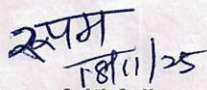

2.5 **Delivery Required:** Specified delivery within **12 weeks** from the date of issue of P.O. / LOI. However early delivery is preferred.

2.6 **L D Clause:** LD shall be 0.5 % of the Basic order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the full order value. In case of any change to the order value, the LD shall be 0.5% of the revised Basic order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of revised Basic order value. 2.9 **Transportation:** Shall be arranged by Vendor upto place of delivery. Transportation charges shall be included in the quoted price & shall remain firm for total supply.

2.10 Packing & Forwarding: Price should be quoted inclusive of all Packing & Forwarding charges. Additional charges, if any shall not be entertained at later stage. Material should be packed in proper wooden casing using suitable material i.e. plastic sheet, bubble wrap in pockets etc. duly secured to avoid any transit damage and to sustain long duration storage at site. All parts of equipment are to be duly packed as per packing list to avoid misplacement /theft. At the time of unboxing at site, if any parts found missing, same shall be replenished by vendor without any additional cost to BHEL. PO reference shall be clearly marked on wooden box in indelible ink.

2.11 Payment Terms:

- Payment of 100% of basic cost towards supply + 100% taxes + all other charges will be made within 90 days, (45 days for MSE Vendors; 60 days for Medium Vendors) against submission of one set of all documents as per PO and receipt of material in our stores subject to acceptance of material. In any case payment against Proforma invoice shall not be payable. HSN/SAC Code to be mentioned on Invoice against each items.
- Payment will be made through e-payment only. Vendor should furnish bank details if not submitted earlier.
- Progressive payment can be made after deduction of LD, if any as and when the item (s) is received and accepted at site. However, transportation charges will remain firm for total supply.
- Any deviation in payment terms quoted by vendor is not accepted.

" For goods / works / services on Indian Suppliers / Contractors: Irrespective of the value of the invoice amount, the supplier/ contractor should necessarily upload the invoice details on BHEL SUVIDHA portal at <https://suvidha.bhel.in/suvidha/>, prior to despatch/raising invoice. All documents as per contract checklist, along with additional documents (if any), must be uploaded on the portal. It is mandatory that tax invoices with a net amount (including taxes) exceeding Rs five lakhs uploaded on the portal are digitally signed using a Class 3 Digital Signature Certificate (DSC) issued by a licensed Certifying Authority. Submission of invoice document in hard copy is allowed for invoices with a net amount (including taxes) equal to and upto Rs five lakhs in case the requirement for digitally signed invoice is not explicitly mentioned in the contract checklist. The Invoice will not be accepted in absence of the above.

2.12 Taxes & Duties: The quoted price shall be inclusive of GST as may be applicable on date of submission of offer as per GeM process. However, if any new taxes & duties are introduced or any variation occurred in existing rate of GST subsequent to bid submission and during the currency of the execution of the order including its extension if any, the same shall be reimbursed at actual against documentary evidence to be submitted by the vendor. In case the delivery schedule is extended for the reasons attributable to the Vendor, no such variation shall be admissible. Successful vendor has to file their GST return by the statutory date. In case, any purchase of BHEL is not appearing in the return of the vendor and/or if any loss incurred by BHEL due to non-compliance / delay in compliance by the vendor as per GST Act, BHEL reserves the right to recover the money including penalty if any or retain payment of the vendor till all compliances are made.

2.13 Transit Insurance: By Vendor.

2.14 Inspection: Material shall be inspected at BHEL-EMRP. However, vendor has to submit all test report and results or COC or both for approval before dispatch of item. Vendor has to obtain prior approval on the test reports and MDCC (Material Dispatch Clearance Certificate) before dispatch of material from BHEL.

2.15 Warranty: 12 months from the date of supply.

- 2.16 Online Demonstration:** In case of Online demonstration (if applicable) and if requested by BHEL shall be in vendor scope for free of cost. No extra Charges for the same shall be paid. The online demonstration shall be valid till completion of warrantee period.
- 2.17 Non-Disclosure Agreement:** All drawings and technical documents relating to the product or it's manufacture submitted by one party to the other, prior or subsequent to the formation of contract, shall remain property of the submitting party. Drawing, technical documents or other technical information received by one party, shall not without the consent of the other party, be used for any other purpose than that, for which they were provided, such technical information shall not without the consent of the submitting party, otherwise be used or copied, reproduced, transmitted or communicated to a third party. Patterns supplied by BHEL will remain BHEL's property which shall be returned by the bidder on demand to BHEL. Bidder shall in no way share or use such intellectual property of BHEL to promote his own business with others. BHEL reserves the right to claim damages from the bidder, or take appropriate penal action as deemed fit against the bidder, for any infringement of the provisions contained herein.
- 2.18 Risk Purchase:** If the material is not supplied within the agreed delivery period, BHEL reserves the right to cancel the order and purchase the material from alternate source(s) at the Risk and Cost of the Seller. In such an event, it shall be obligatory on the part of seller to make good any loss suffered by the purchaser
- 2.19 Force Majeure:** The supplier shall not be considered in default if delay occurs due to causes beyond their control such as Acts of God, Natural Calamities, Frost, Fire, flood, Civil War, Civil Commotion, Riot, Government Restrictions.
Only those causes that have duration of more than seven days shall be considered cause of force majeure. Notification to this effect duly certifies by local chamber of commerce/statutory authorities with supporting documents shall be given by the supplier to BHEL by registered letter/courier service without loss of time.
In the event of delay due to such causes the delivery schedule shall be extended for a length of time equal to the period of Force Majeure or at the option of BHEL the order may be cancelled. Such cancellation would be without any liability whatsoever on the part of BHEL.
In the event of such cancellation the supplier shall refund any amount advanced or paid to the supplier by BHEL and deliver back any material issued to him by BHEL and release facilities, if any provided by BHEL.
- 2.20 Defective Material replacement:** Supplier shall replace defective material free of cost (inclusive of all testing, inspection, TPI, service charges etc.) upto delivery site within two months from defect notification date.

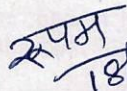

3.0 GENERAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

- 3.1 BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer and or award the work in full or part without assigning any reason.
- 3.2 Tender should be free from over writing and erasers, additions if any must be attested.
- 3.3 Purchase Order will be subject to general conditions of purchase prevailing in Bharat Heavy Electricals Limited.

- 3.4 All questions/interpretations regarding subject matter of the contract shall be decided by BHEL on the request of the contractor/vendor and the decision of BHEL shall be final.
- 3.5 In case of dispute, steps shall be taken by the parties to settle the same through negotiations.
- 3.6 In case dispute is not settled in negotiation, it shall be referred to a Conciliation appointed by BHEL.
- 3.7 In case dispute is not settled in conciliation proceedings too, the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of General Manager of the Department/Executive Director of the unit or any person nominated by any of them as per corporate Guidelines of BHEL and the arbitration proceedings shall be taken out as per provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended read with BHEL's Corporate guidelines in force.
- 3.8 The place of arbitration shall be at Mumbai only.
- 3.9 The Civil Courts at Mumbai shall have jurisdiction to entertain the cases arising out of the arbitration proceedings.
- 3.10 "For this procurement, Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 15.06.2017, 28.05.2018, 29.05.2019 & 04.06.2020 and subsequent Orders issued by the respective Nodal Ministry shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT but before finalization of contract/PO/WO against this NIT.

In the event of any Nodal Ministry prescribing higher or lower percentage of purchase preference and/or local content in respect of this procurement, same shall be applicable."

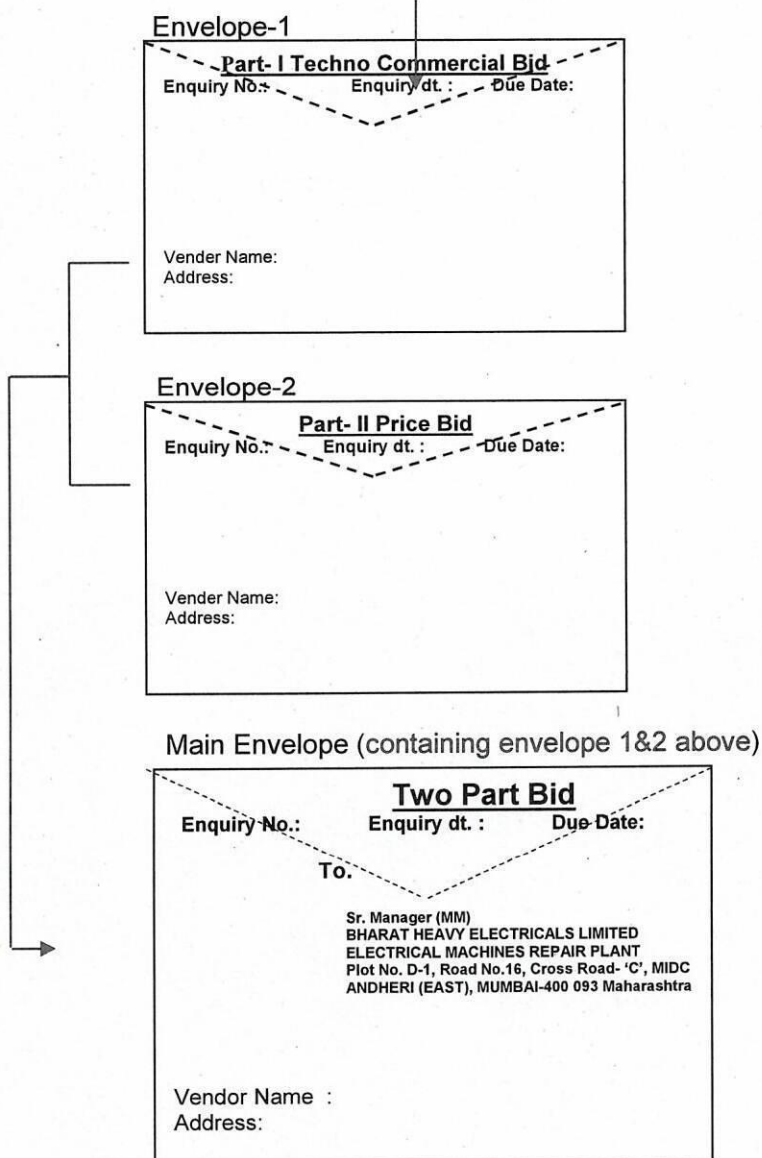

PROCEDURE FOR SUBMISSION OF TENDER

- 4.1 Bidder shall submit the offer in two bid system in two different sealed covers.
- 4.2 Part 'A': Techno-Commercial Bid.
- 4.3 Part 'B': Price Bid.
- 4.4 **Tender No., date and due date of opening should be written on both the covers.**
- 4.5 These two covers shall then be placed in a large cover and sealed. The large cover should also have Tender no., Date and Due Date. This should be dropped in the tender box placed at the entrance of our works before due date and time.
- 4.6 **Part 'A' - Techno Commercial Bid:** Techno Commercial Bid shall contain technical and commercial offer as per NIT Proforma, indicating acceptance of NIT terms, as per Annexure-I. Acceptance of all technical and commercial terms and conditions given in the format **Annexure I**. (No Deviation certificate and deviation Proforma), duly filled in signed as required. Blank price-bid proforma indicating only rates of taxes and duties applicable without rate / price of material should be enclosed with the techno-commercial bid Part A.
- 4.7 **Part 'B' - Price Bid** Part B should contain only the price duly filled in **Price Bid Proforma Annexure II, without any terms and conditions**. Any terms and conditions, if mentioned in the price bid, shall be ignored and not considered. Price Bid received in open condition will be considered only if the offer is technically and commercially accepted without any deviation. The offer received having price bid in open condition and with technical/commercial deviation will be rejected.
- 4.8 Any deviation in the above mentioned terms and conditions or conditional offer may render the offer invalid and shall be liable to be rejected, and price bid of such bidders shall not be opened. Price bid of only those bidders shall be opened whose Techno-Commercial offer is found suitable and acceptable.

PROCESS: -

- The price bid envelope would be kept sealed which would be opened at a later date for only those suppliers who would qualify in the techno commercial bid. During scrutiny of offer, suppliers are supposed to reply for clarifications, if asked, within a week's time.
- The bids shall be evaluated on total delivered cost to BHEL (HESG rate).
- The offers shall also be suitably loaded for any deviation from the Terms and Conditions to arrive at the HESG rate.
