1.	Pre-Bid Meeting with Interested Bidders	1. Facilitate better understanding of the Project Requirements; 2. Clarifying any ambiguities in the bidding documents.
2.	Earnest Money Deposit (EMD)	Reduced EMD amount (Rs. 50 Lakh only)
3.	Price Variation Compensation	PVC shall be applicable for Supply, & E&C portions, Civil and Structural Package as per Appendix-2 (PVC).
4.	Over Run Compensation (ORC)	Not Applicable
5.	Quantity Variation	Not Applicable for the Project
6.	Interest Free Mobilization Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.1)	5% of the Contract Value in three instalments as specified in TCC. (Chapter 7 of TCC)
7.	Interest Bearing Mobilization Advance and Additional Interim Advance (GCC Clause 2.13.2)	Up to 10% of the Contract Value against adequate Security/BG.
8.	Duration of Contract	33 months
9.	Security Deposit	Security Deposit shall be 5% of Contract value of Individual LOA and to be furnished within 30 days of issuance of LOA.
10.	Payment Terms	Refer. Chapter –VII of TCC.
11.	Reverse Auction	Applicable as per RA Guidelines-2024. Elimination Criteria in Reverse Auction is as below: a) Less than 4 Techno Commercial Qualified bidder: - No elimination b) In case 4 or more than 4 Techno Commercial Qualified bidders: - only H-1 bidder to be eliminated No elimination for class-1 local supplier, in case their quoted price comes within L1 + 20% band as per PPP-MII and L-1 bidder as per Price Bid shall be Non-Local Bidder.
12.	Transit Insurance as per GCC Clause 3.13	Inland Transit cum Storage and E&C Insurance shall be in BHEL Scope. Complete project insurance is under BHEL scope.
13.	Construction Power: (Clause 2.11 of TCC Chapter - II)	Construction power shall be arranged by the BHEL free of cost however further distribution shall in bidder's scope of works.

14.	Construction Water (Clause 2.12 of TCC Chapter - II)	Construction water shall be arranged by BHEL. Successful bidder has to make arrangement of further distribution of water at his own cost. No extra payment shall be made under this account.
15.	Ordering Philosophy (As per clause 36.0 of NIT)	<ol style="list-style-type: none"> 1) LOI shall be given to successful bidder for the entire scope of work by CPC upon finalization of the package. 2) Subsequently, Successful Bidder shall submit the broad BBU in line with the clause no 7.7 of TCC as per the attached Annexure-19 of TCC within 7 days from date of LOI. 3) Based on Approved BBU, CPC will release separate LOA as mentioned below, for execution/ billing for the value as derived from the approved BBU in the following manner: <ol style="list-style-type: none"> a) For Supply of Goods for CHP, BMHP, LHP and GHP areas of work. b) For Supply of Goods for MRHS Package c) For E&C, PG Test, Handing Over including O&M Services etc for CHP, BMHP, LHP & GHP. d) For E&C, PG Test, Handing Over including O&M Services etc for MRHS Package. e) For Civil and Structural Package for the entire scope of works (CHP, BMHP, LHP & GHP and MRHS).
