

		Bidders to quote for the complete scope of work as per the tender specifications. The price bids shall be evaluated for the complete scope of work as per tender specifications based on total cost to BHEL. Price evaluation shall be on the total price (all-inclusive incl. freight) excluding Goods & Service Tax (GST), i.e. Basic Price (supply of goods & services), as per price basis mentioned in SCC + Freight Charges (as applicable) + Loading (if any) + Cost of withdrawal (if any) + Power consumption loading (if any) + Any other taxes and duties (if any) excluding Goods & Service Tax (GST). The evaluation currency for this tender shall be INR. The quoted basic price shall be inclusive of packing & forwarding charges, freight charges, all taxes & duties except Goods & Service Tax (GST).

 - g. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.

 - In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership Interest or who exercises control through other means, Explanation-
 - a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twentyfive per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the company;

 - 5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall Include identification of the author of the trust. the
