Work category : - Material Stacking/shifting and Material Retrieval activities in TRM Div.

Nature of Work:- To accomplish all the activities for Material shifting and Material retrieval with help of **semi-skilled** manpower as per details given in NIT & as per the “Annexure- W”.

For the above mentioned work, price on per day basis is as per following:-

Notes:-

1. Bidder to quote the **Service Charge in Rupees on per day basis only, which should take care of all other statutory levies like leave, holidays, uniform, shoes, helmet, supervision/admin charges/margin etc or any hike in Basic, PF, ESI, Labour welfare contribution**, The quoted service charge should not be **Negative** and should be only **upto 2 decimal places**, otherwise such Price Bid shall be cancelled and the bidder shall be **disqualified**. If two firms happen to quote the **same Service Charge**, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders in sealed envelope. In case more than one bidder happen to occupy L-1 status, even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative(s) and ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final and binding.
2. The “**Final Rate on per Day Basis**” shall be equal to, “**Statutory Min Wage and compliances on per day basis on the day of awarding of work**” + “**Service charge quoted by bidder**” as per Table –A, and the “**Final Rate on per Man Hour Basis**” shall be equal to the “**Final Rate on per Day Basis**” divided by “8”.
3. This “**Final Rate arrived on per Man Hour Basis**” on the day of awarding of work will be taken as the **final Work Order Awarding Rate** on per Man Hour basis inclusive of PF, ESI, all other statutory Levies, leave/holiday, uniform, shoes, helmet, supervision/admin charges/margin etc. **but Excluding of the GST and Bonus**. It shall **remain firm throughout the contract period** and **no variation/escalation** what so ever during the contract period shall be allowed. Bonus shall be payable as per Payment of Bonus Act 1965, on actual basis for the contract period on submission of proof of payment with the last bill of the contract and **shall be restricted to the amount of Rs 3.71 per man hr**. Instant arrangement nowhere intends to affix responsibility of payment of bonus on BHEL
4. Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature of person signing the bid else the bid shall be liable for rejection. . All overwriting/cutting, etc will be numbered by bid opening officials and announced during bid opening. The firm should take care to fill up the rate, it should be legible and should be in the price bid provided with tender documents or else the bid shall be liable for rejection. No claim of confusion, unawareness etc shall be entertained after opening of bids.
5. **The bidder shall follow BHEL norms prevailing for wages to be paid to the contract workers. “The Contractor shall also be liable to pay hike in statutory minimum wages in October month & April month with additional wages recommended by BHEL”**
6. The GST shall be paid extra, as per the Govt. rules, as applicable. . Any loss/delay in Tax credit due to the reason attributable to the contractors shall be recovered from them along with interest. **TDS will be deducted both under GST Act and Income Tax Act.**
7. If there is a **discrepancy between words and figures**, the amount in words shall prevail, unless the amount expressed in words is related to an arithmetic error, in which case the amount in figures shall prevail. If there is such discrepancy in an offer, the same shall be conveyed to the bidder with target date up to which the bidder has to send his acceptance on the above lines and if the bidder does not agree to the decision of the purchaser, the bid is liable to be ignored.
