**SUB: NOTICE INVITING TENDER FOR ENTERING INTO RATE CONTRACT FOR 24 MONTHS PERIOD OF SUPPLY OF PURCHASE OF MEDICINE ON DAY TO DAY BASIS.**  
(Empanelment of Authorized Pharmacy for supply of Medicines to BHEL Dispensary Rudrapur).

Sealed Tenders are invited in **Two Parts** i.e. Technical Bid [containing documents listed at Annexure-A,A-1,A-2,A-4,A-5,A-6, signed & sealed copy of this document (NIT) as a token of acceptance to all terms & conditions stated in NIT] in one envelop and Price Bid [strictly as per format given as Annexure-A-3] in second envelop. Both these envelops to be suitably marked as Part-I (Technical Bid) and Part-II (Price Bid). Then both these envelops should be kept in one single envelop.

**RFQ No, Due date & Bidder's credentials should be clearly indicated on all envelops.**

### **TERMS AND CONDITIONS: -**

1. **SCOPE OF RATE CONTRACT:** This Rate Contract (RC) is for supply of medicines required on **DAY TO DAY BASIS**. Demand shall be raised by Dispensary, BHEL Rudrapur. (As per Annexure-A1)
2. **Place of supply:** The supplies to be made to the Dispensary of BHEL Rudrapur (As per Annexure-A1).
3. **Validity of Rate Contract:** This Rate Contract shall be valid for **24 MONTHS**.
4. **Basis of price:** Discounted Rate / Price shall be on Total Price (MRP) i.e. inclusive of taxes, duties etc. as applicable.
5. **Value of Contract:** Rate contract shall be finalized for a value of Rs. 40 Lakhs. However, billing to be done on actual supply basis. Cumulative billing (including taxes) during RC period should not exceed Rs. 40 Lakhs.
6. **DISTRIBUTION OF CONTRACT:** 100% work to be awarded to L-1 bidder.
7. **RISK PURCHASE:** Applicable as BHEL's Policy
8. **Eligibility:** The party participating in this Tender shall be considered only after his registration, on the basis of Mandatory & Statutory documents as listed as Annexure-A2. All these documents need to be submitted along with your Techno commercial bid. (Which is an essential condition to be followed by all the parties).
9. Tenders received after due date and time shall not be considered under any circumstances.
10. **Part I: Technical Bid** shall be opened on due date i.e. on **27/01/2023** at 14:30 hrs.
11. **Price bid (Part II bid)** of only those bidders shall be opened, whose techno-commercial offer (Part I bid) is acceptable & are in line with our tender terms & conditions.
12. Suppliers are requested to quote in **two part bid system** as explained above. However, for quotations submitted in single bid against our requirement of two bid system will not be considered and the bid / offer shall be rejected.
13. Supplier should always be available on phone / mobile or alternate contact number.
14. In case of items required for serious patients, emergency supply shall have to be made around the clock, for which requirement shall be informed over telephone/Email.

15. The supplied material should be of **SPECIFIED BRAND**. If the requisite items are not available, substitute may be supplied after approval of BHEL Medical officer/BHEL Dispensary.
16. Supplier will have to submit bills in DUPLICATE along with delivery challan of the medicine. Name of manufacturers must clearly be written on the bills.
17. **Payment** of bills shall be as:

18. BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract as a whole or any part of it, in case of failure to supply for three consecutive occasions or any breach of aforesaid terms and conditions and the same time the supplier may be delisted from our vendor list.
19. For any further clarifications, HR Dept./BHEL Dispensary may be consulted.

20. **ARBITRATION:**

In case of any unresolved disputes between the vendor and BHEL with regard to the supplies, same shall, after a written notice to the other party, be referred to sole arbitration of the General Manager of BHEL or his nominee.

The Arbitration shall be conducted in accordance with the provisions of the current version of Indian Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996. The award of the arbitrator shall be final and binding on both the parties to the contract. All suit /claims in respect of this shall be in the Courts of Rudrapur only.

21. All terms and conditions shall be as per NIT and tender documents Attached- Annexure-A and A-1 to 6.
