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#### II - GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS:

## PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

The lease period shall normally either Three years or Five years, which shall be indicated in individual tender(s).

The bidder may have to submit Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) & Security Deposit depending on the individual tender requirement. The details of these deposits shall be provided in the respective tenders.

#### **EVALUATION:**

Tender(s) shall be evaluated normally through two part bid process. The offer shall be submitted in **Two** parts consisting of Techno-Commercial and Price Bids.

The technical & commercial bid should not include prices.

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#### BANK CHARGES:

Unless otherwise specified, the Bank charges, if any, shall be to the account of Vendor/Lessor.

#### INSURANCE:

Insurance for the complete Systems/Equipment shall be arranged by the Vendor/Lessor at his own risk and cost, throughout the period of lease. BHEL under any circumstances, will not be responsible for any loss/damage/theft of any Systems/goods, due to any reasons, whatsoever. Claim(s) etc., if any, will be dealt with the underwriters directly by the Vendor/Lessor.

#### **WARRANTY & MAINTENANCE:**

The warranty and maintenance of equipment shall be undertaken by the vendor/lessor, for the entire contract period from the date of installation.

The warranty and maintenance will be comprehensive with spares and labour. The maintenance will be inclusive of replacement of all defective components during the warranty period.

Service provider shall position experienced resident service engineer/s wherever applicable. The details will be as per individual tender requirement.

Periodic preventive maintenance shall be carried out and closure of Corrective maintenance / breakdown calls shall be attended and rectified as per Service Level Agreements of individual tender(s).

The successful bidder shall provide spares/standby equipment at BHEL as per terms and conditions of individual tenders.
