- 16. Settlement of Disputes:

If any dispute, controversy or claim arising out of, relating to, or in connection with, this contract, or t breach, termination or validity thereof, arises, both parties hereto shall endeavor to settle such disputationally. Should this attempt fail, the disputes between the parties shall be resolved through arbitration in accordance with the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996. The attempt to bring about an amical settlement is considered to have failed as soon as one of the parties hereto, after reasonable attempt (which attempt shall continue for not less than 30 days); give 30 days' notice, in writing, invoking arbitration and calling upon the other party to constitute the tribunal as provided.

All or any such disputes or differences arising between the parties to this contract shall be referred to n Arbitral Tribunal consisting of single arbitrators. Sole arbitrator shall be appointed on mutually agreby both the parties.

The place of arbitration shall be New Delhi for foreign vendors. The language of arbitration shall be Ei ish. The substantive law applicable to the substance of the dispute shall be the Indian Law. GISTC cla e may be referred for this clause.

For Indigenous Source. The venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar Courts, which will have exclusive j sdiction.

17. **Conciliation Clause**: Model conciliation clause for conduction conciliation proceedings under the Bh conciliation scheme, 2018 will be applicable against this enquiry.

18. Arbitration Clause:

In case of any dispute arising out of or in connection with this contract, the same shall be referred to bitration under Arbitration & Conciliation Act 1996 of a sole arbitrator who shall be appointed by muti consent of the parties. The seat & venue of arbitration shall be Haridwar. The proceedings shall be coucted in English. The governing law of the contract shall be the substantive Law of India.

19. Breach of contract, Remedies and Termination

In case of breach of contract, recovery of 10% of total contract value shall be applicable. Recovery shall be done by encashing security instruments like Contract Execution Bank Guarantee, rformance bank guarantee, EMD. In case value of security instruments available is less than 10° of the contract value, the balance amount be recovered from other financial remedies (i.e. available bills of the contractor, retention amount, etc. with BHEL) or legal remedies shall be pursued urther, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure, etc., shabe applied as per provisions of the contract.

20. Force Majeure Clause

- a. Either party shall be entitled to suspend performance of his obligations under the contract the extent that such performance is impeded or made unreasonably onerous by any of the fowing circumstances: fire, war, flood, riots, earthquake etc.
- b. The party claiming to be affected by force majeure shall notify the other party in writing imdiately without delay on the intervention and on the cessation of such circumstances. If force ajeure prevents the purchaser from fulfilling his obligations, he shall not be forced to compens e the contractor for expenses.
- c. Regardless of what might otherwise follow from these general conditions, either party shall entitled to terminate the contract by notice in writing to the other party if performance of the ntract remains suspended under Clause Force Majeure for more than 6 months.
- d. Evidence for this would be "Force Majeure" certificate issued by chamber of commerce of the conc ned country.

21. Action against Bidders / vendor / supplier / contractor in case of default:

In order to protect the commercial interests of BHEL, BHEL shall take action against supplies / contract rs by way of suspension of business dealings, who either fail to perform or are in default without any asonable cause, cause loss of business/ money/ reputation, indulge in malpractices, cheating, bribery raud or any other misconduct or formation of cartels so as to influence the bidding process or influence the price etc.

Suspension of Business Dealings could be in the form of "Hold" or "Banning" a supplier/ contractor or
