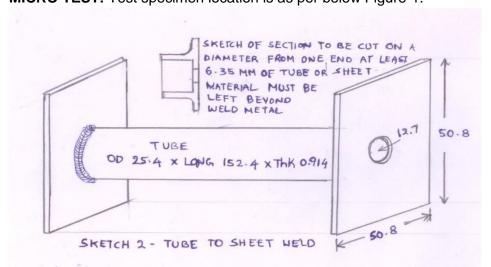


Figure:1: Tube to Sheet Welding – Welder Performance qualification test specimen location

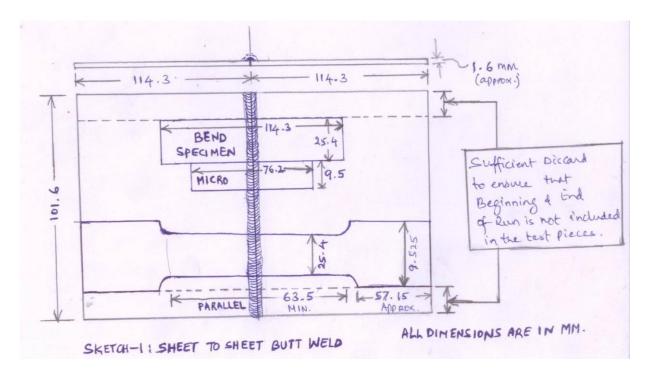


Figure:2: Sheet to Sheet Welding – Welder Performance qualification test specimen location
