1.	Pre-Bid Meeting with Interested Bidders (NIT Clause 1.0 (x))	1. Facilitate better understanding of the Project Requirements; 2. Clarifying any ambiguities in the bidding documents
2.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) [NIT Clause 1.0 (vii)]	Rs. 40,00,000/- (Rupees Forty Lakh Only)
3.	Price Variation Compensation (TCC clause 7.7)	The Price Variation Clause is applicable for the contract in line with the Revised PRICE VARIATION CLAUSE, CLAUSE 12.0 OF Customer SCC (Rev. 02) attached as Appendix-2 along with the tender document mentioned at Chapter-X of TCC. <i>Base Date</i> shall be deemed to be the Last Date of Bid Submission
4.	Over Run Compensation (ORC)	Not Applicable
6.	T&Ps and MMEs	All the T & P required for the execution of the package till handing over of the Unit to end customer shall be in the scope of Bidder.
7.	Duration of Contract	28 months for completion of Supplies, Installation, Commissioning, PG Test till Acceptance of the overall system. Time Period of the O&M services shall be 5 years from the date of Preliminary Acceptance Certificate issued by the customer. (Refer Chapter IV of TCC)
8.	Security Deposit (SD) (GCC Clause 1.10)	5% of Contract Value of Individual PO/WO/LOA and shall be furnished within 30 days of issuance of PO/WO/LOA.

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9.	Retention Amount (RA) (GCC Clause 2.19)	5% of contract value of Individual PO/WO/LOA and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment. On successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected.
10.	Reverse Auction (NIT Clause 19.0)	Not Applicable
11.	Ordering Philosophy (Clause 35.0 of NIT)	1. LOA shall be given to successful bidder for the entire scope of work by CPC upon finalization of the package. 2. Subsequently in line with the PRICE FORMAT, CPC will release separate PO/WO as mentioned below, for execution/ billing for the value as derived from the approved BBU in the following manner: A. For Supply of Goods and Spares for the portion of Scope of Works. B. For Installation Services, Erection and Commissioning, Equipment trial, Integrated Trial Operation of System, PG Test. C. For O&M services of AHP Package from the date of Preliminary Acceptance of the Coal and Ash Handling Plant up to 5 years. Being an EPC Package including Design, Engineering, Installation and O&M Services, the package is treated as a single package and is indivisible in nature 3. BHEL shall reserve the right to divide/redistribute the ordering in some other manner as well (if required) at any point during ordering stage in order to have smooth operation/ execution. Decision of BHEL in this regard shall be final and binding on the vendor/ contractor. 4. The division of package during ordering, as mentioned above, shall not in any way dilute the responsibility of the seller/ Contractor for the

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		successful completion of the Facilities as per Technical Specifications and Terms & Conditions and a breach in one part/ order shall automatically be construed as a breach of the other part (s)/ Order (s) which will confer a right on the BHEL to take action on the seller/ contractor as per the terms & conditions on the other part (s)/ Order (s) also.
12.	Payment Terms	Refer Chapter-VII of TCC For Non-MSME Vendors, Payment shall be made within 90 Days. For Medium Enterprises, Payment shall be made within 60 Days. For Micro and Small Enterprises (MSEs), Payment shall be made within 45 Days.
13.	Facilities Matrix in the scope of Bidder/BHEL:	Refer Chapter-II of TCC.
14.	Labour and Staff Colony:	Labour colony is to be developed by bidder for all the labours required to be deployed for the works. All labour colony set-up is to be developed as per attached drawing and in compliance of statutory requirements.
	Construction power	Refer Chapter-II of TCC, Clause 2.12 Construction power (three phase, 415 V/ 440 V) will be provided near the site at the identified locations by BHEL and Bidder at a distance of approx. 500M free of cost. Further, distribution shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and services. Construction power (three phase, 415 V/ 440 V) for office, stores, canteen etc. within the site premises will be provided on chargeable basis near the site at a distance of approx. 500M. Further, distribution shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and services.
15.	Construction water	Refer Chapter-II of TCC, Clause 2.13 Construction water shall be arranged by BHEL free of cost (at single point source). Bidder has to make arrangement of further distribution of water at his

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		own cost. No extra payment shall be made under this account. Successful bidder to satisfy himself that the water drawn by him is fit for construction / consumption and adequately treat such water at his cost when it is not found fit for the said purposes.
16.	O&M PHILOSOPHY	Refer Chapter-VII of TCC, Clause 7.5 Bidder has to undertake Operation and Maintenance (O&M) services for Ash Handling plant system installed by bidder (including all free issues which are integral part of the system) from the date of Preliminary Acceptance of the Ash Handling plant up to 5 years. The Bidder shall be responsible for the supply of all such consumables throughout the entire O&M period of five (5) years without any additional financial implication to the Purchaser, other than the O&M Service Charges payable under the Contract. The O&M Service Charges shall be paid at the rate of 5% of the Awarded Contract Price (excluding taxes and duties) for the first year of O&M. For each subsequent year, the O&M Service Charges shall be escalated by 3% over the charges payable for the immediately preceding year.
17.	INSURANCE	Refer Chapter-II of TCC, Clause 3.16 Inland Transit cum Storage and E&C Insurance shall be in BHEL Scope.
