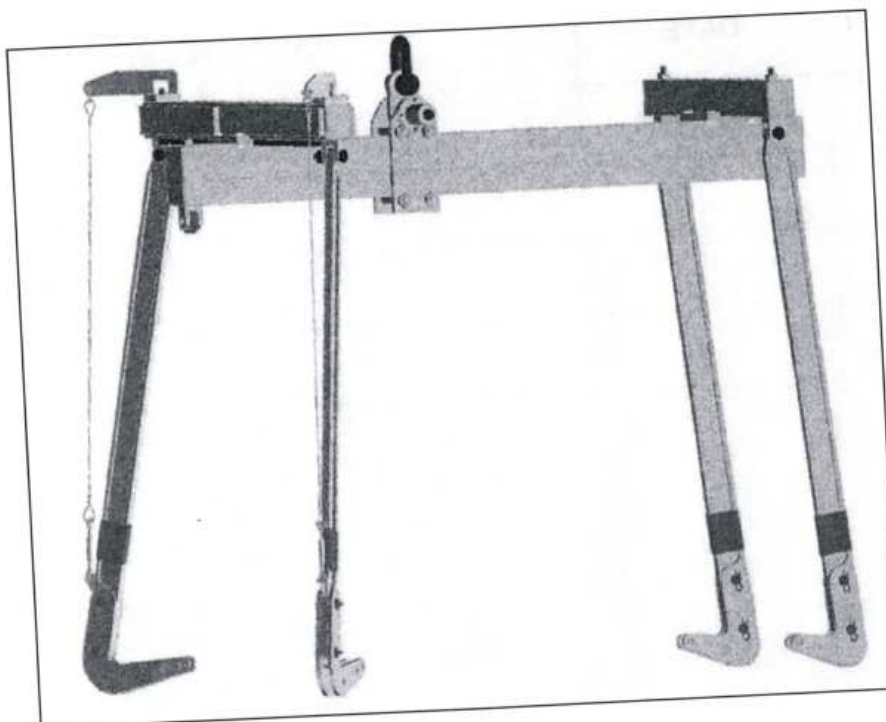

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A. ABOUT FIXTURE

The Lifting Fixture is intended for lifting of 76/62 SRGM (UPGRADE) during assembly, maintenance and transportation at BHEL Haridwar/Site as per fig.-1 & fig.2 and is in service at BHEL Haridwar/Site. Lifting fixture is designed for safe working load upto 18.5 tons and to be functionally load tested as per Loading test arrangements drawing no. R7878-0773/100 at 29 tons.

- Weight of Lifting Fixture (Approx.) = 2 Ton
- Size of Lifting Fixture Assembly (Approx.) = 4000mmx3200mmx3000mm
- Size of Beam Central (Longest Welded Subassembly) (Approx.) = 4000mmx400mmx550mm

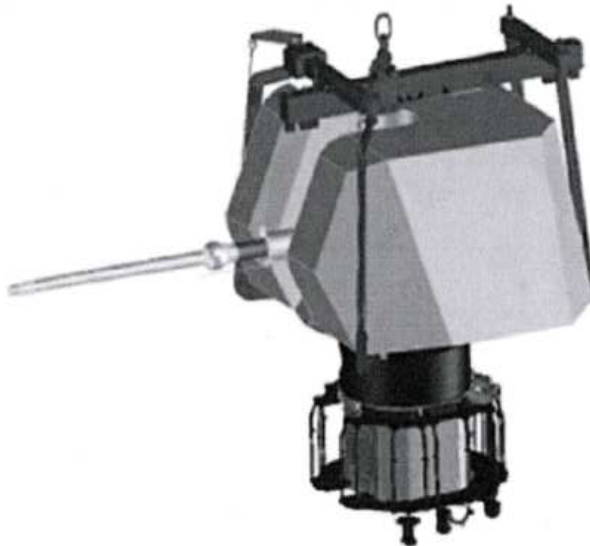

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B. SCOPE OF WORK/ SUPPLY OF BIDDER

The Bidder to confirm adherence to the following points while submitting the offer:

- 1) To manufacture and supply Lifting Fixture (Upgraded SRGM) as per drawing no. 07820068062-00 including procurement of materials as per Bill of Materials (BOM) and its subsequent load testing at BHEL Haridwar works.
- 2) The manufacturing and supply of the Lifting Fixture shall comply with the various requirements as mentioned in drawing no. 07820068062-00, BOM, TDC and Quality Assurance Plans (QAP).
- 3) Manufacturing operations such as Fabrication /Machining/Assembly/Testing should be carried out after taking care of each and every technical requirements of each item (drawings & standards) covered in BOM.
- 4) Bidder to ensure following technological necessity / process control during manufacturing to achieve controlled distortion and dimensional accuracy: -
 - (a) Identification of each and every item as per drawing.
 - (b) Making edge preparation as per drawing details.
 - (c) Manufacturing of Items.
 - (d) Welding of components as per drawing
 - (e) Assembly
 - (f) Use of technological supports / fixtures.
 - (g) Alignments of all components and sub assembly etc. as per ordering drawings.
 - (h) Proper handling during Manufacturing, Lifting and transportation.
- 5) At the time of Functional Load Testing at Haridwar, Bidder to arrange competent authority as specified in Factories Act 1948 and UP Factories Rules 1950 etc. for issuing Functional Load Testing certificate. Dead weight (sl no 1 to 3) as per Functional Load test arrangement's drg. no. R7878-0773/100 will be supplied by BHEL. Items as per sl 4 to 9 of Functional Load test arrangement's drg. no. R7878-0773/100 are to be arranged by bidder.

Applicable statutory documents

Lifting Fixture shall meet all statutory safety requirements in accordance with Factories Act 1948 and UP Factories Rules 1950 etc.

C. TECHNICAL REQUIREMENT

- 1) One set of drawings and standards shall be furnished to the Bidder for submitting the offer. All dimensions in drawings are in millimeter. Drawings and documents furnished to Bidder



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should be treated as BHEL property. Strict confidentiality is to be maintained and under no circumstances these documents or copy of these should be transferred to the third party without express permission of BHEL. On completion of supply, all documents must be returned to BHEL.

- 2) Drawings & documents specified in BOM may undergo minor revisions, however, quantum of scope of supply will remain same. If any drawing undergoes revision, it shall be communicated to Bidder at the earliest.
- 3) Complete set of detail drawings and standards will be furnished to Bidder along with the Purchase Order. Bidder may seek any other cross-referred document, if required.
- 4) Bidder should confirm categorically that they shall meet all technical requirements listed in the drawings and specifications.
- 5) Any deviation wrt drawings/specification/technical requirement should be informed before Placement of Order as per **Deviation Table Annexure III for BHEL approval**. BHEL reserves the right for rejection of non-conformity and will be final and binding on Bidder. No deviation shall be granted by BHEL after Placement of Order.
- 6) Bidder must ensure all technical requirements indicated in the drawings / standards including in the manufactured components/assembly.
 - i.) Surface finish (Ra value indicated in microns).
 - ii.) Sizes and tolerances.
 - iii.) Geometrical accuracies e.g. run-outs, concentricity, parallelism, perpendicularity, etc.
 - iv.) Dimensions shown within ☐ on drawings are Critical to Quality (CTQ) etc.
 - v.) Protective Surface treatments Paints/ Primers/ Zinc- Nickel/Zinc-Blue.
- 7) BHEL shall furnish clarifications, if any, w.r.t scope of work or drawing's dimensions/ technical /assembly requirements to the bidder to enable it to submit technical/ commercial offers.
- 8) All the manufacturing/assembly requirements are to be achieved and recorded as per drawing's dimensions/ technical requirements.
- 9) Bidder to note that all tools, fixtures, measuring equipment's, technological items etc. required for manufacturing and testing (except Dead weight (sl no 1 to 3) as per Functional Load test arrangement's drg. no. R7878-0773/100) of subject item shall be arranged by Bidder.
- 10) Protective Surface treatments Paints/ Primers/ Zinc- Nickel/Zinc-Blue shall be carried out as per drawings/ BOM.



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D. MATERIAL REQUIREMENT

- 1) Material of items / components shall be as per BHEL specification/ equivalent International/ National specification/ additional description given against each item in BOM No. **07820068062** Var. 00.
- 2) Bidder to provide Material Test Certificate (MTC) for materials as per specification mentioned in **BOM 07820068062** Var. 00 as per EN 10204, type 3.2 from any NABL accredited lab/ Govt approved lab/ Internationally accredited lab/OEM approved lab in additional to Mill TC.
- 3) In case Bidder wishes to use material other than BHEL Material Spec/ Acceptable equivalent grade in BOM No. **07820068062** Var. 00. Bidder to submit proposed material in **Deviation Table Annexure III** with a copy of their material specification (English Language only) along with the offer for approval. BHEL reserve the right to accept or reject the proposed alternate material.

E. TECHNOLOGICAL REQUIREMENT

- 1) Bidder should develop and submit Applicable WPS (Welding Procedure Specification- EN ISO 15609-1), PQR (Performance Qualification Record- EN ISO 15614-1, level 2) & WPQ (Welder Performance Qualification - EN ISO 9606-1) as per enquired jobs, duly certified by independent third party of International reputation eg Lloyds, BVQI, TUV, RITES etc for the enquiry item after PO placement and before job manufacturing for BHEL review. Vendor to submit WPS, PQR and WPQ copies for BHEL review at least two weeks prior to start of work.
- 2) NDT (Non-Destructive Testing) shall be carried out by personnel qualified by ASNT / ISNT or equivalent.
- 3) During manufacturing, all the weld-seam to be 100% DP (Dye Penetrant testing) tested at root run and 100% DP tested after final welding. DP testing to be done in accordance with ISO 5817 and ISO 17635 with quality level C.
- 4) Functional load test to be done as per Loading test arrangements drawing no. R7878-0773/100. Bidder to arrange competent authority as specified in Factories Act 1948 and UP Factories Rules 1950 etc. for issuing Functional Load Testing certificate. 100% DP testing of welded joints after Functional load test. DP testing to be done in accordance with ISO 5817 and ISO 17635 with quality level C.
- 5) Bidder to confirm following necessary requirement during fabrication before finalization for placement of purchase order:
 - a) Flatness to be checked.
 - b) Technological supports to be used as and where required.

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- c) Ensure sequential welding is done with root run DP tested.
 - d) Ensure NDT of weld joint is carried out before hand, where no approach is available after complete assembly and proper records for same is maintained.
 - e) Ensure control marking is done before stress relieving to ensure proper machining allowances, if any.
 - f) Stress relieving of welded sub-assemblies is to be done prior to final assembly.
 - g) All welded joint and adjacent areas to be cleaned thoroughly and should be free of weld tears, lumps, weld spatter etc.
- 6) All part items should be made as per part drawings (flatness, perpendicularity etc. to be maintained) and to be cross-checked once again before assembly.

F. TESTING AND INSPECTION REQUIREMENTS

- 1) The Bidder shall carry out quality inspection as agreed in QAP to establish and maintain the quality as per drawings/ BOM/ Specification/ TDC to ensure the mechanical accuracy of components, compliance with drawings, identification and acceptability of all materials, parts and equipment.
- 2) BHEL shall be notified in writing for witnessing of tests and inspections identified as BHEL / End Customer Hold Points (CHP) in the QP, three weeks in advance of the actual date of inspection/test. Quality Plan format shall be sent along with enquiry to Bidder and vendor to fill relevant details and obtain BHEL/Customer approval.
- 3) All the stage inspections should be followed as per Quality Plan Requirements and its record should be kept by the Bidder. Stage-wise inspection report to be ensured against all processes/operations whether called or not in approved quality plan/specification.
- 4) BHEL representative shall be given full access to the workshop in which equipment is being manufactured or tested and all test record shall be made available to BHEL. Final inspection shall be carried out by BHEL/BHEL representative & end customer before the dispatch of the item.
- 5) Bidder will ensure All Tests/ Checks during various stages of manufacturing to be carried out as per agreed quality plan / drawings specification requirements and shall be binding on Bidder. However, in the event of any deficiency observed in any part of Enquiry Item, BHEL reserves the right to extend the scope of inspection / testing if found necessary.
- 6) Tests and inspection requirements shall be finalized in detail at the time of quality plan finalization. The test / checks envisaged by BHEL to be carried out (listed below) are minimum



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requirement. However additional tests / checks to be carried out by Bidder as per national/international standards and their internal practice.

7) QA package shall include the following and shall be submitted to BHEL for approval with the dispatch of the equipment/ prior to dispatch of equipment.

- Approved Welding Procedure Specification (WPS) and Procedure Qualification Record.
- Welder's Qualification records.
- Records of all NDT
- Dimensional Report
- Material Test Certificate (Chemical composition & Mechanical Properties) as per EN 10204: 3.2 from any NABL accredited lab/ Govt approved lab/ Internationally accredited lab/OEM approved lab in additional to Mill TC.
- Records of all tests / checks as per Quality Plan /drawing / specifications.
- Records of heat-treatment. If any.
- Records of repairs. If any.
- Records of deviations / concessions, if any and their approval BHEL / customer.

8) Stage Inspection - Stage inspection / supervision shall take place during course of manufacturing. Any deviation from the test / inspection, envisaged in the quality plans shall require the consent of the BHEL. All tests and examination listed shall be binding for stage inspection. The Bidder shall be responsible for the execution and commissioning of the inspection / test listed in the Quality Plan.

9) Third party inspection will be carried out for all material / component / equipment /assemblies at the end of all shop tests at the Bidder's works for following:

- Verification of completeness and acceptance of all previous tests, inspections & checks performed and satisfactory documentation of the same.
- Checks for workmanship appearance and cleanliness.
- Checks for identification, painting, preservation and packing.

G. ACCEPTANCE TESTING

1) Lifting Fixture shall be subjected to functional test as per Loading test arrangements drawing no. R7878-0773/100 at Haridwar. In particular, the freedom of movement of moving parts, adherence to the tolerance and also to the clearance necessary for proper functioning shall be demonstrated by the Bidder

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- 2) Load testing to be carried out at BHEL Haridwar works using BHEL Haridwar facility. Support for the same shall be provided to Bidder. In-case slings are used in the load testing of Lifting Fixture, then each slings leg shall be Functional load tested to twice the permissible working load prior to use. In case solid links etc. are used in place of slings, Functional Load testing shall be at 1.5 times the permissible working load. A certificate issued by competent authority shall be furnished. Lifting arrangement such as slings will be in bidder's scope.
- 3) Load testing shall be done in presence of BHEL or its representative. Assembly and load testing shall be the sole responsibility of the Bidder. 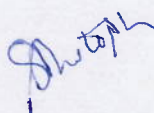

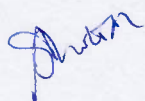

The Confidential Information shall also include all reports, notes or other material prepared by the Receiving Party based on the Confidential Information and/ or any discussion thereon.
 - (ii) Confidential Information includes information disclosed by the Disclosing Party or by any individual, firm or corporation controlled by, controlling, or under the common control of the Disclosing Party.

Recipient shall notify the Disclosers immediately upon discovery of any unauthorized use or disclosure of Confidential Information by Recipient or its Representatives, or any other breach of this Agreement by Recipient or its Representatives, and will cooperate with efforts by the Discloser regain possession of Confidential Information and prevent its further unauthorized use.

14. Survival



The provisions of Clauses 8, 9 & 10 of this Agreement, and the rights and obligations contained there under shall not terminate upon termination of this Agreement.

15. Governing Law & Dispute Resolution

The contract shall be governed by the Law for the time being in force in the Republic of India. Civil Court having original Civil Jurisdiction at (name of Place) ^{HARIDWAR} shall alone have exclusive jurisdiction in regard to all matters in respect of this agreement.

Except as provided elsewhere in this Contract, in case amicable settlement is not reached between the Parties, in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach, termination, validity or execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the Parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the Contract; or, in any manner touching upon the Contract, then, either Party may, by a notice in writing to the other Party refer such dispute or difference to arbitration. The arbitration shall be conducted by three arbitrators, one to be appointed by each of the Parties and a third arbitrator to be appointed by the mutual consent of the two arbitrators so appointed by the Parties.

The Arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the Parties. Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be HARIDWAR (the place from where the contract is issued)

16. No Publication

Neither Party shall disclose, publicise or advertise in any manner the discussions or negotiations contemplated by the Agreement without the prior written consent of the other Party, except as may be required by law.

17. Miscellaneous

- (a) This Agreement constitutes the entire understanding between the parties and supersedes any and all prior or contemporaneous understandings and agreements, whether oral or written, between the parties, with respect to the subject matter hereof. This Agreement can only be modified by a written amendment signed by the party against whom enforcement of such modification is sought.
- (b) Any failure by a Discloser to enforce the Recipient's strict performance of any provision of this Agreement will not constitute a waiver of its right to subsequently enforce such provision or any other provision of this Agreement.

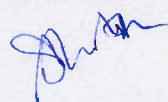


- (c) Although the restrictions contained in this Agreement are considered by the parties to be reasonable for the purpose of protecting the Confidential Information, if any such restriction is found by a court of competent jurisdiction to be unenforceable, such provision will be modified, rewritten or interpreted to include as much of its nature and scope as will render it enforceable. If it cannot be so modified, rewritten or interpreted to be enforceable in any respect, it will not be given effect, and the remainder of the Agreement will be enforced as if such provision was not included.
- (d) Any notices or communications required or permitted to be given hereunder may be delivered by hand, deposited with a nationally recognized overnight carrier, electronic-mail, or mailed by certified mail, return receipt requested, postage prepaid, in each case, to the address of the other party first indicated above (or such other addressee as may be furnished by a party in accordance with this paragraph). All such notices or communications shall be deemed to have been given and received (a) in the case of personal delivery or electronic-mail, on the date of such delivery, and (b) in the case of delivery by a nationally recognized overnight carrier, on the third business day following dispatch.
- (e) Parties shall not directly or indirectly assign or transfer it by operation of law or otherwise without the prior written consent of the Disclosers, which consent will not be unreasonably withheld. All obligations contained in this Agreement shall extend to and be binding upon the parties to this Agreement and their respective successors, assigns and designees.
- (f) Paragraph headings used in this Agreement are for reference only and shall not be used or relied upon in the interpretation of this Agreement.

18. **Notices**

All notices, documents, consents, approvals or other communications (a 'Notice') to be given hereunder shall be in writing and shall be transmitted by first class registered or recorded delivery mail to the person at the address specified herein below, or by telex, facsimile or other electronic means in a form generating a record copy to the party being served at the relevant address for that party shown herein below. Any Notice sent by mail shall be deemed to have been duly served on receipt of delivery confirmation. Any Notice sent by telex facsimile or other electronic means shall be deemed to have been duly served at the time of transmission.
