21. Tender Evaluation - The evaluation currency for this tender shall be INR. Evaluation will be done on overall L1 (Total Cost to BHEL excluding GST) basis with necessary loading as applicable.	



The loading (technical/commercial), if any, shall be added at the time of evaluation. Ordering shall be done after de-loading the commercial/ technical loading from bidder's final price.

In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders.

In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder (s) or their representative(s).

Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final & binding.

- 22. Terms & Conditions:- The terms & conditions shall be as per enclosed special conditions of the contract (copy enclosed), GCC Rev 07 which is available on www.pem.bhel.com and other Terms and Conditions included in this Enquiry Letter.
- 23. Bidders who fulfil Pre-Qualification (Technical & Financial) Requirement Criteria are eligible to participate in this tender. Bids of only those bidders shall be evaluated who meet the Pre-Qualifying requirements.
- 24. BHEL shall be resorting to price bid opening (PBO) in this tender. PBO shall be done among all the techno-commercially qualified bidders. Reverse auction process shall not be done for this package.
- 25. Regarding verification of PQR documents-

Bidders to ensure that Third party/customer issued certificates being submitted as proof of PQR qualification should have sufficient verifiable details of document/certificate issuing authority such as name & designation of Issuing Authority and its organization contact number and e-mail Id etc. In case the same are found not available, Purchaser has right to reject such document from evaluation.

- 26. Bidder to note that this is a Global Tender enquiry & PBO participation shall be subject to following condition:
 - a) Qualifying Pre-Qualification Requirements.
 - b) Techno-commercial acceptance of offer by BHEL-PEM.
 - c) Approval of bidder by End Customer: Same shall be taken up with end customer based on the latest credentials/reference list furnished by bidder. Accordingly, bidders are requested to submit credential as per the format enclosed herewith along with their technical bid.

The bidders who are not registered with BHEL-PEM may apply for registration in BHEL-PEM through Registration Portal available at www.pem.bhel.com-->vendor section-->online supplier registration. All credentials and/or documents duly signed & stamped related to registration has to be uploaded on the website & submit the application for registration. One set of hard copy filled-up SRF downloaded from Online Registration Portal duly signed & stamped has to be submitted.

- 27. All corrigenda, addenda, amendments, time extensions, clarifications, etc. to the tender will be hosted on BHEL website (www.bhel.com), https://bhel.abcprocure.com & BHEL-PEM website (www.pem.bhel.com). Bidders should regularly visit websites to keep themselves updated.
- 28. BG should be in favour of PEM. L1 Vendor will be required to submit BG as per GCC Rev-07.

Bidder agrees to submit the performance security required for execution of the contract within the time period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate + 6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further, if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT / contract, from the bills along with due interest.

29. Payment terms:

Payment terms for supply: - as per GCC Rev 07.

Payment terms for training: -100% payment shall be released after successful completion of the activity on pro rata basis, on Site certification/ certification by engineering as applicable.

Payment terms for other goods and services (like as Supervision of E&C, Mandatory spares, PG test etc.) shall be as per GCC Rev 07.



30. Advance Payment: - Normally, no advance payment will be given to any vendor. However, under exceptional circumstances (the decision of the Purchaser as to what constitutes exceptional circumstances shall be final) on request of vendors, advance payment can be made as per following provisions and modalities:

Interest bearing advance payment shall be maximum five percent (5%) of contract value (total contract value excluding taxes and duties of complete scope of package) subject to submission of bank guarantee of 110% of value of advance payment with following conditions:

- (i) This 5% payment shall be interest bearing and interest rate shall be the base rate of SBI (on the date of release of payment) plus 6%.
- (ii) Recovery of this payment along with interest shall be made from the first bill of supply to the maximum extent possible and subsequent bill(s).
- (iii) Interest shall be calculated from the date of release of advance payment by BHEL till due date for supply bill(s) payment or date of release of payment, whichever is earlier.
- (iv) This BG shall be over and above the CPBG (contract performance bank guarantee) as per GCC Rev 07.
- 31. If bidder mentions Not Applicable / Not required / Not Quoted in BHEL price format, the same has to be substantiated by the bidder. If any such item is required to be supplied for system completion in future, same will be supplied free of cost.

- 33. Over all (%) quantity variation: The variation on overall package value due to changes in the scope shall be limited to +/-10%
- 34. **Insurance Deductibles** Insurance Deductibles/Excess shall be as follows: For Marine Cover: Rs 20,000/ -.
- 35. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.
- 36. All Bidders to comply Govt. of India, Ministry of Power, order no-25-111612018-PG dtd 02/07/2020 regarding mandatory testing of all the imported items/equipment's/components.
- 37. GST shall be payable extra at actual as per the HSN code finalised for the items during detailed BBU.
- 38. In place of clause no 26 of (ITB) GCC-Rev-07, following clause to be considered:

"For this procurement, offers from Class I Local Supplier / Class II Local Supplier / Non Local supplier shall be considered. Purchase preference to Class I local supplier, as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), (PPP-MII) Order 2017 dated 16.09.2020 issued by DPIIT shall be given. Further, please note that this package is not divisible in nature.

Bidders are required to provide the following along with the part-1 bid:

- (i) The local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide a certificate from the statutory auditor or cost auditor of the company (in the case of companies) or from a practicing cost accountant or practicing chartered accountant (in respect of suppliers other than companies) giving the percentage of local content.
- (ii) Provide the details of the location(s) at which the local value addition shall be made.



- 39. This item/Package falls under the list of items defined in Para 3 of Ministry guideline ref no.F.20/2/214-PPD(Pt.) dated.20-09-2016 (in respect of procurement of items related to public safety, health, critical security operations and equipment's, etc) & hence no relaxation of PQR for start-up/MSME vendors is envisaged for the NIT items/Package"
- 40. **CHARGES FOR SUPERVISION OF E&C**: Supervision of E&C charges should not exceed 2% of the total contract value, failing which the quoted amount shall be restricted (2% of the total contract value) by BHEL at the time of evaluation and ordering.
- 41. GeM Seller ID shall be mandatory before placement of order/award of contract to the successful bidder.
- 42. Due to Covid-19 Pandemic crisis prevailing in the country, BHEL may go for remote inspection for the subject package. Bidders are requested to be equipped with the facilities/gadgets as required to smooth conductance for inspection remotely.
- 43. GCC Rev-07 to be read instead of GCC Rev-06 and GST related Corrigendum to GCC Rev 06, mentioned in SCC Rev-00.
- 44. Bidders may visit site/ work area and study the job content, facilities available, availability of materials, prevailing site conditions including law & order situation etc. before quoting for this tender. They may also consult this office before submitting their offers, for any clarifications regarding scope of work, facilities available at sites or on terms and conditions. No additional claim shall be entertained by BHEL in future, on account of non-acquaintance of above.
- 45. Restrictions under Rule 144(xi) of the General Financial Rules (GFRs), 2017
 - I. Any bidder from a country which shares a land border with India will be eligible to bid in this tender only if the bidder is registered with the Competent Authority.
 - II. "Bidder" (including the term 'tenderer', 'consultant' or 'service provider' in certain contexts) means any person or firm or company, including any member of a consortium or joint venture (that is an association of several persons, or firms or companies), every artificial juridical person not falling in any of the descriptions of bidders stated hereinbefore, including any agency branch or office controlled by such person, participating in a procurement process.
 - III. "Bidder from a country which shares a land border with India" for the purpose of this Order means a. An entity incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - b. A subsidiary of an entity Incorporated. established or registered in such a country; or
 - c. An entity substantially controlled through entities incorporated, established or registered in such a country; or
 - d. An entity whose beneficial owner is situated in such a country: or
 - e. An Indian (or other) agent of such an entity; or
 - f. A natural person who is a Citizen of such a country; or
 - g. A consortium or joint venture where any member of the consortium or joint venture falls under any of the above.
 - IV. The beneficial owner for the purpose of (iii) above will be as under:
 - 1. In case of a company or Limited Liability Partnership, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has a controlling ownership Interest or who exercises control through other means, Explanation
 - a. "Controlling ownership interest" means ownership of or entitlement to more than twenty-five per cent. of shares or capital or profits of the company;
 - "Control" shall include the right to appoint majority of the directors or to control the management or policy decisions Including by virtue of their shareholding or management rights or shareholder's agreements or voting agreements;
 - 2. In case of a partnership firm, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s) who, whether acting alone or together. or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of entitlement to more than fifteen percent of capital or profits of the partnership;
 - 3. In case of an unincorporated association or body of individuals, the beneficial owner is the natural person(s), who, whether acting alone or together, or through one or more juridical person, has ownership of or entitlement to more than fifteen percent of the property or capital or profits of such association or body of Individuals;



- 4. Where no natural person is Identified under (1) or (2) or (3) above, the beneficial owner is the relevant natural person who holds the position of senior managing official;
- 5. In case of a trust, the identification of beneficial owner(s) shall Include identification of the author of the trust. the trustee, the beneficiaries with fifteen percent or more interest in the trust and any other natural person exercising ultimate effective control over the trust through a chain of control or ownership.
- V. An Agent is a person employed to do any act for another, or to represent another in dealings with third person
- VI. The successful bidder shall not be allowed to sub-contract works to any contractor from a country which shares a land border with India unless such contractor is registered with the Competent Authority.

Note- The above clause shall not be applicable for the bidders from those countries (even if sharing a land order with India) to which the Government of India (GoI) has extended lines of credit or in which the GoI is engaged in development work.

Bidders to submit the certification (format enclosed) as per Order no-F6/18/2019-PPD dated 23.07.2020 issued by Ministry of Finance.

- 46. All the above terms and conditions, post-bid agreements/ MoMs (during Techno- Commercial evaluation) shall automatically become a part of the Order/Contract after its finalisation.
- 47. Bidders to note that offers shall be submitted strictly in accordance with the requirements of tender documents. Bidders shall upload their complete offer meeting the requirements of the tender documents on e-procurement portal https://eprocurebhel.co.in/nicgep/app.

- 48. It shall be the responsibility of the bidder to ensure that the tender complete in all respects is uploaded on or before the due date and time. Incomplete/late offers shall not be considered. 'Part-I bids shall be opened at 04:00 PM on due date through e-procurement Portal.
