Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

- 1. OPTION CLAUSE: The buyer can increase or decrease the contract quantity or contract duration up to 25 percent at the time of issue of the contract. However, once the contract is issued, contract quantity or contract duration can only be increased up to 25 percent. Bidders are bound to accept the revised quantity or duration
- 2. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Account Payee Demand Draft also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). DD should be made in favour of BHEL

- . After award of contract, Successful Bidder can upload scanned copy of the DD in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy to the original DD to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.
- 3. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Fixed Deposit Receipt also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). FDR should be made out or pledged in the name of BHEL. Haridwar
 - A/C (Name of the Seller). The bank should certify on it that the deposit can be withdrawn only on the demand or with the sanction of the pledgee. For release of Security Deposit, the FDR will be released in favour of bidder by the Buyer after making endorsement on the back of the FDR duly signed and stamped along with covering letter. Successful Bidder has to upload scanned copy of the FDR document in place of PBG and has to ensure delivery of hard copy of Original FDR to the Buyer within 15 days of award of contract.
- 4. Successful Bidder can submit the Performance Security in the form of Payment online through RTGS / internet banking also (besides PBG which is allowed as per GeM GTC). On-line payment shall be in Beneficiary name

- . Successful Bidder to indicate Contract number and name of Seller entity in the transaction details field at the time of on-line transfer. Bidder has to upload scanned copy / proof of the Online Payment Transfer in place of PBG within 15 days of award of contract.
- 5. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses
 - 1. The Parties who have been suspended or black listed or banned by BHEL HEE P, Haridwar or any other BHEL Unit and are under suspension at the time of bi d submission will not be allowed to participate in the Tender and the bidder sh ould declare the same in the Tender. Even during the course of evaluation / fin alization of Tender if it is found that some of the parties are black listed / barr

ed from business transactions / under business hold, BHEL will reject their offe r.

2. The Bidder along with its associate / collaborators / sub - vendors / consultant s / service providers shall strictly adhere to BHEL Fraud Prevention Policy displ ayed on BHEL website http://www.bhel.com and shall immediately bring to the notice of BHEL Management about fraud or suspected fraud as soon as it com es to their notice".

Fraud Prevention policy and List of Nodal Officers shall be hosted on BHEL we bsite, vendor portals of Units / Regions intranet.

- 3. The offers of the bidders who are under suspension as also the offers of the bi dders, who engage the services of the firms debarred across BHEL, shall be rej ected. The list of firms debarred across BHEL is available on BHEL web site www.bhel.com.
 - 1.0 Integrity commitment, performance of the contract and punitive action the reof:
 - 1.1. Commitment by BHEL:

BHEL commits to take all measures necessary to prevent corruption in conne ction with the tender process and execution of the contract. BHEL will during the tender process treat all Bidder(s) in a transparent and fair manner, and with equity.

- 1.2. Commitment by Bidder/ Supplier/ Contractor:
 - 1.2.1. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor commit to take all measures to preve nt corruption and will not directly or indirectly influence any decision or ben efit which he is not legally entitled to nor will act or omit in any manner whi ch tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian P enal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India.
 - 1.2.2. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will, when presenting his bid, disclose any and all payments he has made, and is committed to or intends to make to agents, brokers or any other intermediaries in connection with the award of the contract and shall adhere to relevant guidelines issued from time to t ime by Govt. of India/ BHEL.
 - 1.2.3. The bidder/ supplier/ contractor will perform/ execute the contract as per the contract terms & conditions and will not default without any reasona ble cause, which causes loss of

business/ money/ reputation, to BHEL.

If any bidder/ supplier/ contractor during pre-tendering/ tendering/ post tendering/ award/ execution/ post-execution stage indulges in malpractices, cheating, bribery, fraud or and other misconduct or formation of cartel so as to influen ce the bidding process or influence the price or acts or omits in any manner which tantamount to an offence punishable under any provision of the Indian Penal Code, 1860 or any other law in force in India, then, action may be taken against such bidder/ supplier/ contractor as per extant guidelines of the company available on www. bhel.com and/or under applicable legal provisions.

4. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agr eement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). Thi s applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contra cts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict comp etitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.

In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

5. CONFLICT OF INTEREST AMONG BIDDERS/ AGENTS

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. **The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.** A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a. they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b. they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them: or
- c. they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
- d. they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, $\underline{\text{that put}}$ $\underline{\text{s them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of anothe r Bidder; <math>\underline{\text{or}}$
- e. Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are i nvolved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components/ sub-assembly/ Assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or
- f. In cases of agents quoting in offshore procurements, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorise only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:
 - 1. The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
 - 2. Indian/foreign agent on behalf of only one principal,

- g. A Bidder or any of its affiliates participated as a consultant in the preparation of the desig n or technical specifications of the contract that is the subject of the Bid; or
- h. In case of a holding company having more than one independently manufacturing units, o r more than one unit having common business ownership/management, only one unit sho uld quote. Similar restrictions would apply to closely related sister companies. Bidders mu st proactively declare such sister/ common business/ management units in same/ similar line of business."
- 6. The contractor shall obtain Licence from Competent Authority under Inter Sta te Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act, 1979 in case contractor engages in any day five or more workmen recruited fr om outside the state of Uttarakhand in which BHEL, HEEP, Haridwar located. The contractor shall submit a valid licence under Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and Condition of Service) Act, 1979 to Contract Execution department on or before the commencement of contract. Further contractor has to ensure all the compliances of the provisions of Inter State Migrant Workmen (Regulation of Employment and condition of Service) Act, 1979.
- 7. Contractor shall provide necessary Uniform, Shoes and PPEs to the staff engaged in the contract.
- 8. For contract value Rs. 5,00,000/- (including GST) and above following shall be applicable:

"BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim(s) by BHEL towards loss of life / p ermanent disability due to an accident which is attributable to the negligence of contractor, agenc y or firm or any of its employees as detailed below:

- a) Victim: Any person who suffers permanent disablement or dies in an accident as defined bel
- b) Accident: Any death or permanent disability resulting solely and directly from any unintende d and unforeseen injurious occurrence caused during the manufacturing/ operation and work s incidental thereto at BHEL factories/ offices and precincts thereof, project execution, erecti on and commissioning, services, repairs and maintenance, trouble shooting, serving, overha ul, renovation and retrofitting, trial operation, performance guarantee testing undertaken by the company or during any works / during working at BHEL Units/ Offices/ townships and pre mises/ Project Sites.
- c) Compensation in respect of each of the victims:
 - In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: ₹10, 00,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs)
 - (ii) In the event of other permanent disability: ₹7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs)

Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the proviso to Section 2 (I) of the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923."

- d) Permanent Disablement: A disablement that is classified as a permanent total disablement u nder the proviso to Section 2 (I) of the Employee's Compensation Act, 1923."
 - A. The Contractor shall necessarily buy Death cum Accidental insurance policy for all of his workforce to be deployed under the contract before commencement of work. The insurance Policy should cover the following compensation in respect of each of the victims:
 - (i) In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: ₹10,00

,000/- (Rupees Ten Lakhs)

- (ii) In the event of other permanent disability: ₹7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs)
- B. The Contractor shall Indemnify and keep BHEL indemnified against any loss/claim which is brought against BHEL by third party on account of any negligence of the contractor or his workforce, while carrying out the services under the contract.
- C. NOTWITHSTANDING ANYTHING ABOVE, BHEL shall recover from the Contractor for any I oss suffered by BHEL due to any negligence of the contractor or his workforce, while car rying out the services under the contract.
- D. The bidder(s) have to assess the premium of insurance cover for the entire contract peri od. Bidders should include the impact of cost of insurance cover in their quote itself."
- 9. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which wo uld include interest (Repo rate + 4%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder.

This bid has Floor price (minimum value) of Rs. 46,57,000/- (Inclusive of GST) (Rupees Forty-Six Lacs and Fifty-Seven Thousand only). Service Providers (Bidders) are advised to quote above the minimum floor value otherwise their offer shall be rejected.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

- 1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
- 2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
- 3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
- 4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
- 5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
- 6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
- 7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
- 8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
- 9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.

- 10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
- 11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
- 12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
- 13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
- 14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
