The minimum average annual financial turnover of the bidder during the last three years, ending on 31st March of the previous financial year, should be as indicated above in the bid document. 2. Audited Financial documents of FY 2019-20 & 2020-21 & 2021-22 shall be furnished in support of Turnover and this requirement shall supersede other Turnover parameters cited elsewhere. If financial statements are not required to be audited statutorily, then instead of audited financial statements, financial statements are required to be certified by Chartered Accountant.

In case of audited Financial statements have not been submitted for all the three years as indicated against Financial Turnover QR (Qualifying requirement) above, then the applicable audited statements submitted by the bidders against the requisite three years, will be averaged for three years i.e. total divided by three.

iii) Only Profilers (Bidders having own factory with facility for profiling plain coil/sheets) shall be eligible to qualify for this tender. Dealers/Traders shall not be eligible to qualify against this tender and their offer shall not be considered. Bidders have to furnish list of Plant and Machinery, Manufacturing facilities, quality control details, List of manpower etc. along with offer.

Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
