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1. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Experience Criteria" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Experience Criteria, shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
2. If the bidder is a DPIIT registered Startup, the bidder shall be exempted from the the eligibility criteria of "Bidder Turnover" as defined above subject to their meeting of quality and technical specifications. If the bidder is DPIIT Registered OEM of the offered products, it would be exempted from the "OEM Average Turnover" criteria also subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications. The bidder seeking exemption from Turnover shall upload the supporting documents to prove his eligibility for exemption.
3. Preference to Make In India products (For bids < 200 Crore): Preference shall be given to Class 1 local supplier as defined in public procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 as amended from time to time and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Nodal Ministry for specific Goods/Products. The minimum local content to qualify as a Class 1 local supplier is denoted in the bid document. If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must upload a certificate from the OEM regarding the percentage of the local content and the details of locations at which the local value addition is made along with their bid, failing which no purchase preference shall be granted. In case the bid value is more than Rs 10 Crore, the declaration relating to percentage of local content shall be certified by the statutory auditor or cost auditor, if the OEM is a company and by a practicing cost accountant or a chartered accountant for OEMs other than companies as per the Public Procurement (preference to Make-in -India) order 2017 dated 04.06.2020. Only Class-I and Class-II Local suppliers as per MII order dated 4.6.2020 will be eligible to bid. Non - Local suppliers as per MII order dated 04.06.2020 are not eligible to participate. However, eligible micro and small enterprises will be allowed to participate .The buyers are advised to refer the OM No.F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023. [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017.
4. Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 [OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023](#) for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.
5. Reverse Auction would be conducted amongst all the technically qualified bidders except the Highest quoting bidder. The technically qualified Highest Quoting bidder will not be allowed to participate in RA. However, H-1 will also be allowed to participate in RA in following cases:
 - i. If number of technically qualified bidders are only 2 or 3.
 - ii. If Buyer has chosen to split the bid amongst N sellers, and H1 bid is coming within N.
 - iii. In case Primary product of only one OEM is left in contention for participation in RA on elimination of H-1.
 - iv. If L-1 is non-MSE and H-1 is eligible MSE and H-1 price is coming within price band of 15% of Non-MSE L-1
 - v. If L-1 is non-MII and H-1 is eligible MII and H-1 price is coming within price band of 20% of Non-MII L-1

Description: Supply and Installation of Low Tension (LT)Panel for Electrolyser.

1) Pre-Qualification Criteria:

1a) Prior Experience:

Bidder should submit at least one Purchase order (PO) copy for Low Tension (LT) Panel or High Tension (HT) Panel or Switchgear Panel within last 5 years from the date of enquiry.

1b) Relaxation of Norms for Startups: The condition of Prior Turnover and prior experience is relaxed for all startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR, 2005 and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms for startups issued from time to time.

2) Payment term: 90% of basic Payment of Supply Value (Supply of LT Panel for electrolyser) will be made within the stipulated days as mentioned below from the date of receipt and acceptance of item at BHEL Energy Systems Facility, Nacharam, Hyderabad.

Balance 10% of Supply Value (Supply of LT Panel for electrolyser) plus 100% of installation of the LT Panel for electrolyser Charges will be paid against successful completion of installation and Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) by Supplier.

GST will be reimbursed against submission of proof of payment of GST to govt. of India.

Type of bidder:

- A. For Micro & Small enterprises (MSEs) payment will be made within 45 days
- B. For Medium Enterprises will be made within 60 days
- C. Non MSMEs will be made within 90 days

However, GST Portion of Invoice shall be released only upon:

- i) Vendor declaring the Invoice in their GSTR-1.
- ii) Receipt of Goods and Tax Invoice by BHEL.
- iii) Confirmation of Payment of GST thereon by vendor on GSTN.

3) Compliance on restrictions under Rule 144 (XI) of the GFR : Submit the Annexure - A which is attached in ATC document.

4) Compliance on Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India) : Submit the Annexure - C which is attached in ATC document.

5) Technical Specification: Bidder shall submit compliance on attached BHEL Technical specification (Annexure-1) uploaded in Buyer Specification Document.

6) Terms of Delivery: Shall be Free On Road (FOR) BHEL Energy systems facility, C/o IICT pilot plant chemical complex, Road no 7, Nacharam Industrial Area, Nacharam, Hyderabad 500076.

7) Vendor has to submit this GeM bid document duly signed and stamped on all pages. By submitting signed GeM bid document it affirms that vendor has accepted to all the terms and conditions mentioned in this bid such as Payment terms, delivery period, PBG etc.

8) Insurance, loading/unloading from vendor site to BHEL Energy systems facility, C/o IICT pilot plant chemical complex, Road no 7, Nacharam Industrial Area, Nacharam will be in vendor scope only. Vendor has to quote price(s) inclusive of GST, Transportation/Insurance, Loading/Unloading charges.

9) Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination: In case of breach of contract, wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL against the said contract is at least 10% of the contract value, the same be encashed. In case the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the contract or, retention amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies be pursued. Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

10) Delivery period:

- a) Supply of LT Panel for electrolyser is within 60 days from the date of Purchase order.
- b) Vendor has to complete the Installation of the Item within 4 weeks from date of intimation (through mail) of site readiness from BHEL

11) Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) : PBG of 10% of total order value (i.e Supply + Installation) is to be submitted by the successful vendor and shall be kept valid up to guarantee period. Expiry of claim period may be kept 3-6 months after validity date. PBG shall be from one of the Consortium banks of BHEL or from a reputed bank and confirmed by any Consortium bank of BHEL. The offers of the suppliers not accepting to this clause will be rejected.

Note: Format of Performance Bank guarantee (PBG) is attached ATC document (Annexure-B).

12) Interest of delayed submission of PBG : Bidder has to submit performance bank guarantee (PBG) within 15 days date of completion of completion of entire scope (Supply + installation).

In case of delay in submission of PBG, enhanced performance security which would include interest (Repo rate + 4%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/contract, from the bills along with due interest.

13) SFMS Confirmation of Bank Guarantees (BGs):

Vendor/Contractor/Bidder to ensure that issuance of Bank Guarantee shall be confirmed by the issuing Bank directly to the Owner mandatorily through Structured Financial Messaging System (SFMS), as it provides an RBI supported Integrated Platform for Bank Guarantee Verification.

SBI Bank has been designated as BHEL Corporate R&D's Bank for receiving SFMS messages for BGs issued in favour of BHEL Corporate R&D.

BG shall only be obtained from Banks and Branches which are live on SFMS platform i.e. which have infrastructure to issue SFMS confirmation message along with the BG.

Vendor/Contractor/Bidder to take a print out of SFMS confirmation message from the BG issuing bank branch and attach copy of same along with the hardcopy of BG while submitting the same to BHEL Corporate R&D. Same process has to be followed for any verification of BG amendment as well.

14) Safety and statutory requirement: contractor / vendor shall ensure all safety and statutory requirement related to its staff.

15) Following documents to be submitted by bidders along with offer:

- a. PAN Number
- b. GSTIN Registration Status
- c. Bank details

16) Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers / Contractors:

The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bidders, who engage the services of the banned firms / principal / agents, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL web site <https://www.bhel.com/supplier-registration>

17) Conflict of Interest clause:

Treatment of cases regarding conflict of interest:

The bidder notes that a conflict of interest would said to have occurred in the tender process and execution of the resultant contract, in case of any of the following situations:

- i. If its personnel have a close personal, financial, or business relationship with any personnel of BHEL who are directly or indirectly related to the procurement or execution process of the contract, which can affect the decision of BHEL directly or indirectly;
- ii. The bidder (or his allied firm) provided services for the need assessment/ procurement planning of the Tender process in which it is participating;
- iii. Procurement of goods directly from the manufacturers/suppliers shall be preferred. However, if the OEM/Principal insists on engaging the services of an agent, such agent shall not be allowed to represent more than one manufacturer/ supplier in the same tender. Moreover, either the agent could bid on behalf of the manufacturer/ supplier or the manufacturer/ supplier could bid directly but not both. In case bids are received from both the manufacturer/ supplier and the agent, bid received from the agent shall be ignored. However, this shall not debar more than one Authorised distributor (with/ or without the OEM) from quoting equipment manufactured by an Original Equipment Manufacturer (OEM) in procurements under a Proprietary Article Certificate.
- iv. A bidder participates in more than one bid in this tender process. Participation in any capacity by a Bidder (including the participation of a Bidder as a partner/ JV member or sub-contractor in another bid or vice-versa) in more than one bid shall result in the disqualification of all bids in which he is a party. However, this does not limit the participation of an entity as a sub-contractor in more than one bid if he is not bidding independently in his own name or as a member of a JV.

The Bidder declares that they have read and understood the above aspects, and the bidder confirms that such conflict of interest does not exist and undertakes that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s), in this regard. This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.

In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, the same will be considered as a violation of the tender conditions, and suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

अस्वीकरण/Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without

specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.

10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
16. In a category based bid, adding additional items, through buyer added additional scope of work/ additional terms and conditions/or any other document. If buyer needs more items along with the main item, the same must be added through bunching category based items or by bunching custom catalogs or bunching a BoQ with the main category based item, the same must not be done through ATC or Scope of Work.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
