23.2 The following events are explicitly excluded from Force Majeure and are solely the re sponsibilities of the non-performing party: a) any strike, work-to-rule action, go-slow or similar labour difficulty (b) late delivery of equipment or material (unless caused b y Force Majeure event) and (c) economic hardship. 23.3 If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obli gations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the ot her in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances thereof within n 15 (fifteen) days after the occurrence of such event. The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force Majeure continues and to the extent that such party's performance is prevented, hindered or delayed. The Time for Completion shall be extended by a period of time equal to period of delay caused due to such Force Majeure event. 23.4 23.5 Delay or non-performance by either party hereto caused by the occurrence of any ev ent of Force Majeure shall not Constitute a default or breach of the Contract. Give rise to any claim for damages or additional cost expense occasioned the reby, if and to the extent that such delay or non-performance is caused by th e occurrence of an event of Force Majeure. BHEL at its discretion may consider short closure of contract after 1 year of imposition of Force Majeure in line with extant guidelines. In any case, Supplier/Vendor cannot consider deemed short-closure after 1 year of imposition of Force Majeure. 24. **Non-Disclosure Agreement:** The bidders shall enter into the Non-disclosure agreement separately.
