Following terms and conditions supersede all existing "Buyer added Bid Specific Terms and conditions" given in the bid document or any previous corrigendum. Prospective bidders are advised to bid as per following Terms and Conditions:

Buyer Added Bid Specific Additional Terms and Conditions

1. Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

CORRIGENDUM 1 dated 19.03.2025

1. Due to typographical issues in Price Bid format uploaded in excel during bid creation, bidder to kindly note the following:

a. Audit charges to be read as Training charges

b. Total business volume to be considered as 113 mandays in place of 488 man days

c. 113 training man days to be considered for quoting in the price bid format.

d. Further bidders to refer section VII- Price Schedule format mentioned in ATC document while uploading price bid format in GeM Portal

e. Bidders can convert PDF format (as mentioned in Section VII-Price Schedule of ATC) to excel format while uploading price bid in GeM Portal

2. Kindly note that all other terms and conditions are as per ATC and remains unchanged.

3. For any clarifications, bidder may contact BHEL as per contact details mentioned in ATC.

Also Bidder to note following:

1. As per Clause no: A of Section II of ATC (PQR) , During last 3 (three) financial years of 2021-22, 2022-23 and 2023-24:

(i) Bidder should have earned average annual revenue of minimum INR 20,00,00,000. (INR 20 Crores)

(ii) Bidder should have positive net worth as on audited statement of Financial Year 2023-24.

(iii) Bidder shall have earned profit in at least one year (specified above)

Above term of PQR shall prevail in conflict (if any)

2. All other PQR and Tender conditions are mentioned in Buyer Uploaded ATC. Bidder to refer the same prior to bidding in NIT through GeM Portal.

3. Generation of Invoice/Billing shall not be done through GeM Portal. All the invoices/bills/tacklers shall be generated offline to respective Consignee/ BHEL Divisions (List of consignees available in Tender Specification) and payments will be processed by respective Consignee/ BHEL Division outside GeM only.

4. All the documents required with bid shall be uploaded by the bidder on GeM portal only.

5. Bidder to note that bids of only those bidder(s) shall be evaluated who meet the Pre Qualifying requirements as mentioned in ATC.

6. Bidder should be GST registered in GeM Portal

7. Bidder may seek clarifications from GeM in case of following:

a. Procedure for creation of Bid in GeM Portal

b. ITC based evaluation

c. Procedure to participate in RA as per GeM guidelines in case bidder is qualified to take part in RA

8. BHEL shall not be responsible for any issues arising out of bidding in GeM Portal as per standard down procedure of GeM platform.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. If any clause(s) is / are incorporated by the Buyer regarding following, the bid and resultant contracts shall be treated as null and void and such bids may be cancelled by GeM at any stage of bidding process without any notice:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process. (However, in bids for [attached categories](#), trials are allowed as per approved procurement policy of the buyer nodal Ministries)
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.
15. Any ATC clause in contravention with GeM GTC Clause 4 (xiii)(h) will be invalid. In case of multiple L1 bidders against a service bid, the buyer shall place the Contract by selection of a bidder amongst the L-1 bidders through a Random Algorithm executed by GeM system.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
