

MAJOR HIGHLIGHTS OF THE TENDER

BROAD SCOPE OF JOB: Manufacturing of Crushed Stone Sand from Excavated Rock Boulders inside the plant premises including sorting and feeding of boulders, storage of sand at crusher site, disposal of silt/clay/rejects to the designated site and loading of Sand to the prospective consumer's vehicle from crusher site at 2x660 MW Talcher Thermal Power Station, Odisha and 2x800 MW Singrauli STPP- Stage-III, Sonbhadra, Uttar Pradesh.

1.	Pre-Bid Meeting with Interested Bidders (NIT Clause 1.0 (X))	1. Facilitate better understanding of the Project Requirements; 2. Clarifying any ambiguities in the bidding documents.
2.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) [NIT Clause 1.0 (X) and GCC Clause 1.9]	Reduced EMD amount (Rs. 20 Lakh only)
3.	Interest Free Mobilization Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.1)	5% of the Contract Value in three instalments as specified in TCC. (Chapter 7 of TCC)
4.	Secured Advance Against Material Brought to Site (GCC Clause 2.13.3)	Limited to 5% of the Contract Value.
5.	Interest Bearing Mobilization Advance and Additional Interim Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.2)	Up to 10% of the Contract Value against adequate Security/BG.
6.	Quantity Variation (GCC Clause 2.14.2)	Provision is kept for revision of rates for individual BOQ item(s) in the event the executed quantity exceeds two times the quantity in the original price schedule.
7.	Procurement at Risk and Cost of bidder, in case of default of Contractor is removed (replaced by "Breach of Contract" clause) ("Rights of BHEL" - GCC Clause 2.7)	The total liability on account of Breach of Contract is limited to 10% of the Contract Value.
8.	Demobilization and remobilization of Contractor (GCC Clause 2.7.7)	BHEL may permit the contractor to demobilize and remobilize in some specified situations, other than Force majeure conditions, not attributable to contractor.
9.	Security Deposit (SD) (GCC Clause 1.10)	5% of Contract Value and shall be furnished before Commencement of Work. SD to be released after completion of Guarantee Period.
10.	Retention Amount (RA) (GCC Clause 2.22)	5% of contract value and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment. On successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected. RA to be released along with Final Bill.

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11.	Price Variation Compensation (GCC clause 2.17)	Not Applicable.
12.	Over Run Compensation (ORC) As per GCC clause 2.12)	Not Applicable.
13.	Reverse Auction (NIT Clause 19.0)	Applicable. Elimination Criteria in Reverse Auction is as below: <ul style="list-style-type: none"> a) In case 4 Techno Commercial Qualified bidder: - One (01) bidder is to be eliminated; b) In case 5 Techno Commercial Qualified bidder: - Two (02) bidders are to be eliminated; c) In case 6 or more than 6 Techno Commercial Qualified bidders: - 50% bidders are to be eliminated. <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • No elimination for class-1 local supplier, in case their quoted price comes within L1 + 20% band as per PPP-MII.
14.	BOCW Cess (TCC Chapter – VIII, Clause 8.4)	Not to be borne by Bidder.
15.	DIVISIBLE CONTRACT (TCC Chapter-II, Clause 2.5)	Bidder shall note that separate orders shall be placed in line with Price Schedule for: A) 2x660 MW Talcher Thermal Power Station, Odisha B) 2x800 MW Singrauli STPP- Stage-III, Sonbhadra, U.P.
16.	T&Ps and MMEs (TCC Chapter-IV)	All T&Ps are to be provided by the Contractor as per Chapter-IV of TCC. BHEL shall not provide any T&Ps for this scope of work.
17.	Labour and Staff Colony (TCC Chapter – III, Clause 3.2)	All arrangement and facilities regarding labour and staff is in the scope of contractor.
18.	Construction Power: (TCC Chapter – III, Clause 3.3)	Construction power (three phase, 415 V/ 440 V) will be provided on chargeable basis at one point near the site at a distance of approx. 500M.
19.	Construction Water (TCC Chapter – III, Clause 3.4)	Construction water shall be supplied by BHEL free of cost. Bidder has to make arrangement of further distribution of water at his own cost. No extra payment shall be made under this account.
