BROAD SCOPE OF JOB: Erection, Testing & Assistance for commissioning and Trial Operation of Balance Stage-II (Unit # 6) FGD System, Booster fans and its accessories, ducting from booster fan inlet gate to new chimney including duct supporting structure, Absorber & its accessories, Absorber Structure, JAS System, Mist Eliminator, Spray Nozzles, Elevator Structure, RC Pump along with motor & RC Shed, Gypsum bleed pump, Emergency Quench system, tanks, Slurry Pump along with motor and accessories, Oxidation blower along with motor and accessories, Valves, agitators, make-up water piping, wet/dry interface washing system, Piping (CS, SS, GI, FRP) for completion of system, Grating, Misc platforms, handrails etc., Application of Thermal Insulation including supply and application of Painting/Touch-up Painting, Collection/ Loading/ Unloading/ Transportation of Materials from BHEL/ Client's Stores/ Storage Yard and transportation to site of and Handing over of Flue Gas Desulphurization System (FGD) at 3X500 MW NTPC Korba, Stage-II, Chhattisgarh, India.

1.	Pre-Bid Meeting with Interested Bidders (NIT Clause 1.0 (X))	1. Facilitate better understanding of the Project Requirements; 2. Clarifying any ambiguities in the bidding documents.
2.	EMD AMOUNT) (NIT Clause 1.0 (vii) and GCC Clause 1.9)	Rs. 20,00,000/- (Rupees Twenty Lakh Only)
3.	Security Deposit (SD) (GCC Clause 1.10)	The successful Tenderer should deposit the 5% of the contract value as Security Deposit towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
4.	Retention Amount (RA) (GCC Clause 2.22)	5% of contract value and shall be furnished before the first RA Bill becomes due for payment. Alternatively, on successful bidder's request, the Retention Amount can also be recovered at the rate of 10% of the gross amount, progressively, from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required retention amount is collected. Retention Amount to be released along with Final Bill.

6.	Reverse Auction (NIT Clause 19.0)	Not Applicable.
7.	Price Variation Compensation (GCC clause 2.17)	Applicable.
8.	Over Run Compensation (ORC) (As per GCC clause 2.12)	Applicable.

Interest Free Mobilization Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.1)	Interest Free Secured Mobilization Advance as per GCC Clause No. 2.13.1 will be payable under exceptional circumstances on certification of BHEL Construction Manager at Site. Interest Free Mobilization Advance shall be disbursed in specifically mentioned stages of major respective resource mobilization as specified hereunder: 1. For Mobilization and installation of Site Infrastructure by contractor i.e. site office, stores etc-2% 2. For Mobilization of 40 MT crane at site for the work of FGD - 2% 3. For Mobilization of other resources and consumables at site to start the work of FGD as finalized with BHEL Engineer In-Charge – 1% (Refer Chapter 7 of TCC)
10.	Interest Free Mobilization Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.1)	5% of the Contract Value in three instalments as specified in TCC. (Chapter 7 of TCC)
11.	Secured Advance Against Material Brought to Site (GCC Clause 2.13.3)	Limited to 5% of the Contract Value.
12.	Procurement at Risk and Cost of bidder, in case of default of Contractor is removed (replaced by "Breach of Contract" clause)	The total liability on account of Breach of Contract is limited to 10% of the Contract Value.
13.	BOCW Cess (TCC Chapter – VIII, Clause 8.4)	Not to be borne by Bidder.
14.	T&Ps and MMEs (TCC Chapter-IV)	All T&Ps are to be provided by the Contractor as per Chapter-IV of TCC. BHEL shall provide T&Ps to Contractor on sharing basis as per Chapter-V of TCC.
15.	Construction Power: (Clause 3.10 of TCC Chapter - III)	The construction power (415V) will be provided at a single point for construction purpose only at chargeable basis and the further distribution is to be arranged by the bidder at his cost. Construction power shall be provided from the nearest Substation / tapping point.
16.	Construction Water (Clause 3.11 of TCC Chapter - III)	Water shall not be provided by BHEL and bidder has to make their own arrangement.
