2.0 Instructions to Tenderer

2.1 Tender is a two part bid system. The tender documents consist of part '1' and part '2' as described below.

Part '1' Techno commercial Bid (To be sent in a wax sealed cover enabling us to open on the due date.

Part '2' Price Bid to be guoted as per tender conditions.

- 2.2 Part '1' must be duly completed sealed in a separate envelope superscribed "Techno Commercial bid-Tender number, MM/ OT/Ins. Cement/10-11 due on 26-12-2009. The tenderer shall not indicate the price or rate in the Technocommercial bid. The tender shall express and accept all the terms and conditions of the tender. The tender, which does not comply with BHEL's terms and conditions is liable to be rejected.
- 2.3 Part '2' must be duly completed with reference to the tender conditions and put in a separate sealed envelope superscribed "Price bid-Tender number, MM/ OT/Ins. Cement/10-11 due on 26-12-2009
- 2.4 Part '2' the price bid should not carry any conditions. Price / rate should be quoted in clear terms in the format given by BHEL. The offer should remain valid for 120 days from the date of opening the tender.
- 2.5 Part '2' Price bid will be opened only in respect of those tenders who are qualified in Techno- commercial Bid.
- 2.6 Name of the tenderer should be written on the sealed envelope.
- 2.7 Before making the offer, the tenderers are advised to carefully go through the terms and conditions, which form part of the agreement.

General Terms and Conditions.

- 2.8 All entries in the tender document should be in one ink. Corrections, over writing, cuttings etc are not permitted. All the columns in the tender form should be filled without leaving any column blank in any page of the tender. The tender forms both Part '1' & '2' duly filled in all respects shall be signed on each page by the tenderer. Any alterations, erasure or over writing will render the tender invalid.
- 2.9 The price / rate should be quoted in figures as well as in words. The offer of suppliers should be in full acceptance of techno commercial & General terms and conditions of this tender.



- 2.10 Required quantities indicated are only projected figures and supplies shall be made only for actual requirement and not the indicated quantities. Quantum of materials ordered for the supply from time to time shall be dependent on actual requirement. Delivery dates stipulated by BHEL shall be adhered to.
- 2.11 The rates finalized for the rate contract shall be valid for one year from the date of placement of firm order. The rate contract may be extended beyond one year with mutual consent.
- 2.12 The rates quoted shall be on F.O.R. Stores basis. The rates shall be exclusive of taxes but inclusive of freight and insurance. Any tax, if applicable, is to be separately specified.
- 2.13 Prices shall be considered on **LANDED COST BASIS**. Landed cost shall be worked out on price quoted including freight, excise duty, sales tax after taking out **CENVAT benefit**. The comparative statement shall be prepared & L1 status of respective vendor shall be worked out on over all landed cost basis. The price negotiations if considered necessary, will be done with L1 bidder only and L2 and L3 will be asked to match negotiated L1 price. Distribution of quantities among L1 ,L2 , L3 and L4 vendors will be in the ratio of 40:30:20:10 In case of where quantity to be shared between three vendors only, the ratio of 50:30:20 will be maintained. In case where quantity is to be shared between TWO vendors only, the ratio of 60:40 will be maintained. However the load sharing is linked with the vendor performance
- 2.14 The Orders will be placed against rate contract in phases depending on suppliers' position in comparative statement of original offers subject to acceptance of counter offered rates, suppliers' performance. and BHEL requirement during the period of contract. The suppliers with consistant good performance will be preferred over poor performing suppliers and encouraged with more order share.
- 2.15 Tender documents consisting of Part '1' & '2' duly sealed in a separate envelopes should be sealed in another envelope and sent to AGM/ Materials Management, BHEL/EPD, IISc Post, Malleswaram, Bangalore-560012 so as to reach him on or before **14-00 hrs on due date**. Part '1' of tender form i.e. Techno- commercial bid will be opened on **the due date at 14.00 hrs** the same day in the presence of tenderers or their representative who are present for the tender opening and details of tenderers will be noted for further evaluation. Tenderers who qualify in the techno-commercial bid will be intimated to attend the tender opening of part '2' i.e. price bid will be opened at the specified date in the presence of the tenderers or their representative who are notified to attend the tender opening.

- 2.17 Suppliers' capacity to supply per month implies suppliers' ability to supply such quantities of items meeting the quality requirements and delivery schedules. Suppliers shall indicate only such capacity that can be allocated to BHEL-and not their total capacity.
- 2.18 BHEL reserves the right to assess the capacity and capability of the Suppliers for pre-qualification. The company also reserves the right to accept or reject any or all the tenders or any part thereof at any stage of process without assigning any reasons whatsoever. The company has no obligation to accept the lowest tender. BHEI's decision in this regard shall be final.
- 2.19 The latest IT returns, Balance sheet/Annual report, Sales tax validity certificate is compulsory to be furnished along with your offer. The units registered under SSI should also furnish the validity certificate for the same. Excise authority certificate should also be furnished
- 2.20 <u>Risk Purchase Clause</u>: BHEL at its option will be entitled to terminate the contract and/or purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the seller fails to deliver within the stipulated time. The seller shall be liable for any loss, which BHEL may sustain by such risk purchases. The loss may be recovered from the vendor's outstanding bills with the concerned unit or any sister unit.
- 2.21 In case of unsatisfactory performance of quality / delivery BHEL will have right to discontinue the contract in part or full.
- **2.22 LD Clause**: In case of delayed delivery, LD @ 0.5% per week up to a maximum of 5% will be levied on the defaulting quantity for the delayed period as per the corresponding PO.
- **2.23 Legal Jurisdiction**: In case of any legal proceedings, area of jurisdiction will be Bangalore in case of EPD and Sultanpur, in the case of IP Jagadishpur.
