15.	Over Run Compensation (ORC) (As per GCC clause 2.12)	Not Applicable.
16.	T&Ps and MMES (TCC Chapter-IV)	All T&Ps are to be provided by the Contractor as per Chapter-IV of TCC. BHEL shall not provide any T&Ps for this scope of work. All T&Ps required for handling of items / materials to be arranged by bidder refer Chapter-V of TCC.
17.	T&PS AND MMES to be provided by BHEL (TCC Chapter-V)	Nil
