1.	Pre-Bid Meeting with Interested Bidders (NIT Clause 1.0 (x))	1. Facilitate better understanding of the Project Requirements; 2. Clarifying any ambiguities in the bidding documents
2.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) [NIT Clause 1.0 (vii) and GCC Clause 1.9]	Rs. 50 (Fifty) Lakhs only
3.	Price Variation Compensation (TCC clause 7.7)	PVC shall be applicable for Ex-Works Price of Plant and Equipment, Mandatory Spares, Installation Price Component of Contract Price, Civil and Structural Works price component of Contract Price as per Appendix-K (PVC) of TCC
4.	Over Run Compensation (ORC)	Not Applicable
5.	Secured Recoverable Advances	Applicable only for Total Civil (including site fabricated Structural) + Installation/ Erection Works in line with the Approved BBU. (Refer Clause 7.10 of TCC & Clause 2.12 of GCC)
6.	T&Ps and MMEs	All the T & P required for the execution of the package till handing over of the Unit to end customer shall be in the scope of Bidder
7.	Duration of Contract	32 months (Refer Chapter IV of TCC)
8.	Security Deposit (SD) (GCC Clause 1.10)	5% of Contract Value of Individual Work Order and shall be furnished within 30 days of issuance of Work Order.
9.	Retention Amount (RA) (GCC Clause 2.19)	5% of contract value of Individual WO and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment. On successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected.
10.	Reverse Auction (NIT Clause 19.0)	Applicable

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11.	Modality of Award (Clause 35.0 of NIT)	<ol style="list-style-type: none">1. LOA shall be given to successful bidder for the entire scope of work by CPC upon finalization of the package.2. Subsequently, Successful Bidder shall submit the broad BBU/Price Break-Up in line with the clause no 7.9 of TCC and as per format in chapter-19 of TCC within 7 days from date of LOA.3. Based on Approved BBU/Price Break-up, CPC will release separate Work Order as mentioned below, for execution/ billing for the value as derived from the approved Price Break-up in the following manner:<ol style="list-style-type: none">A. For Supply of Goods and Mandatory Spares for the portion of Scope of Works.B. For E&C, PG Test, Handing Over including O&M Services etc for the portion of Scope of Works.C. For Civil and Structural Package for the portion of Scope of Works.4. BHEL shall reserve the right to divide/redistribute the ordering in some other manner as well (if required) at any point during ordering stage in order to have smooth operation/ execution. Decision of BHEL in this regard shall be final and binding on the vendor/ contractor.5. The division of package during ordering, as mentioned above, shall not in any way dilute the responsibility of the seller/ Contractor for the successful completion of the Facilities as per Technical Specifications and Terms & Conditions and a breach in one part/ order shall automatically be construed as a breach of the other part (s)/ Order (s) which will confer a right on the BHEL to take action on the seller/ contractor as per the terms & conditions on the other part (s)/ Order (s) also.

13.	Construction Power:	<p>Refer Chapter-II of TCC, Clause 2.14</p> <p>Construction power (three phase, 415 V/ 440 V) shall be provided by BHEL free of cost at one point near the site at a distance of approx. 500M. Further, distribution shall be arranged by the contractor at his own cost and services.</p> <p>However, contractor has to deploy DG Sets to meet power requirement in case of delay in availability of single source or any kind of power interruptions during the course of the project at no extra cost to BHEL.</p>
14.	Construction water	<p>Refer Chapter-II of TCC, Clause 2.15</p> <p>BHEL shall provide water supply free of cost (at single point source) for construction. Contractor has to make arrangement of further distribution. However, contractor</p>

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		<p>shall make alternate arrangement of construction water till the same is made available by BHEL.</p> <p>The Contractor should make arrangements for storage of sufficient quantity of water required for work. The agency should also construct sumps (if required) of suitable size for storage of construction water as per their requirement for use for execution and construction purposes.</p> <p>Contractor to satisfy himself that the water drawn/ arranged by him is fit for construction/ consumption and adequately treat such water at his cost when it is not found fit for the said purposes.</p> <p>In case of non-availability of water, the contractor shall make his own arrangements of water suitable for construction purpose to have uninterrupted work. No separate payment shall be made for any contingency arrangement made by contractor.</p>
15.	Open Space for storage	Refer Chapter-II Clause 2.1.1 (b.1) of TCC
16.	Labour / Worker's Accommodation Shed	Refer Chapter-II Clause 2.9 of TCC
