Copies of relevant contracts to be submitted along with bid in support of having supplied some quantity during each of the Financial year. In case of bunch bids, the category of primary product having highest value should meet this criterion.
2. Estimated Bid Value indicated above is being declared solely for the purpose of guidance on EMD amount and for determining the Eligibility Criteria related to Turn Over, Past Performance and Project / Past Experience etc. This has no relevance or bearing on the price to be quoted by the bidders and is also not going to have any impact on bid participation. The tax shall be deducted at the rate of 0.1%, which shall be increased to 5% if the seller does not provide his PAN. (w.e.f. 1st day of July 2021)

N) NON-FILER OF INCOME TAX RETURN SHALL BE SUBJECT TO TDS/TCS AT HIGHER RATES (SECTION 206AB AND SECTION 206CCA):

Ø The Finance Act 2021 inserts these sections to provide for deduction and collection of TDS and TCS at the higher rates in case of non-filers of the income tax return for preceding two years (provided total TDS deducted / TCS collected exceeds Rs. 50,000 in each of the two preceding years). The rate of TDS/TCS shall be at the double of the specified rate or 5%, whichever is higher.
