- 1. The software & Hardware for analysis & display of vibrations in polar, orbit & transient mode and feature for display of vibration spectrum up to 500 Hz, as and when required may be offered as optional items.
- Software, if any required for interpretation of any of the test results shall also be offered as an optional item.
