B) Completion Schedule of the project:

Supply, Installation, commissioning, testing, stabilization, demonstration and training of the Video Surveillance Camera system at BHEL PSER NORTH KARANPURA as per BOM mentioned in Annexure 1 should be completed within 30 days from the date of delivery instruction from the Authorized official of North Karanpura Site, BHEL PSER. This instruction shall be given after placement of Purchase Order to the vendor.

Post-delivery inspection would be carried out by the indenting department to ensure functional completeness of supplied items. Materials found defective at the time of delivery should be replaced free of cost by vendor within 10 days of date of intimation from BHEL.

C) Warranty period:

Two-year default warranty of the items as mentioned in Annexure 1 shall presume from the date of installation as per certification from Indenting Department

D) Newness Certificate:

All the items as marked in Annexure -1, to be supplied under the scope of this tender, should be NEW and confirming to the contract technical specifications.

The newness certificate should be furnished (as indicated against the items in Bill of Material) containing the Serial number or identification number of the item along with the mention of month and year of manufacturing of the items.

- OEM O&M manuals (as applicable) and drawings wherever applicable, have to be provided by the vendor along with the supplied materials as a part of handover.
- After Installation of the whole set up the vendor has to submit proper installation report which has to be duly signed by vendor's service engineer and BHEL Personnel.
- Vendor can submit bill after completion of supply & installation along with delivery challan, job completion certificate other required document from concerned site.
- All the contract related deliverable have to be submitted as per tender specification before submission of bill like OEM warranty certificate etc. if not submitted during submission of offer. The contractors must have adequate equipment and qualified staff for executing such job.

E) Liquidated Damage/ Penalty for delay in completion of the project

If the vendor fails to complete the job of Supply, Installation, commissioning of the Video Surveillance Camera system at BHEL PSER NORTH KARANPURA as per BOM mentioned in Technical Scope and SCC within the scheduled stipulate time as mentioned above, a penalty of @0.5% per week of delay of total PO value shall be imposed on the vendor.

Maximum penalty for delay in completion of the job of Supply, Installation & commissioning of the Video Surveillance Camera system at BHEL PSER NORTH KARANPURA shall be 15% of the PO Value. **In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall also be recovered from vendor.**

F) Quarterly Maintenance scope:

During the entire warranty period of 2 years, vendor has to extend support towards maintenance of the entire setup of the Video Surveillance system as supplied and being installed by the vendor as per the scope of the tender. For this support vendor will be paid quarterly maintenance charges at end of each quarter. This payment shall be linked to the quarterly SLA. Vendor has to ensure 98.0% uptime for the system.

G) Downtime

System down due to physical damage (like Rat Bitten / Theft Cases / Damage / Burnt etc. cases) shall not come under vendor's service availability scope. Vendor has to restore the service within 2 days of reporting. Afterwards downtime shall be applicable. Any downtime other than above shall be accounted under vendor scope and downtime is applicable as per downtime clause.

In case of Downtime deduction, the applicable GST shall also be recovered from vendor.

During the Warranty period the Vendor shall have to provide breakdown maintenance for the whole set up for which BHEL shall not pay any separate charges.

(a) **Breakdown Maintenance:** Any breakdown call from site needs to be attended within 4 hours over telephone from the time of logging the call for **site in the scope** and if needed, vendor's engineer must reach site within 4 hours from the time of logging the call. If the call is not resolved within 4 hours then the downtime after allowable 8 hours shall be considered as downtime as per the downtime calculation.

(b) **During the contract period BHEL shall not provide any other special utility required to perform the above job to vendor. The vendor nevertheless shall be required to deploy the legal and licensed software and branded hardware only for the purpose.**

Call for equipment malfunction shall be reported by BHEL to the service group of the vendor. For this purpose, the vendor shall furnish details, viz. Office addresses, name of contact person, phone no. etc to BHEL. The vendor will inform the call serial no or acceptance and the time of call reporting for which BHEL and the vendor's complaint registering office will maintain record.

Time of reporting of all calls shall be within normal office hour's i.e. 9.00 AM to 5.30 PM. All calls reported after 15-00 hrs on Monday to Friday and after 12-00 hrs on Saturdays, shall be treated as a call reported on the next working day for the purpose of downtime calculations. During Warranty Period Compensation During warranty period if the system fails to keep the requisite uptime as per UPTIME/DOWNTIME clause then the prorated amount will be deducted first from the quarterly maintenance charges and then from the 10% retention amount (if downtime penalty is more than the quarterly maintenance charges) as mentioned in payment terms as per the following formula given below.

The period of the warranty, under this scope is for a minimum of Two Year (As specified in the Scope of Work of this Document). All the equipment as mentioned Annexure 1 (except consumable items like STP cable, Optical Fiber cable, casing/conduit/HDPE Pipe and CAT 6 RJ 45 connectors) should have minimum TWO-Year Warranty. The date of commencement of warranty shall be from date of installation completion duly certified by concerned executing officials of BHEL.

- B. Balance 20% of Supply value plus 100% of the Installation & Commissioning charges excluding GST and BOCW Cess**, as applicable shall be payable against submission of the following:
- a) Installation & Commissioning Report signed by BHEL.
 - b) Submission of Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG) of 10% of total PO value in the prescribed format valid as per tendered PBG clause. The PBG confirmation charges shall be borne by vendor. If vendor opines not to submit PBG, equivalent amount of PBG will be kept withheld till completion of warranty/guarantee period. The withheld amount will be released after successful completion of warranty/guarantee period.

 - iv. Above is subject to receipt of goods / service and tax invoice thereof along with vendor declaring invoice in his return and paying GST within timeline prescribed for availing ITC by BHEL.
- GST along with any interest if levied thereon for reasons elaborated in Taxes and Duties clause of the tender which is not attributable to BHEL will be recovered from the Final Payment / retention.
- No advance shall be paid. Payment shall be paid in INR only.
 - Payment shall be through RTGS
 - Paying Authority: RAO, BHEL PSER North Karanpura.
 - Quantities mentioned under Sl. No. 1(vii), 1(xi), 1(xii), 1(xiii), 1(xiv), 1(xv), 2(i) & 2(ii) may vary (Increase or Decrease) during execution stage due to changes in layouts/ dimensions etc. and they will be paid on the basis of actual execution. Bidder shall furnish unit rate for these items.

I) Other Terms and Conditions

1. The vendor should submit the OEM (original equipment manufacturer) authorization for camera, network video recorder & radio frequency (RF) device. Bidder should submit documentary evidence to ascertain the same. The OEM of camera and network video recorder should be the same.
2. Bidder should have experience in installation and commissioning of the following:
 - 1) Pan Tilt Zoom camera.

Bidder may comply the above by submitting copy of order & Completion Certificate/ documentary evidence issued by the client/end user in support of above along with details of customer contact.
3. BHEL office having its own LAN system, The Video Surveillance system shall be integrated with BHEL LAN.
4. Main supply items are fixed as per BOM mentioned in Annexure 1.
5. During warranty period BHEL may ask for shifting of camera location within the site premises.
6. Vendor shall provide UPS power at identified location for powering the POE switches. Camera to be powered through the POE Switches.
7. User training after completion of installation is under vendor scope which should be inclusive in the quoted price.
8. Charges for deployment of manpower including fooding and lodging expenses for the above scope of main and optional job shall be borne by vendor. No additional claims of vendor shall be entertained in this regard by BHEL.
9. During the warranty period any sort of job like cleaning of Camera or any other job required pertaining to this matter shall be under the scope of the vendor.
10. The Maintenance of the entire setup during the entire warranty period shall be in the scope of the vendor.
11. Validity of offer should be minimum of NINETY (90) DAYS from the date of offer.
12. The bidder must have at least one service personnel of their own in the state of Bihar/Jharkhand/West Bengal so that the site can be catered in least possible time.
13. Vendor has to submit offer for all items as mentioned in the BOM including the optional items. Incomplete bid for any item shall not be considered for evaluation.
14. As per site condition alteration request may come. Vendor has to carry out shifting of location of camera within the warranty period within same site. Vendor has to offer for lumpsum price for shifting as mentioned in BOM. Required cable which are existing in BOM like Cat-6 Cable shall be provided by BHEL as per agreed rate. All other consumables must be included in shifting charges.
15. During the contract period if any damage or similar incident happen which are not attributable to vendor & requires reinstallation, same shall be considered as shifting or alteration as per scope. BHEL competent official shall initiate a request for the same. Vendor has to submit bill of such alteration charges with request letter and completion certificate.
16. Vendor has to submit quarterly visit report with BHEL concerned official signature for clearance of "Quarterly Maintenance Charges". The invoice for "Quarterly Maintenance Charges" shall be raised by the vendor to BHEL after completion of the quarter.
17. Vendor has to carry out a detail survey before starting supply of material and implementation and required to submit an implementation plan in discussion with concerned BHEL official.
18. The coverage area and implementation topology shall be decided jointly by BHEL concerned engineer and vendor before start of work, which is inclusive in the Contract. BOM as published are tentative.
19. BHEL may ask for integration with existing WAN connection available at site. In that case BHEL will provide network IP series and LAN Connection. BHEL may ask for enabling same facility over WAN. Vendor has to be provide necessary system support for the same **free of cost**.

20. OEM Warranty should cover replacement / repair of devices from OEM. Vendor has to be provided undertaking or certification from OEM for availability of spare during the warranty period.
21. Theft / loss / physical damage related insurance issues are under BHEL scope as an outright item / device after the delivery & acceptance.
22. During maintenance, vendor may require accessing the BHEL server room/ Network racks. BHEL may ask vendor personnel for providing of non-disclosure agreement (NDA) for security purpose
23. **SHIFTING / ALTERATION OF LOCATION (WITHIN SITE) during the warranty period:**
TEN (10) DAYS notice period will be provided to the vendor for each order placed (if any) for shifting and redeployment. If shifting and Redeployment is not completed within 10 days of notice period, due to reasons attributable to vendor, penalty @0.5% per week of delay of total order or part thereof limited to PBG or equivalent amount of PBG that will be kept withheld till completion of warranty/guarantee period as stipulated in payment terms (CI .H) of TCC.
In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall also be recovered from vendor.
24. **SHIFTING/ALTERATION OF LOCATION (ANYWHERE IN INDIA) during the warranty period:**
THIRTY (30) DAYS notice period will be provided to the vendor for each order placed (if any) for shifting and redeployment. If shifting and Redeployment is not completed within 30 days of notice period, due to reasons attributable to vendor, penalty @0.5% per week of delay of total order or part thereof limited to value of the re-deployment job, shall be applicable.
In case of LD recovery, the applicable GST shall also be recovered from vendor.
25. **Extra Work Charges**
Some of the quantities in BOQ are provisional and may vary to any extent at the time of Execution of work. Contract shall be operated in item rate basis. Quoted Rate shall remain firm within the variation of (+/-) 30 (Thirty percent) percent of the awarded price.

J) TERMINATION:

BHEL, PSER may terminate this CONTRACT at any time by informing the vendor of BHEL PSER's intention to do so in writing by giving notice for a period of one month and without assigning any reasons whatsoever. In such case, no payment will be given for the balance period of CONTRACT including period of unsatisfactory services, if any. BHEL shall have the option for termination of the contract, which may be required by BHEL due to site closure with 3 months' notice period.

K) THIRD PARTY AGREEMENT:

As per Information Security Management System (ISMS) policies of BHEL, PSER vendor should enter into a third party agreement with BHEL, PSER after receipt of order.

L) FORCE MAJEURE:

The service Provider shall not be responsible for delay in delivery resulting from acts/events beyond his control, the Service Provider gives provided notice of the happening of any such act/event to the Purchaser within 15 days from the date of its occurrence. Such acts/events shall include but not be limited to acts of God, war, floods, earthquakes, strikes, lockouts, epidemics, riots, fire or Governmental regulations superimposed after the date of order/contract.

M) Price Variation Clause: Not Applicable

N) Over Run Charges: Not Applicable

O) Taxes and Duties

- 1) TDS under Income Tax shall be deducted at prevailing rates on gross invoice value from the running bills unless exemption certificate from the appropriate authority / authorities is furnished.
- 2) TDS under GST shall be deducted at prevailing rates on gross invoice value from the running bills.
- 3) **All taxes excluding GST with applicable cess & BOCW Cess (dealt separately in Tender)** but including, Charges, Royalties, any State or Central Levy and other Taxes for materials if any obtained for the work and for the execution of the contract shall be borne by the bidder and shall not be payable extra by BHEL.
- 4) Any increase of the same at any stage during execution including extension of the contract shall have to be borne by the contractor. Quoted / accepted rates / price shall be inclusive of all such requirements. **Please note that since GST on output will be paid by BHEL separately as enumerated below, the bidder quoted rates / price should be after considering the Input Credit under GST law at the bidder end.**

- 10) Bidder shall upload the Invoices raised on BHEL in GSTR-1 within the prescribed time as given in the GST Act. Bidder shall note that in case of delay in declaring such invoice in the bidder return and GST credit availed by BHEL is denied or reversed subsequently as per GST Law, GST amount paid by BHEL towards such ITC reversal as per GST law shall be recoverable from the bidder along with interest levied / leviable on BHEL.
- 11) Way Bill: Successful Bidder to arrange for way bill / e-waybill for any transfer of goods for the execution of the contract.
The Bidder has to make their own arrangement at their cost for completing the formalities, if required, with Issuing Authorities, for bringing materials, plants & machinery at site for execution of the works under this contract, Road Permit / Way Bill, if required, shall be arranged by the contractor and BHEL will not supply any Road Permit / Way Bill for this purpose.

SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS OF THE CONTRACT**MEASUREMENT OF WORK AND MODE OF PAYMENT:**

- a) All payments due to the contractors shall be made by e mode only, unless otherwise found operationally difficult for reasons to be recorded in writing.
- b) These measurement sheets will be checked by BHEL Engineer and quantities and percentage eligible for payment under various groups shall be decided by BHEL Engineer. The abstract of quantities and percentage so arrived at based on the terms of payment shall be entered in Measurement Book and signed by both the parties.
- c) Based on the above quantities, contractor shall prepare the bills in prescribed format and work out the financial value. These will be entered in Measurement Book and signed by both the parties. Payment shall be made by BHEL after effecting the recoveries due from the contractor.
- d) All recoveries due from the contractor for the month/period shall be effected in full from the corresponding running bills unless specific approval from the competent authorities is obtained to the contrary.
- e) Measurement shall be restricted to that portion of work for which it is required to ascertain the financial liability of BHEL under this contract.
- f) The measurement shall be taken jointly by persons duly authorized on the part of BHEL and by the Contractor.
- g) The Contractor shall bear the expenditure involved if any, in making the measurements and testing of materials to be used/used in the work. The contractor shall, without extra charges, provide all the assistance with appliances and other things necessary for measurement.
- h) If at any time due to any reason whatsoever, it becomes necessary to re-measure the work done in full or in part, the expenses towards such re measurements shall be borne by the contractor unless such re measurements are warranted solely for reasons not attributable to contractor.
- i) Passing of bills covered by such measurements does not amount to acceptance of the completion of the work measured. Any left out work has to be completed, if pointed out at a later date by BHEL.
- j) Final measurement bill shall be prepared in the final bill format prescribed for the purpose based on the certificate issued by BHEL Engineer that entire works as stipulated in tender specification has been completed in all respects to the entire satisfaction of BHEL. Contractor shall give unqualified "No Claim" Certificate. All the tools and tackles loaned to him should be returned in satisfactory condition to BHEL. The abstract of final quantities and financial values shall also be entered in the Measurement Books and signed by both parties to the contract. The Final Bill shall be prepared and paid within a reasonable time after completion of work.

INSURANCE:

It is the sole responsibility of the contractor to insure his materials, equipments, workmen, etc. against accidents and injury while at work and to pay compensation, if any, to workmen as per Workmen's compensation Act. The work will be carried out in a protected area and all the rules and regulations of the client /BHEL in the area of project which are in force from time to time will have to be followed by the contractor.

RESPONSIBILITIES OF THE CONTRACTOR IN RESPECT OF LOCAL LAWS, EMPLOYMENT OF WORKERS ETC.

The following are the responsibilities of the contractor in respect of observance of local laws, employment of personnel, payment of taxes etc. The subcontractor shall fully indemnify BHEL against any claims of whatsoever nature arising due to the failure of the contractor in discharging any of his responsibilities hereunder:

- a. The contractor shall comply with all applicable State and Central Laws, Statutory Rules, Regulations etc. such as Payment of Wages Act, Minimum Wages Act, Workmen Compensation Act, Employer's Liability Act, Industrial Disputes Act, Employers Provident Act, Employees State Insurance Scheme, Contract Labour (Regulation and Abolition) Act 1970, Payment of Bonus & Gratuity Act and other Acts, Rules and Regulations for labour as may be enacted by the Government during the tenure of the Contract and having force or jurisdiction at Site. The Contractor shall also give to the local Governing Body, Police and other relevant Authorities all such notices as may be required by the Law.
- b. The contractor shall pay all taxes, fees, license charges, deposits, duties, tolls, royalties, commission or other charges which may be leviable on account of his operations in executing the contract.
- c. Contractor shall be responsible for provision of Health and Sanitary arrangements (more particularly described in Contract Labour Regulation & Abolition Act), Safety precautions etc. as may be required for safe and satisfactory execution of contract.
- d. The contractor shall be responsible for the proper behavior and observance of all regulations by the staff employed by him.
- e. The contractor shall ensure that no damage is caused to any person/property of other parties working at site. If any such damage is caused, it is responsibility of the contractor to make good the losses or compensate for the same.
- f. All the properties/equipment/components of BHEL/their Client loaned with or without deposit to the contractor in connection with the contract shall remain properties of BHEL/their Client.

- g. The contractor shall use such properties for the purpose of execution of this contract. All such properties/equipment/components shall be deemed to be in good condition when received by the contractor unless he notifies within 48 hours to the contrary. The contractor shall return them in good condition as and when required by BHEL/their Client. In case of non-return, loss, damage, repairs etc, the cost thereof as may be fixed by BHEL Engineer will be recovered from the contractor
- h. In case the contractor is required to undertake any work outside the scope of this contract, the rates payable shall be those mutually agreed upon if the item rates are not mentioned in existing contract
- i. Any delay in completion of works/or non-achievement of periodical targets due to the reasons attributable to the contractor, the same may have to be compensated by the contractor either by increasing manpower and resources or by working extra hours and/or by working more than one shift. All these are to be carried out by the contractor at no extra cost.
- j. The contractor shall arrange, coordinate his work in such a manner as to cause no hindrance to other agencies working in the same premises.
- k. All safety rules and codes applied by BHEL at site shall be observed by the contractor without exception.
- The contractor shall be responsible for the safety of the equipment/material and works to be performed by him and shall maintain all light, fencing guards, slings etc. or other protection necessary for the purpose. Contractor shall also take such additional precautions as may be indicated from time to time by the Engineer with a view to prevent pilferage, accidents, fire hazards. Due precautions shall be taken against fire hazards and atmospheric conditions.
- i. The contractor shall arrange for such safety devices as are necessary for such type of work and carry out the requisite site tests of handling equipment, lifting tools, tackles etc. as per prescribed standards and practices.
- ii. Contractor has to ensure the implementation of Health, Safety and Environment (HSE) requirements as per directions given by BHEL.
- l. In case of any class of work for which there is no such specification as laid down in the contract, such work shall be carried out in accordance with the instructions and requirements of the Engineer.
- m. Also, no idle charges will be admissible in the event of any stoppage caused in the work resulting in contractor's labour and Tools & Plants being rendered idle due to any reason at any time.
- n. The contractor shall take all reasonable care to protect the materials and work till such time the plant/equipment has been taken over by BHEL or their Client whichever is earlier.
- o. The contractor shall not stop the work or abandon the site for whatsoever reason of dispute, excepting force majeure conditions. All such problems/disputes shall be separately discussed and settled without affecting the progress of work. Such stoppage or abandonment shall be treated as breach of contract and dealt with accordingly.
- p. The contractor shall keep the area of work clean and shall remove the debris etc while executing day-to-day work. Upon completion of work, the contractor shall remove from the vicinity of work, all scrap, packing materials, rubbish, unused and other materials and deposit them in places specified by the Engineer. The contractor will also demolish all the hutments, sheds, offices, etc. constructed and used by him and shall clean the debris. In the event of his failure to do so, the same will be arranged to be done by the Engineer and the expenses recovered from the contractor.
- q. The contractor shall execute the work in the most substantial and workman like manner in the stipulated time.
- Accuracy of work and timely execution shall be the essence of this contract. The contractor shall be responsible to ensure that the quality, assembly and workmanship conform to the dimensions and clearance given in the drawings and/ or as per the instructions of the Engineer.
- r. In case BHEL provides vendor any T&Ps and MMDs and incase of any damage / loss of the same is due to carelessness/ negligence on the part of the contractor, the Contractor is liable to get them repair/ replaced immediately and in case of his failure to do so within a reasonable time, BHEL will reserve the right to recover the loss from the contractor.

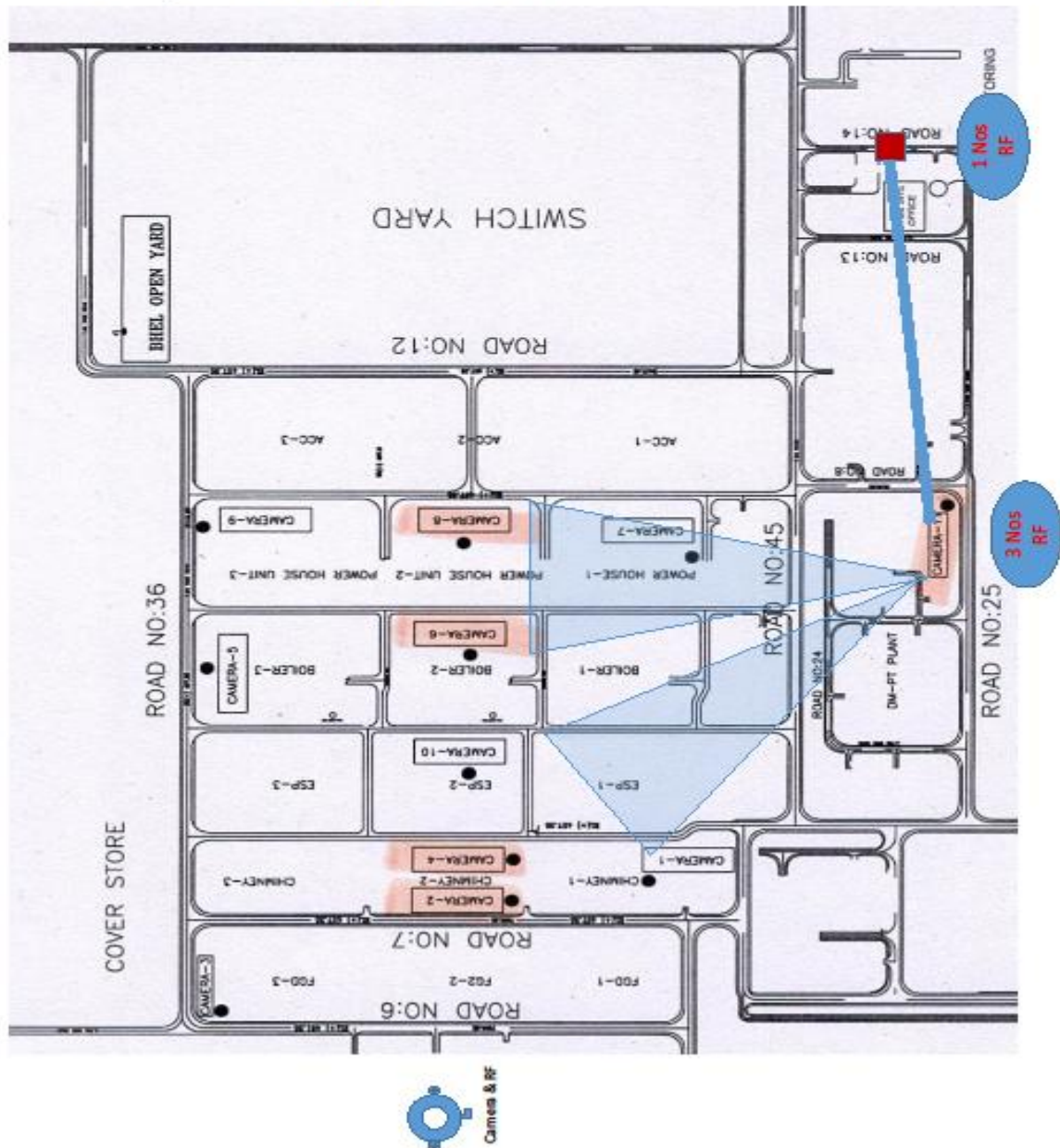
