- 1. - 13. In the bid PBG is 5% mentioned, however 5% additional PBG has to be submitted by the L1 bid der i.e. **Total PBG shall be 10% for this tender**. - 16. BHEL has the right to carry out pre-shipment inspection. Pre-dispatch Inspection may be carried out by BHEL/BH EL Nominated Agency/BHEL's client at Vendor works.
- 17.All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications etc. to the Tender will be hosted on https://gem.gov.in only. Bidders should regularly visit this website to keep themselves updated.
- 18.Amendments/addendums/circulars/Revisions thereto if any from Government or Statutory bodies or agencies sha II be applicable if not explicitly stated above from time to time. It is the responsibility of the bidders to keep updated themselves of the same. The bidders shall submit their offers in compliance.

19.CONCILIATION: Any dispute, difference or controversy of whatever nature howsoever arising under or out of or in relation to this Agreement (including its interpretation) between the Parties, and so notified in writing by either Part y to the other Party (the "Dispute") shall, in the first instance, be attempted to be resolved amicably in accordance with the conciliation procedure as per BHEL Conciliation Scheme 2018. The proceedings of Conciliation shall broadly be governed by Part-III of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 or any statutory modification thereof and as provided in - "Procedure for conduct of conciliation proceedings" (as available in www.bhel.com)).

Note:

Ministry of Finance has issued OM reference No. 1/2/24 dated 03.06.2024 regarding "Guidelines for Arbitration and Mediation in Contracts of Domestic Public Procurement. In the said OM it has been recommended that Government departments/ Entities/agencies are to encourage mediation under the Mediation Act. 2023. The said Act has not yet been notified by the Government. Therefore, the clause "Settlement of Disputes" shall be modified accordingly as and when the Mediation Act 2023 gets notified.

- 20. Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination: The following shall amount to breach of contract:
 - i. Non-supply of material/ non-completion of work by the Supplier/Vendor within scheduled delivery/ completion period as per contract or as extended from time to time.
 - ii. The Supplier/Vendor fails to perform as per the activity schedule and there are sufficient reasons eve n before expiry of the delivery/ completion period to justify that supplies shall be inordinately delayed b eyond contractual delivery/ completion period.
 - iii. The Supplier/Vendor delivers equipment/ material not of the contracted quality.
 - iv. The Supplier/Vendor fails to replace the defective equipment/ material/component as per guarantee clause.
 - v. Withdrawal from or abandonment of the work by the Supplier/Vendor before completion as per contract
 - vi. Assignment, transfer, subletting of Contract by the Supplier/Vendor without BHEL's written permission resulting in termination of Contract or part thereof by BHEL.
 - vii. Non-compliance to any contractual condition or any other default attributable to Supplier/Vendor.
 - viii. Any other reason(s) attributable to Vendor towards failure of performance of contract. In case of br each of contract, BHEL shall have the right to terminate the Purchase Order/ Contract either in whole or in part thereof without any compensation to the Supplier/Vendor.
 - ix. Any of the declarations furnished by the contractor at the time of bidding and/ or entering into the contract for supply are found untruthful and such declarations were of a nature that could have resulted in non-award of contract to the contractor or could expose BHEL and/ or Owner to adverse consequences, financial or otherwise.
 - x. Supplier/Vendor is convicted of any offence involving corrupt business practices, antinational activitie s or any such offence that compromises the business ethics of BHEL, in violation of the Integrity Pact en tered into with BHEL has the potential to harm the overall business of BHEL/ Owner.

Note- Once BHEL considers that a breach of contract has occurred on the part of Supplier/Vendor, BHEL shall notify the Supplier/Vendor by way of notice in this regard. Contractor shall be given an opportunit y to rectify the reasons causing the breach of contract within a period of 14 days.

In case the contractor fails to remedy the breach, as mentioned in the notice, to the satisfaction of BHEL , BHEL shall have the right to take recourse to any of the remedial actions available to it under the relev ant provisions of contract.

REMEDIES IN CASE OF BREACH OF CONTRACT.

- i. Wherein the period as stipulated in the notice issued under clause 19 (as above) has expired and Sup plier/Vendor has failed to remedy the breach, BHEL will have the right to terminate the contract on the ground of "Breach of Contract" without any further notice to contractor.
- ii. Upon termination of contract, BHEL shall be entitled to recover an amount equivalent to 10% of the C ontract Value for the damages on account of breach of contract committed by the Supplier/Vendor. This amount shall be recovered by way of encashing the security instruments like performance bank guaran tee etc available with BHEL against the said contract. In case the value of the security instruments avail able is less than 10% of the contract value, the balance amount shall be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the Supplier/Vendor, retention amount, from the money due to the Supplier/Vendor etc. with BHEL) or the other legal remedies shall be pursued.
- iii. wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL ag ainst the said contract is 10% of the contract value or more, such security instruments to the extent of 10% contract value will be encashed. In case no security instruments are available or the value of the s ecurity instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the 10% of the contract value or the balance amount, as the case may be, will be recovered in all or any of the following manners:
- iv. In case the amount recovered under sub clause (a) above is not sufficient to fulfil the amount recove rable then; a demand notice to deposit the balance amount within 30 days shall be issued to Supplier/V endor.
- v. If Supplier/Vendor fails to deposit the balance amount within the period as prescribed in demand noti ce, following action shall be taken for recovery of the balance amount:
- a. from dues available in the form of Bills payable to defaulted Supplier/Vendor against the same contract.
- b. If it is not possible to recover the dues available from the same contract or dues are insufficient to m eet the recoverable amount, balance amount shall be recovered from any money(s) payable to Supplier /Vendor under any contract with other Units of BHEL including recovery from security deposits or any ot her deposit available in the form of security instruments of any kind against Security deposit or EMD.
- c. In-case recoveries are not possible with any of the above available options, Legal action shall be initia ted for recovery against defaulted supplier/Vendor.
- vi. It is an agreed term of contract that this amount shall be a genuine pre-estimate of damages that B HEL would incur in completion of balance contractual obligation of the contract through any other agen cy and BHEL will not be required to furnish any other evidence to the Supplier/Vendor for the purpose of estimation of damages.
- vii. In addition to the above, imposition of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, sho rt-closure, etc., shall be applied as per provisions of the contract.

Note:

- 1) The defaulting Supplier/Vendor shall not be eligible for participation in any of the future enquiries floated by BHEL to complete the balance work. The defaulting contractor shall mean and include:
- (a) In case defaulted Supplier/Vendor is the Sole Proprietorship Firm, any Sole Proprietorship Firm owne d by same Sole Proprietor.

In case defaulted Supplier/Vendor is The Partnership Firm, any firm comprising of same partners/ some of the same partners; or sole proprietorship firm owned by any partner(s) as a sole proprietor.

21. Conflict of Interest

The bidder notes that a conflict of interest would said to have occurred in the tender process and execution of the resultant contract, in case of any of the following situations:

i) If its personnel have a close personal, financial, or business relationship with any personnel of BHEL w ho are directly or indirectly related to the procurement or execution process of the contract, which can affect the decision of BHEL directly or indirectly;

ii)The bidder (or his allied firm) provided services for the need assessment/ procurement planning of the Tender process in which it is participating;

iii)Procurement of goods directly from the manufacturers/ suppliers shall be preferred. However, if the OEM/ Principal insists on engaging the services of an agent, such agent shall not be allowed to represen t more than one manufacturer/ supplier in the same tender. Moreover, either the agent could bid on beh alf of the manufacturer/ supplier or the manufacturer/ supplier could bid directly but not both.
