If the bidder wants to avail the Purchase preference, the bidder must be the manufacturer of the offered product in case of bid for supply of goods. Traders are excluded from the purview of Public Procurement Policy for Micro and Small Enterprises. In respect of bid for Services, the bidder must be the Service provider of the offered Service. Relevant documentary evidence in this regard shall be uploaded along with the bid in respect of the offered product or service. If L-1 is not an MSE and MSE Seller (s) has/have quoted price within L-1+ 15% (Selected by Buyer) of margin of purchase preference /price band defined in relevant policy, such Seller shall be given opportunity to match L-1 price and contract will be awarded for 25%(selected by Buyer) percentage of total QUANTITY.

Buyer Added Bid Specific Terms and Conditions

1. Generic

OPTION CLAUSE: The Purchaser reserves the right to increase or decrease the quantity to be ordered up to 25 percent of bid quantity at the time of placement of contract. The purchaser also reserves the right to increase the ordered quantity by up to 25% of the contracted quantity during the currency of the contract at the contracted rates. Bidders are bound to accept the orders accordingly.

2. Buyer Added Bid Specific ATC

Buyer Added text based ATC clauses

1) PRE QUALIFICATION CRITERIA:

1a) Previous Experience: The bidder should have supplied similar items atleast once in the last 3 years. Please provide a copy of the Purchase order for the same.

1b) Relaxation of Norms for Startups: The condition of Prior Turnover and prior experience is relaxed for all startups whether Micro & Small Enterprises(MSEs) or otherwise subject to meeting of quality and technical specifications in accordance with the relevant provision of GFR,2005 and other DOEPPD notifications for relaxation norms for startups issued from time to time.

2)Payment term: 100% payment shall be made within the stipulated days as mentioned below from the date of receipt and acceptance of materials after installation and commissioning at BHEL Corporate R&D Vikasnagar, Hyderabad Type of bidder :

- For Micro & Small enterprises(MSEs) payment will be made with in 45 days
- For Medium Enterprises will be made with in 60 days
- Non MSMEs will be made with in 90 days

However, GST Portion of Invoice shall be released only upon:

- Vendor declaring the Invoice in their GSTR-1.
- Receipt of Goods and Tax Invoice by BHEL.
- Confirmation of Payment of GST thereon by vendor on GSTN

3) Restriction under rule 144(xi) of GFR: Submit the Annexure-A uploaded in ATC document.

4)PBG: PBG of 10% of total order value is to be submitted by the successful vendor within 15 days from the date of acceptance of item at BHEL R&D,Hyd and shall be kept valid upto guarantee period with additional claim period of 3 to 6 months there after.The offers of the suppliers not accepting to this clause will be rejected. PBG format attached.

5) Interest for delayed submission of PBG: Bidder agrees to submit performance security required for execution of contract within 15 days from the date of acceptance of item. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate + 6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/Contract, from the bills along with due interest.

6)Warranty Clause: Minimum of 12 Months from the date of receipt and acceptance of the product.

Disclaimer

The additional terms and conditions have been incorporated by the Buyer after approval of the Competent Authority in Buyer Organization, whereby Buyer organization is solely responsible for the impact of these clauses on the bidding process, its outcome, and consequences thereof including any eccentricity / restriction arising in the bidding process due to these ATCs and due to modification of technical specifications and / or terms and conditions governing the bid. Any clause(s) incorporated by the Buyer regarding following shall be treated as null and void and would not be considered as part of bid:-

1. Definition of Class I and Class II suppliers in the bid not in line with the extant Order / Office Memorandum issued by DPIIT in this regard.
2. Seeking EMD submission from bidder(s), including via Additional Terms & Conditions, in contravention to exemption provided to such sellers under GeM GTC.
3. Publishing Custom / BOQ bids for items for which regular GeM categories are available without any Category item bunched with it.
4. Creating BoQ bid for single item.
5. Mentioning specific Brand or Make or Model or Manufacturer or Dealer name.
6. Mandating submission of documents in physical form as a pre-requisite to qualify bidders.
7. Floating / creation of work contracts as Custom Bids in Services.
8. Seeking sample with bid or approval of samples during bid evaluation process.
9. Mandating foreign / international certifications even in case of existence of Indian Standards without specifying equivalent Indian Certification / standards.
10. Seeking experience from specific organization / department / institute only or from foreign / export experience.
11. Creating bid for items from irrelevant categories.
12. Incorporating any clause against the MSME policy and Preference to Make in India Policy.
13. Reference of conditions published on any external site or reference to external documents/clauses.
14. Asking for any Tender fee / Bid Participation fee / Auction fee in case of Bids / Forward Auction, as the case may be.

Further, if any seller has any objection/grievance against these additional clauses or otherwise on any aspect of this bid, they can raise their representation against the same by using the Representation window provided in the bid details field in Seller dashboard after logging in as a seller within 4 days of bid publication on GeM. Buyer is duty bound to reply to all such representations and would not be allowed to open bids if he fails to reply to such representations.
