CIF is applicable for this package

12. **Tender Evaluation - Evaluation shall be done on Total Cost to BHEL basis (excluding GST), project wise, as per Cl. No. 19.2 of Instruction to Bidders of GCC, Rev. 07. Mandatory Spares are optional and shall not be considered for evaluation and ordering.**

For RA, the loading (technical/commercial), if any, shall be added by bidder while submitting the bid in reverse auction portal.

Ordering shall be done after de-loading the commercial/ technical loading from bidder's final price.

The Evaluation Currency for this tender shall be INR.

13. Terms & Conditions: - All other terms & conditions shall be as per Notice Inviting Tender (NIT) conditions, GCC Rev-07 & SCC for 5x800 MW Yadadri TPS. Order of precedence shall be as per clause No, 36.0 of GCC Rev. 07 (GENERAL COMMERCIAL TERMS & CONDITIONS).

14. Bidder to note that this is a Conditional Tender enquiry and the RA participation shall be subject to following condition:

- a) Qualifying technical PQR
- b) Techno-commercial recommendation by BHEL.
- c) Approval of bidder by End Customer.

Note: Approval shall be taken up with end customer based on the latest credentials/reference list furnished by bidder. Accordingly, bidders are requested to submit credentials along with their technical bid as per the format enclosed with this enquiry.

The bidders who are not registered with BHEL-PEM may apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Registration Portal available at www.bhelpem.com-->vendor section-->online supplier registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.

15. Bidders to ensure that Third party/Customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have verifiable details of documents/certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of issuing authority and its organization contact number and e-mail id etc. In case the same found not available, purchaser has right to reject such document from evaluation.

16. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications, etc. to the tender will be hosted on <https://eprocurebhel.co.in>. Bidders should regularly visit websites to keep themselves updated.

17. If bidder mentions Not Applicable / Not required / Not Quoted in BHEL price format, the same to be substantiated by the bidder. If such item is required to be supplied for system completion in future, same will be supplied free of cost.

18. Standard pre-printed terms & conditions of the tenderers (other than BHEL format) shall not be valid and binding in any manner whatsoever.
19. Unsolicited fresh/revised price bid shall not be entertained.
20. Purchaser shall be under no obligation to accept the lowest or any other tender and shall be entitled to accept or reject any/all tender(s) in part or full without assigning any reason whatsoever.
21. Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature(s) of person(s) signing the bid else bid shall be liable for rejection.
22. Bidder participating in tender will necessarily have to buy class III DSCs issued by the certifying authorities in India. Basic procedure/checklist has been uploaded on www.bhel.com for participating in future tender enquiries through e procurement.

26. Bidders to quote freight charges in percentage of their quoted Total Ex-works Prices.

27. Due to COVID-19 pandemic condition prevailing in the country, BHEL/PEM may go for Remote Inspection of Offered items, if required. Vendors are requested to be equipped with the facilities/gadgets as indicated in the guidelines attached to take up the inspection REMOTELY.

28. In course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective bidders. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L1 bidder shall be decided by a toss / draw of lots, in the presence of respective bidder(s) or their representative(s). Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situation shall be final and binding.

40. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.

In case, the bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/guidelines.

41. Service charges like Supervision, Inspection etc consequent or incidental to supply are envisaged in tender, such charges should not exceed 2% of the total contract value.

42. For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a Class I Local Supplier / Class II Local Supplier / Non Local supplier and Purchase preference to Class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), (PPP-MII) Order 2017 dt. 16/09/2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of Part-II bids against this NIT.

Regarding verification of local content, the local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide certification as per para 9 of PP-MII order revision dated 16.09.2020.

43. "This Item/ Package/ System falls under the list of items defined in para 3 of Ministry of Finance Guideline dated 20.09.2016 (procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations and equipment's, etc.) & hence criteria of prior experience/ turnover shall be same for all the bidders including start up/ MSME."

44. Foreign bidders will have to quote on C&F (Cost & Freight) Mumbai Port.

45. Bidders to note that offers shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of tender documents. Bidders shall upload their complete offer meeting the requirements of the tender documents on e-procurement portal <https://eprocurebhel.co.in/nicgep/app>.
