1. **ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA**

Average annual turnover of the contractor duly certified by a practitioner chartered accountant during the last 3 years ending 31st March 2021 should be at least. ₹32.70 Lakhs. In case annual turnover for FY 2020-21 is not finalized or ITR is not submitted by the contractor, Average annual turnover during the last 3 years ending 31st March 2020 shall be considered.

Tenderer should enclose EPF, ESI, PAN, GSTIN registration no., Income tax returns for last three years (AY-2019-20, 2020-21, 2021-22/ 2017-18) and Profit & Loss account and Balance Sheet certified by the Practicing Chartered Accountant for the last 3 years.

- II) The Contractor should have experience of completing similar works during last 7 years ending 31st March 2022 as given below:

- IV) AVAILABILITY OF OFFICE OF SERVICE PROVIDER: An office of the Service Provider must be located in the state of Andhra Pradesh. Documentary evidence to be submitted

2. SCOPE OF THE WORK

Work is to be carried out as per Scope of work & Special Terms and Conditions (Annexure – I), GTC of GeM and as per schedule of Quantities & Rates.

3. LOCATION OF WORK

3.1 The subject work is to be carried out in the premises of BHEL, Heavy Plates & Vessels Plant (HPVP) Unit, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh.

3.2 The intending tenderers are advised to visit the above place, note down the entry procedures, safety requirements, work permit system etc. and satisfy themselves of all conditions prevailing there before submission of their tenders.

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

- I. The tenderer shall submit EMD for ₹2,19,000/- (Rupees Two Lakh Nineteen Thousand only) in the following form only:
 - a) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account (before tender opening).
- II. EMD by the tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:
 - a) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
 - b) The contractor fails to deposit the required security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract.
 - c) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- III. EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within 15 days of award of work.
- IV. EMD shall not carry any interest.
- V. EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit.

Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents is not submitted before price bid opening

5. CONTRACT PERIOD:

Contract shall be valid for a period of <u>One year</u> from the date of work order or intimation from HR-Security whichever is later.

6. SECURITY DEPOSIT/ ePBG:

Security Deposit shall be collected from the successful tenderer @3% Contract Value.

- A. Security deposit means the security provided by the contractor towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
- B. The total amount of the security deposit will be **3% of the contract value**. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security deposit.

C. Modes of Deposit:

The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of **3%** of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms:

- a) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)
- b) Local Cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.

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c) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the company's act. The bank guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.

D. Collection of Security deposit:

At least 50% of the required security deposit, should be submitted before start of the work. Balance security deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required security deposit is collected.

The successful tenderers shall furnish Security Deposit within 15 days from the date of Work Order / Letter of Intent. The Security Deposit shall be furnished by the successful tenderers before commencement of work by them.

Security deposit shall be released to the contractor upon fulfilment of contractual obligations as per the terms of the contract.

Note: In case of (a) small value contracts not exceeding ₹20 Lakh or (b) SAS jobs, work can be started before the required Security Deposit is collected. However, payment can be released only after collection/ recovery of initial 50% Security Deposit).

E. Refund of Security Deposit:

- i. The security deposit shall be refunded after successful completion of the Contract as per agreement and subject to deduction of any amount due to BHEL.
- ii. Security deposit shall not be refunded to the Contractor except in accordance with the terms of the Contract.
- iii. The security deposit shall not carry any interest.
- iv. Security Deposit / Bank Guarantee will be released after the maintenance **period of 2 months** or **on closure of contract whichever is later.**

F. Bidder agrees to submit performance security required for execution of the contract within the time period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate +6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/ contract, from the bills along with due interest.

7. INCOME TAX:

Income tax as per statutory requirement will be deducted on each payment made to the contractor and TDS certificate will be issued to this effect.

8. PAYMENTS TO SECURITY PERSONNEL:

Payments to the security personnel are to be made through bank by online transfer to their individual accounts by 10th of every month. Necessary proof is to be submitted along with monthly bill.

9. PAYMENT TERMS:

R.A. Bill shall be submitted once in a month & the payments will be arranged within 45 days from the date of bill **or** 15 days from the date of clearance of the statutory compliance by IR Department whichever is later.

Note: All payments will be released through RTGS/ NEFT only (Format enclosed in Annexure-B).

10. PRICE SCHEDULE, TAXES & DUTIES:

- a. Prices shall be quoted in the price schedule attached to the tender for the complete scope of work.
- b. The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes, duties and GST as applicable as on due date of tender submission. GST as applicable shall be payable by vendor & the same will be reimbursed as per Annexure GST.
- c. In addition to existing taxes, any new taxes imposed by Central/ State Govt. shall be payable by the contractor and same shall be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents/proof of payment, to the extent of tax benefit available to BHEL.
- d. All terms & conditions of the contract in respect of taxes & duties are subject to new taxation laws introduced time to time by Govt. and terms & conditions will deemed to be modified in accordance with the provisions of New Laws (i.e., GST).
- e. The Quoted service charge in percentage shall be fixed & firm without any escalation during the entire period of contract and till completion of the work.
- f. The Contractor shall pay the minimum wages to the contract labour as notified by the HR dept. of BHEL HPVP, Visakhapatnam from time to time Normally, Minimum Labour wages are revised twice in a year and Contractor has to pay the revised wages from the effective date. The present rate of minimum wages is enclosed at **Annexure II**
- g. In case of any changes in the minimum wages as per the Applicable Laws during the Contract period, Buyer (BHEL) shall pay the Service Provider the difference in wage from the amount mentioned in the contract on pro rata basis

11. RISK PURCHASE:

In case the contractor fails to execute the work due to any reason, BHEL reserves the right to get the same completed through some other party at the risk & cost of the contractor and any additional expenditure incurred due to the same shall be charged to the contractor.

12. Reverse Auction: Not Applicable

13. **GENERAL**:

13.1 Bidders shall confirm their acceptance to all the terms & conditions of the tender enquiry.

Deviations to the tender conditions are not acceptable and BHEL-HPVP reserves the right to reject such offers which do not meet Technical / Commercial requirements without any / further correspondence.

- 13.2 BHEL reserves the right to modify or cancel or short close the tender at any stage at its discretion without assigning any reason thereof.
- 13.3The bidders shall study the Tender documents and all other relevant documents in detail for understanding the scope of work involved in various items before submission of offers. All details related to the scope of this tender are available with HR-Security Dept. and the same can be referred during working hours from 9.00 AM to 4.00 PM.

For any clarifications required on this tender document, scope of work etc., the bidders shall depute their authorized representatives to HPVP, Visakhapatnam with prior intimation to get clarifications from concerned authorities.

13.7 Submission of offer by a tenderer implies that all the tender documents were read by the tenderer and the tenderer is aware of the scope and specifications of the work, site condition, local conditions and rates at which stores, tools and plant, free / chargeable materials etc., will be issued to him by BHEL - HPVP and other factors having bearing on the execution of the work.

14. COMPENSATION IN CASES OF DEATH / PERMENENT INCAPACITATION OF PERSON DUE TO UNINTENDED / UNFORESEEN OCCURENCES DURING MANUFACTURING / OPERATION AND WORK AT BHEL FACTORIES / OFFICES:

BHEL shall recover the amount of compensation paid to victim(s) by BHEL towards loss of life / permanent disability due to an accident which is attributable to the negligence of contractor, agency or firm or any of its employees as detailed below.

- a) Victim: Any person who suffers permanent disability or dies in an accident as defined below.
- b) Accident: Any death or permanent disability resulting solely and directly from any unintended and unforeseen injurious occurrence caused during the manufacturing / operation and works incidental thereto at BHEL factories / offices and precincts thereof, project execution, erection and commissioning, services, repairs and maintenance, trouble shooting, servicing, overhaul, renovation and retrofitting, trail operation, performance guarantee testing undertaken by company or during any works/during working at BHEL units/offices/townships and premises/project sites.
- c) Compensation in respect of each of the victims:
 - (i) In the event of death or permanent disability resulting from Loss of both limbs: ₹ 10,00,000/-(Rupees Ten Lakhs)
 - (ii) In the event of other Permanent disability: ₹ 7,00,000/- (Rupees Seven Lakhs)
- d) Permanent Displacement: A displacement that is classified as a permanent total disablement under the provision to Section 2(I) of the Employees Compensation Act, 1923.
- 15. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.

In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

SCOPE OF WORK & SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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Sub: Engaging Civil Security personnel in Factory premise of M/s. BHEL-HPVP, Visakhapatnam for a period of one year

1. Contractor should engage security Guards for performing security duties at BHEL-HPVP Unit. Security points/ places will be decided by the Company from time to time. Depending on the requirements of the Company, the security points will be altered at the discretion of the management of the Company. Contractor has to ensure all the security guards to wear masks and follow the preventive measures of Covid Guidelines issued by state/ Central

2. Security Guards:

The Contractor shall deploy 43 Security Guards every day for rendering security service at the locations as indicated by the Management on round-the clock basis on all the days during the entire contract period including Sundays, Holidays etc., The duties of security Guards at such locations should be arranged in 3 shifts, each shift consisting of 8 hours.

Requirements of Security Guards:

Security Guards should meet the following criteria:

- a) Essential educational qualification for Security Guard is minimum 10th class passed or equivalent
- b) Candidates must have minimum physical standards required for security guards
- c) Age of security guard should be less than 50 years
- **3.** All Security Guards must be in possession of **cycles**, which are to be utilized during the tenure of their duties as and when required.
- **4. Torch lights with cells** are compulsory requirements for all Security Guards. Accordingly, the Contractor must supply torch & new cells once in a month. Similarly, Face masks, Gumboots/Raincoats / winter clothing are to be catered for Monsoon / winter months for proper protection of Security Guards.
- 5. Regular checks are to be carried out by the contractor or his representative at least once in a fortnight and must be planned out in consultation with Security Department. Results of such checks to be notified to the Security Department regularly

6. Shift timings:

The Security Guards are to be deployed as per the following shift timings:

1st Shift: 0700 hrs to 1500 hrs **2nd Shift:** 1500 hrs to 2300 hrs

3rd Shift: 2300 hrs to 0700 hrs (Next day)

7. Statutory Obligations:

The contractor shall be liable for complying with all statutory obligations like ESI, PF etc., and the Company shall not be responsible to compensate or reimburse anything whatsoever except to the extent specifically agreed to by the Company in this contract.

Contractor should produce proof of payment of GST for releasing the same along with subsequent monthly bill.

8. Replacement of Guards:

The contractor should be prepared to replace the Security Guards as per the directions of the Management.

SCOPE OF WORK & SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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9. Monetary Obligations:

All obligations and monetary payments etc., arising out of various labor laws, Workmen's Compensation Act, Minimum Wages Act, Provident Fund, Bonus, ESI, payment for holidays and including as per any future legislations as may be passed by the Government of Andhra Pradesh /Central Government shall be to the account of the Contractor only.

10. Management of Contract service:

Contractor shall ensure timely reporting for duty by his security guards, in such shifts and at such security points as indicated by the Management. Security Guards who are negligent, not punctual or commits acts of misconduct, shall be replaced immediately with new security guards on receiving instructions from the Management. All the Security Guards should be supplied uniform and other material required for carrying out the security duty by the Contractor including further maintenance thereof at Contractor's cost.

11. Responsibilities:

The Contractor shall be responsible for the incidents on the part of his employees such as thefts, loss of property of the Company, sale or purchase of Company property, sleeping while on duty, failure to observe punctuality, habitual absence in their duties, non-payment of Wages, involvement of the Security Guards in any Union activities, which are detrimental to the interests of the Company and for any subversive or disorderly behavior by the Guards.

12. The Contractor shall submit his bill for the service rendered as per this contract once in a month to the Executing officer of the Company. The Contractor shall submit a copy of acquaintance roll in respect of his employees deployed in said contract work before 10th of every month. Upon certificate of the Executing officer, payment will be within 45 days from the date of bill or 15 days from the date of clearance of the statutory compliance by IR Department whichever is later.

13. P.F. & E.S.I.:

The monthly wage under this contract of the security guards includes contractor's P.F. contribution and contribution to ESI. These payments will be released to the Contractor after producing proof of payment thereof to the statutory authorities considered for the previous month along with the payment against the current month. The Contractor should give a certificate to the effect that this payment to PF & ESI authorities includes the PF & ESI payments in respect of his employees under this contract.

14. The rates agreed to in this contract shall be deemed to have been included all other expenditure whatsoever which the contractor may incur.

15. Responsibility to Pay Wages etc.:

Payment of Wages as per Annexure-II shall also be the responsibility of the Contractor and the Company shall not reimburse any other payment whatsoever other than what is specifically agreed to in this contract.

Compliance of all statutory provisions falls within the scope of contactor only. Service charge in percentage shall be fixed & firm and will not be revised under any circumstances.

16. Responsibility to pay terminal benefits, Statutory payments etc.:

All other terminal benefits, statutory payments whatsoever and payment of professional tax, if applicable; deducting the same from his employees etc., shall be to the account of the Contractor only.

SCOPE OF WORK & SPECIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS

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17. Wages for weekly Offs:

The wages agreed to in this contract shall include the wages for **weekly offs** and hence the Company shall not pay separately any payment for the weekly offs.

18. Criteria for payment of monthly bills:

The payments as per the rates agreed to in the contract will be made subject to other conditions as aforesaid based on the certification by the Executing Officer. If a Post is unguarded for any number of hours necessary deduction from the respective wage bill shall be effected for such number of hours/days. For this purpose, **the daily wage will be divided by 8.** To put it more clearly, if all the security points as per the contract are guarded in a month as per the terms and conditions without any lapses/unguarded, the payment against a monthly bill shall be as per **Monthly rate of Security Guard x 43 Nos.**

19. <u>Penalty:</u> In the event of any of the posts remain unguarded for any period, for the first lapse the Contractor shall be noticed in writing to that effect. In case of repetition of the same in any of the posts, a Penalty of Rs.100/- per day's lapse shall be imposed by the Company and the same shall be deducted from the next wage bill.

20. Final Wage Bill:

The Final wage bill shall be cleared upon certification of Executing Officer after due approval of Management.

21. Termination of Contract:

This contract can be terminated upon giving **three months**' notice on either side.

- 1. In Response to Tenders for Indigenous supplier will be entertained only if the vendor has a valid GSTIN which should be clearly mentioned in the offer. If any specific exemption is available, a declaration with due supporting documents need to be furnished for considering the offer.
- 2. Supplier shall mention their GSTIN in all their invoices and invoices shall be in the format as specified/prescribed under GST laws. Invoices shall necessarily contain Invoice number (in case of multiple numbering system is being followed for billing like SAP invoice no, commercial invoice no etc., then the Invoice No which is linked/uploaded in GSTN network shall be clearly indicated), item description as per P0, Quantity, Rate, Value, applicable taxes with nomenclature (like IGST, SGST, CGST & UTGST) separately, HSN/ SAC Code, etc.

Alternatively, BG of appropriate value may be obtained from vendor which shall be valid At least one month after the confirmation of date of payment of GST by vendor on GSTN portal and receipt of Tax invoice and receipt of goods, whichever is later. Above is subject to receipt of goods/service and tax invoice thereof along with vendor declaring invoice in his return and paying GST within timeline prescribed for availing ITC by BHEL.
- 10. That in case vendor delays Declaring such invoice in his return and GST credit availed by BHEL is denied or reversed subsequently as per GST law, GST amount paid by BHEL towards such ITC reversal as per GST law shall be recoverable from vendor/contractor along with interest levied/ leviable on BHEL.
