1. Contractor scope:
  - i) Cleaning the area of the crane with brooms
  - ii) Cleaning the area of the crane with kerosene and cotton waste
  - iii) Cleaning the paint from places where it is damaged using rough emery paper
  - iv) Applying two coats of the specified colour of paint using paint brush / spray gun
  - v) The crane are is to be painted with deep orange colour for the EOT Cranes and golden yellow for gantry cranes.
  - vi) All motors on the cranes should be painted with grey paint
  - vii) Hand rails, plat forms, hooks, gear boxes and shafts should be painted with black paint.
  - viii) Name plate boards and asset number boards available on the crane should be painted with new paint. Wherever the boards are not available new boards are to be painted and fixed on the crane.
  - ix) Necessary Tools and other Equipments like Painting Brushes, Spray Gun, Brooms etc Supply is in the scope of contractor.

### **GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS**

- 1) Sufficient skilled/ semiskilled painters having work experience in the working at heights should be engaged.
- 2) Security Deposit clause is applicable; SD is 10% for contracts up to 10 Lakhs. Security Deposit is refundable after expiry of guarantee period. Interest is not applicable on SD/ EMD Deposits.
- 3) Security Deposit may be furnished in any one of the following forms:
  - i. Cash (as permissible under the Income Tax Act)
  - ii. Pay Order, Demand Draft in favour of BHEL
  - iii. Local cheques of scheduled banks, subject to realization.
  - iv. Securities available from Post Offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (Certificates should be held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly pledged in favour of BHEL and discharged on the back).
  - v. Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the Companies Act. The Bank Guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.

  - vii. Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. In such cases 50% of the Security Deposit shall be collected before start of the work and the balance 50% shall be recovered from the running bills.
- 4) EMD of the successful tenderer can be converted and adjusted against the security deposit
- 5) Guarantee period- 6 Months.
- 6) Contractor should obtain HR clearance for getting the bill payment and S.D.refunds.
- 7) Contractor shall ensure payment of statutory minimum wages as applicable from time to time in the presence of authorized representative of BHEL and maintain proper records of timely disbursement. Any future wage raise on account of DA Increase/ Wage revision by AP Government may be met by the contractor himself. BHEL will not reimburse the differential in rate of DA or Wages

- 8) Payment will be arranged in 2 installments for the completed work in all respects and on submission of bill to Cranes Maintenance Section.
- 9) Contractor should commence the work immediately once obtained labour permission from HR. Any delay in execution will attract penalty @ 1/2% per week on the total contract value to a maximum extent of 10% (subject to free supplies arranged by BHEL)
- 10) SAFETY: Contractor shall provide personnel protective equipment to the labour engaged and should see that they will wear during the work.
- 11) Contractor should obtain permission to work at heights from safety/ plant maintenance.
- 12) The contractor is wholly responsible for any loss of life or partial disability of any of their labour while on duty
- 13) In case of occurrence of any accident/ injury of contractor's staff, BHEL will not pay any compensation while they are on duty and contractor has to take care of health of workers under statutory obligation.
- 14) Upon awardal of the work, the contractor has to execute an agreement with BHEL on a non-judicial stamp paper worth of Rs 100/- purchased by the contractor.

### **ANNEXURE-B**

#### **MEASUREMENT OF WORK AND PAYMENT THEREOF**

1. A Measurement Book will be maintained in the BHEL by Cranes Maintenance section ( 10 RS or at 05 Shop). The Contractor wherein he or his authorized representative will submit work completed in weekly basis, based on quantities completed by the contractor entries will be entered in the measurement book
2. The designated employee of the Unit will inspect the work executed by the contractor and authenticate the entries made in the measurement book.
3. Short comings, if any, in the work executed will be pointed out by the designated employee to the Contractor or his authorized representative and the same will be rectified by him (other than watering) within three days to the satisfaction of the designated employee.
4. Payment towards work satisfactorily executed will be made to the Contractor at the following rates :-

(Measurement of work will be as per Annexure-I (work schedule/ price schedule))

- i) Payments will be made to the contractor after completion of work on the basis of work carried out by him.
- ii) All payments will be subject to deduction of income tax at source as per Income Tax Rules.

**CONTRACTOR'S OBLIGATIONS**

**A) CONTRACTUAL**

1. The Contractor will ensure that the employees deployed by him in the premises of BHEL are physically and mentally fit and do not have any criminal record.
- 2) The Contractor will maintain records of his employees deployed to carry out the job.
- 3) The Contractor will provide employment card/Identity card with photograph duly attested by him to his employees.
- 4) The Contractor will provide uniforms / safety appliances to his employees.
- 5) In the event of termination of contract for any reason whatsoever, the contractor shall withdraw all his employees from the establishment of BHEL.
- 6) The Contractor will obtain insurance cover for his employees and take third party risk insurance coverage at his own cost.
- 7) The Contractor will decide the number of employees to be deployed for execution of the work awarded to him and will be solely entitled to dictate such workers about the manner of carrying out the work.
- 8) The Contractor or his authorized representative will supervise the work allotted to him and being carried out by his employees or will post a Supervisor for this purpose.
- 9) The Contractor will be responsible for the good conduct of his employees. In case of any misconduct / misbehaviour by any employee, contractor will replace such employee immediately.
10. The contractor will ensure that the job is executed through the employees on his rolls and under no circumstances he will deploy any casual employee to carry out the job nor shall he sub-contract the job awarded to him.
- 11) The Contractor will keep watch on his employees and he will be liable for any pilferage / loss to BHEL due to acts of omission and commission by his employees. Similarly, liability for any compensation to outsiders on account of any act of omission and commission by the employees deployed by the contractor shall lie exclusively with him.
- 12) The Contractor will ensure that all precautions are taken for the safety of his employees.
- 13) The Contractor will provide to his employees all tools, tackles and equipments required to carry out the job under the contract at his own cost.
- 14) The Contractor will provide safety appliances at his own cost which may be required under the statute or otherwise.
- 15) The Contractor will provide all material at his own cost as mentioned in the contract to his employees for carrying out the job.
16. Paints will be supplied by BHEL free of cost.

**B. STATUTORY**

- 17) All statutory requirements under Minimum Wages Act, 1948, Payment of Wages Act, 1936, Workmen Compensation Act. 1923, EPF & MP Act, 1952, Payment of Gratuity Act, 1972, ESI Act, 1948, The Contract Labour (R&A) Act, 1970, Payment of Bonus Act, 1965, Income Tax Act etc. shall be complied with by the contractor.
- 18) The Contractor shall comply with all statutory requirements, rules, regulations, notifications in relation to employment of his employees issued from time to time by the concerned authorities.

- 19) The Contractor shall ensure payment of statutory prescribed minimum wages as applicable from time to time in the presence of authorized representative of BHEL and maintain proper records of their timely disbursement. These records need to be preserved for a period of at least 3 years and made available even after the contract is over for any verification by the statutory authorities.
- 20) The Contractor should have independent code numbers under EPF & MP Act, 1952 and ESI Act, 1948 and he shall cover his employees under the said codes.
- 21) The Contractor shall provide PF pass book to his employees and ensure payment of PF, EDLI, pension dues under EPF & MP Act, 1952 to the RPFC.
- 22) The Contractor shall ensure payment of ESI contribution under ESI Act, 1948.
- 23) The Contractor shall produce proof of deductions as well as remittances of PF, EDLI, Pension, ESI contribution, administrative charges etc. wherever applicable and shall maintain proper records.
- 24) The Contractor shall furnish proper returns to the concerned statutory authorities.
- 25) The Contractor shall be solely responsible for non payment/ delayed payment of wages, contributions under EPF & MP Act, ESI Act etc.
- 26) In case the contractor fails to make payment of wages to his employees or remittance of contribution to the concerned authorities, the security deposit/other dues under the contract can be utilized by BHEL to discharge the liability of the contractor.
- 27) The Contractor shall indemnify BHEL against all claims and losses under various statutes or any civil or criminal law in connection with employees deployed by him.
- 28) The liability for any compensation on account of injury sustained by an employee of the contractor will be exclusively that of the contractor.
- 29) The Contractor shall obtain licence under CL(R&A) Act, 1970.

## **ANNEXURE-D**

### **GENERAL TERMS & CONDITIONS OF MODEL AGREEMENT**

1. BHEL shall have the privity of the contract with the contractor only and will give instructions to the contractor or his authorized representative. BHEL will have nothing to do or be concerned with the employment of employees working for the contractor. The relationship between BHEL and the Contractor will be that of independent entities and nothing herein contained will amount to joint venture, partnership or an employer-employee relationship.
2. The contractor shall maintain regular contact with the designated employee(s) of BHEL and will interact on matters relating to the work awarded under this contract.
3. In case the Contractor does not carry out the Contractual/Statutory obligations or the services rendered by him are found to be unsatisfactory, BHEL shall bring the same to his notice and he will be obliged to discharge the obligations and rectify the deficiency/anomaly within three days time failing which, BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract without assigning any reason whatsoever. In such an event, no damages will be payable for short closure of the contract.

4. The contractor shall deposit an amount of Rs \_\_\_\_\_ /- ( 10% of contract value) as security with BHEL in the form of pay order /bank guarantee / FDI in the name of contractor A/c – BHEL duly discharged on the back. Alternatively, the amount of security deposit can be adjusted partly from EMD and balance amount from subsequent bills. This security deposit shall be liable to be returned to the contractor after termination of the contract or at the end of it, subject to deduction on account of company dues, non-deposit of statutory dues etc. No interest shall be payable on the security deposit.
5. The decision of BHEL regarding interpretation of any of terms and conditions set forth in this agreement shall be final and binding on the Contractor.
6. Any matter arising out of or in connection with the agreement shall be under jurisdiction of SANGAREDDY/ HYDERABAD Court.
7. Notwithstanding anything contained in this Agreement, the contract may be terminated by BHEL without assigning any reason thereof by giving a notice of 30 days to the contractor.
8. The contract will commence on \_\_\_\_\_ date and will remain valid for a period of \_\_\_\_\_ Months (s) till \_\_\_\_\_ date. The parties reserve the right to extend the contract on mutually agreed terms and conditions.
9. All disputes between the parties to the contract arising out of or relating to the contract either concerning the terms and conditions of the contract or its implementation will be settled by the parties amicably. In case the dispute is not resolved, the same shall be referred for conciliation by an officer of BHEL. In case it still remains unresolved, the dispute will be referred for arbitration by an officer of BHEL. (In case arbitration by an officer of BHEL is not acceptable, the same could be entrusted to any mutually agreeable Government functionary or an independent person). The venue of arbitration shall be office of General Manager/ M&S (indicate place). The arbitrator will give his award within a period of four months or within such extended time as may be agreed by the parties. The award of the arbitrator shall be final, conclusive and binding on both the parties.

#### **OBLIGATIONS OF THE CONTRACTORS**

1. If the tender is made by an individual, it shall be signed with his full name and his address shall be furnished. If it is made by firm, it shall be signed with the co-partnership name by a member of the firm, who shall also sign his own name, also furnish the name and address of each member of the firm. If the tender is made by a corporation, it shall be signed by a duly authorized Officer who shall produce with the tender, satisfactory evidence of his authorization. Such tendering corporation/firm is required to furnish evidence of its existence along with bid.
2. The EMD will be refunded to the unsuccessful Tenderers on application after rejection of the tender is intimated. The earnest money will be retained in the case of the successful tenderers and either of the cases will not carry any interest. It will be dealt with as provided in the conditions attached to the tender.
3. Whenever a tender is to be accepted, the tenderer, whose tender is under consideration, shall attend the Office of " Officer Inviting the Tender " on the date fixed by written intimation to him. He shall forthwith, upon intimation being given to him by the " Officer Inviting the Tender" for acceptance of his tender, complete the execution of the agreement by signing all documents

connected therewith. Failure to do so and not to commence the work within one month from the date of intimation shall entail forfeiture of the earnest money.

4. Tenderers shall persue carefully the instructions and directions to the parties given in the tender document and the conditions there of and all other relevant documents before quoting the rates for the work. The approximate quantity of work to be executed under each class is given in the schedule. The quantities are given with a view to enable tenderer to quote his overall rate for each class of work in the tender form and for a uniform comparison of tenders. It shall be definitely understood that the schedule is liable to alterations at the discretion of accepting authority.
5. Tenderers shall keep the offer valid for a period of 90 days from the date of opening of tender. After submitting the tender, he will not recall his offer or modify the terms and conditions thereof. Should the tenderer fail to observe or comply with the foregoing stipulations, the EMD shall be forfeited.
6. ***Tenderers have to quote their rates in the tender schedule legibly written in figures and words*** and those not submitted in proper form, offers is liable for rejection.
7. The submission of tender shall be strictly in accordance with the terms and conditions stipulated in this tender notice. ***No counter conditions will be acceptable*** or valid.
8. Contractor shall be deemed to have included in his tender price of all the plant, machinery and appliances required for the purpose of all operations connected with the work embraced under the contract to secure a satisfactory quality of work and rate of progress which in the opinion of the " Contract Signing Officer" will ensure the completion of the work within the time specified.
9. *BHEL is having every right to split the schedule and to award the work to single or more parties on the lowest offered rates basis.*
10. **BHEL is having right to call the lowest bidder for price negotiations, if the rate or amount quoted by contractor is felt on higher side. In such cases contractor should attend negotiations with full details.**
11. BHEL may request the contractor for extending the contract for likely works with same terms and conditions.
12. The rates quoted by the contractor should be firm for the contract period. There shall be no revision in contract rates during the period of the contract.
13. The contractor must have phone facility at his office/ residence or cellular phone for proper communication.
14. Withdrawal from contract during contract period in BHEL will entail forfeiture of EMD & Security Deposit.
15. In case the contractor does not execute the work awarded to him as per the terms and conditions of the agreement, the same shall be got executed by some other contractor and the excess cost incurred shall be recovered from the contractor's security deposit/pending bills.
16. The contract agreement shall be entered with BHEL, Ramachandrapuram, Hyderabad on valid non judicial stamp paper of the value of Rs100/- to be purchased by the contractor at his own cost.

17. Labour engaged by the contractor should be disciplined & exhibit good behaviour in dealing with employees of BHEL. Any misbehavior or conduct of any Person engaged by the contractor is not good, contractor shall change that person immediately or else it may even lead to termination of the contract & security deposit will be forfeited as penalty.
18. The Executing Officer shall ensure the execution of work on quantifiable basis taking into account equipment and machinery deployed rather than availability of technicians.
19. Disputes, grievances between the contractor and his labour, will have to be settled by the contractor only.
20. The labour employed by the contractor, if found in abetting any of fellow labour or contractors or any BHEL employee, the same shall be considered as an act of indiscipline. Such laborers shall be removed from the services of the contractor, on the advice of BHEL. Further the contractor shall initiate every necessary action in accordance with the relevant Laws, Rules & Regulations and enactments of state and Central Governments.
21. **Earnest Money Deposit:**  
Earnest Money is to be paid by each tenderer to ensure that the tenderer does not refuse to execute the work after it is awarded to him. The rate of earnest money deposit shall be as per tender schedule.

iv) Security deposit can also be recovered at the rate of 10% from the running bills. However in such cases at least 50% of the Security Deposit should be collected before start of the work and the balance 50% may be recovered from the running bills.

v) EMD of the successful tendered shall be converted and adjusted against the security deposit.

The security deposit shall not carry any interest

23. WAGE SLIP, employment card etc to the technicians/ supervisors/ engineers have to be arranged by the contractor.
24. Contractor should have independent code numbers / exemptions under EPF & MP Act, 1952 and ESI Act, 1948 and shall cover his employees under the said codes.
25. Payment of bonus under the payment of Bonus Act, Payment of gratuity under the Gratuity Act, and retrenchment compensation under Act will be the sole responsibility of the contractor.
26. PF Remittances should be made before 7th of succeeding month for workmen engaged, copy must be produced in HR (Personnel) for obtaining HR Clearance and also to the site incharge ( as per EPF clause).
27. The issue of materials is governed by the conditions specified in the tender schedule itself . Any item requires for executing the work shall be supplied by the contractor himself and the rates for the relevant items are inclusive of all such supplies.
28. BHEL reserve the right to deviate either by addition or by deletion from the schedule of items of work given in the tender document after awarding the work.
