Purchase preference will be given to MSEs having valid Udyam Registration and whose credentials are validated online through Udyam Registration portal as defined in Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs) Order, 2012 dated 23.03.2012 issued by Ministry of Micro, Small and Medium Enterprises and its subsequent Orders/Notifications issued by concerned Ministry. If the bidder wants to avail themselves of the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer / OEM of the offered product on GeM. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises and hence resellers offering products manufactured by some other OEM are not eligible for any purchase preference. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service and Buyer will decide eligibility for purchase preference based on documentary evidence submitted, while evaluating the bid. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has / have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such MSE Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25% (selected by Buyer) percentage of total quantity. The buyers are advised to refer the OM No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dated 18.05.2023 OM No.1 4 2021 PPD dated 18.05.2023 for compliance of Concurrent application of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises Order, 2012 and Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India) Order, 2017. Benefits of MSE will be allowed only if seller is validated on-line in GeM profile as well as validated and approved by Buyer after evaluation of documents submitted.

Description: Supply and Installation of Metal Cutting Horizontal Band saw machine

1) Pre-Qualification Criteria:

- 1a) The bidder should submit at least one (01) purchase order (PO) copy of "Band Saw Machine/P ower Hacksaw Machine". PO date should be within five (5) years from the date of enquiry.
- 1b) **Relaxation of Norms for Start-ups**: The condition of Prior Turnover and prior experience is relaxed for all start-ups whether Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR,2005 and other DOE-PPD notifications for relaxation norms for start-ups issued from time to time.

2) Payment term:

100% Basic payment shall be made within the stipulated days as mentioned below from the date of completion of entire scope of work (i.e Supply & Installation) & issue of Installation c ertificate by BHEL-R&D, Hyderabad and submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG).

Type of bidder:

- A. For Micro & Small enterprises (MSEs) payment will be made with in 45 days
- B. For Medium Enterprises will be made with in 60 days
- C. Non MSMEs will be made with in 90 days

However, GST Portion of Invoice shall be released only upon:

- i) Vendor declaring the Invoice in their GSTR-1.
- ii) Receipt of Goods and Tax Invoice by BHEL.
- iii) Confirmation of Payment of GST thereon by vendor on GSTN
- 3) **Compliance on restrictions under Rule 144 (XI) of the GFR:** Submit the Annexure A which is attached in buyer added bid specific ATC document.
- 4) **Conflict of Interest Clause:** Submit the Annexure B which is attached in buyer added bi d specific ATC document.
- 5) Compliance on Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India (MII): Submit the A nnexure C which is attached in buyer added bid specific ATC document.
- 6) **Technical Specification:** Bidder shall submit compliance on attached BHEL Technical specification (Annexure-1) uploaded in Buyer Specification Document.
- 7) **Terms of Delivery :** Shall be F.O.R BHEL-Corp R&D, Hyderabad.
- 8) Invoice registration and documents upload in SUVIDHA portal by suppliers:

Irrespective of the value of the invoice amount, the bidder / vendor should necessarily upload the despatch & invoice details on BHEL SUVIDHA portal at $\frac{\text{https://suvidha.bhel.in/suvidha/}}{\text{https://suvidha.bhel.in/suvidha/}}, p rior to despatch.$

- All documents as per PO checklist, along with additional documents (if any), must be upload ed on the portal. It is mandatory that tax invoices with a net amount (including taxes) exceed ing Rs five (5) lakhs uploaded on the portal are digitally signed using a Class 3 Digital Signat ure Certificate (DSC) issued by a licensed Certifying Authority. Submission of invoice docume nt in hard copy is allowed for invoices with a net amount (including taxes) equal to and upto Rs five (5) lakhs, in case they were not digitally signed and uploaded on the portal.
- **9)** The material will not be accepted inside BHEL in absence of the above.
- 10) Vendor has to submit this GeM bid document duly signed and stamped on all pages. By sub mitting signed GeM bid document it affirms that vendor has accepted to all the terms and co nditions mentioned in this bid such as Payment terms, delivery period, terms of delivery, PB G etc.
- 11) Vendor has to quote price(s) **inclusive of GST, Transportation/Insurance, Loading/Unloading** and other applicable charges.
- 12) **Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination:** In case of breach of contract, wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL again st the said contract is at least 10% of the contract value, the same be encashed. In case the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the contract or, rete ntion amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies be pursued. Further, levy of liquidated dama ges, debarment, termination, de scoping, short-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisio ns of the contract.

13) **Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG):** PBG of 10% of total order value is to be submitted by the successful vendor and shall be kept valid up to guarantee period. Expiry of claim perio d may be kept 3-6 months after validity date. PBG shall be from one of the Consortium banks of BHEL or from a reputed bank and confirmed by any Consortium bank of BHEL. The offers of the suppliers not accepting to this clause will be rejected.

Note: Format of Performance Bank guarantee (PBG) of Annexure-D is attached in buyer adde d bid specific ATC document.

14) **Interest of delayed submission of PBG:** Bidder has to submit performance bank guarant ee (PBG) with-in 15 days date of completion of entire scope of work (Supply & Installation).

In case of delay in submission of PBG, enhanced performance security which would include in terest (Repo rate + 4%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if p erformance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of p erformance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/contract, from the bill s along with due interest.

15) SFMS Confirmation of Bank Guarantees (BGs):

Vendor/Contractor/Bidder to ensure that issuance of Bank Guarantee shall be confirmed by the issuing Bank directly to the Owner mandatorily through Structured Financial Messaging System (SFMS), as it provides an RBI supported Integrated Platform for Bank Guarantee Verification.

SBI Bank has been designated as BHEL Corporate R&D's Bank for receiving SFMS messages f or BGs issued in favour of BHEL Corporate R&D.

BG shall only be obtained from Banks and Branches which are live on SFMS platform i.e. which have infrastructure to issue SFMS confirmation message along with the BG.

Vendor/Contractor/Bidder to take a print out of SFMS confirmation message from the BG issui ng bank branch and attach copy of same along with the hardcopy of BG while submitting the same to BHEL Corporate R&D. Same process has to be followed for any verification of BG am endment as well.

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of

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bidding process without any notice:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.

- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
- 15. Buyer added ATC Clauses which are in contravention of clauses defined by buyer in system generated bid template as indicated above in the Bid Details section, EMD Detail, ePBG Detail and MII and MSE Purchase Preference sections of the bid, unless otherwise allowed by GeM GTC.
