



(STALL B 13 (91 sq.m. - 13 m x 7 m) - HALL 12)









### **APPROVED 3D STALL DESIGN**























- 2. The bidder should accept all terms & conditions of the tender unconditionally. Any deviation to BHEL terms and conditions mentioned anywhere in the tender document shall not be considered and may lead to outright rejection of such offer.
- 3. The bidders are advised to obtain all the necessary information related to the scope of work/ specifications before submitting their offers. Any queries regarding this tender may be clarified from Ujjwal Tomar, Dy. Manager (Corp. Comm.) on landline no. 011-66337399 or e-mail: ujjwal@bhel.in.
- 4. clearance of all the liabilities on agency's part. No claim will be entertained after signing the final bill.

- (ii) Payment shall be made as per the actual nos. of BOQ items executed.
- (iii) Bills raised by the Agency shall be certified by the official in-charge of BHEL and the payments will be made against final bill, within 60 days by NEFT/RTGS from the date of receipt of bill subject to conditions mentioned at Taxes & Duties.   - i. In accordance with the rules of procedure of the Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996.
  - ii. The place of Arbitration shall be the place from which the contract is issued or such other place as the Arbitrator at his discretion may determine.
  - iii. The language of the Arbitration Proceedings shall be English.
  - iv. The law governing the arbitration proceeding shall be the Indian law and
  - v. The cost of arbitration shall be borne equally by the parties.

If the Agency / Contractor fails to provide the required services as per the Contract / fails to deliver the services thereof within the period(s) fixed for such delivery of the contracted quality and failing to adhere to the contract specifications or at any time repudiates or otherwise abandons the contract before expiry of such period or refuses or is unable to supply services covered by the Order/Contract either in whole or in part or otherwise fails to perform the Order/Contract or commits any breach of the Order/Contract not herein specifically provided for or in the event of the death or insanity or if the Seller/Contractor being an individual or if a firm on a partnership thereof, shall at any time, be adjudged insolvent or shall have a receiving order for administration of his estate made against him or shall take any proceeding for composition under any Insolvency Act for the time being in force or make any assignment of the Order/Contract or enter into any arrangement or composition with his creditors or suspend payment or if the firm dissolved under the Partnership Act or if the Seller/Contractor (Agency) being a company is wound up

- or similar labour difficulty (b) late delivery of equipment or material (unless caused by Force Majeure event) and (c) economic hardship.
- b) If either party is prevented, hindered or delayed from or in performing any of its obligations under the Contract by an event of Force Majeure, then it shall notify the other in writing of the occurrence of such event and the circumstances thereof within 02 (two) days after the occurrence of such event.
- c) The party who has given such notice shall be excused from the performance or punctual performance of its obligations under the Contract for so long as the relevant event of Force
