No additional claim shall be entertained by BHEL in future, on account of non-acquaintance of above.
- 44. **MSE Purchase preference:** Purchase preference would be applicable to MSE bidders as per GOI circular (No. F.1/4/2021-PPD dtd. 18.05.2023) and any other subsequent circulars / clarifications.
- 45. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the tender is uploaded on or before the due date and time. Part-I bids shall be opened on due date through e-procurement Portal.
- 46. Land Border certificate: Please furnish land border certificate as per enclosed format dully signed and stamped by Director or Company Secretary or authorised person by Board of the Company.
- 47. Self-declarations/ auditor's/ accountant's certificates submitted by the manufacturer/ supplier may be verified randomly by the committee constituted as per MoP Order 28-07-2020. In case of false documents/misrepresentation of the facts requisite action against such manufacturer/ supplier will be taken based on the recommendation of the Committee.

- 49. A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anticompetitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests.   - a) they have controlling partner (s) in common;' or
  - b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy/ financial stake from any of them; or
  - c) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
  - d) they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another Bidder; or
  - e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a Bidder in more than one Bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved.
