1. ELIGIBILITY CRITERIA

 i) Average annual turnover of the contractor duly certified by a practitioner-chartered accountant during the last 3 years ending 31st March 2022 should be at least ₹2.10 Lakh.

Tenderer should enclose EPF, ESI, PAN, GSTIN New registration no., Income tax returns for last three years (AY- 2020-21, 2021-22 & 2022-23) and Profit & Loss account and Balance Sheet certified by the Practicing Chartered Accountant for the last 3 years.

- ii) The Contractor should have experience of completing similar works like chemical (or) mechanical (or) metallurgical tests during last 7 years ending 30th April 2023 as given below:
 - (a) Three completed works costing not less than the amount of ₹2.80 Lakh each.

Work orders & Job Completion Certificates with WO reference and completed value from the customer shall be enclosed in support of successful and satisfactory completion of the orders.

iii) Vendor must have experience to carry out macro, micro & chemical analysis by wet method of samples in operating industry on regular contract basis for State Govt. / Central Govt./Govt. Undertaking/ private sector.

Supporting documents: Job completion certificates signed by the customer consisting of macro, micro & chemical analysis by wet method (or)Test reports covering macro, micro & chemical analysis by wet method signed by customer/TPIA agency.

The above documents should have work order reference & the relevant work order shall be enclosed.

- iv) Vendor's Lab must have own facilities to carry out macro, micro & chemical analysis by wet method as on date of submission of the tender. Outsourcing of any activities related to this tender is not allowed. (Confirmation to be given by vendor on letter head).
- v) The works executed in the own name of the vendor will only be considered for eligibility criteria. (Test reports should have vendor name)
- vi) The Lab should be NABL accredited. (NABL certificate to be enclosed).

2. SCOPE OF THE WORK:

The work shall be carried out as per scope of work (Annexure-I) and Schedule of Quantities & Rates.

3. LOCATION OF WORK:

- 3.1 The subject job is to be carried out inside factory premises of BHEL-HPVP, Visakhapatnam, Andhra Pradesh State.
- 3.2 The intending tenderers are advised to visit the work place, note down the entry procedures, safety requirements, work permit system etc. and satisfy themselves of all conditions prevailing there before submission of their tenders. Tenderers are requested go through all term & conditions, nature and quantum of the job to be done and in general shall themselves obtain all necessary information as to risks, safety precautions, contingencies and other circumstances. A tenderer shall be deemed to have full knowledge of the site, whether he inspects it or not, no claim shall be allowed.

4. EARNEST MONEY DEPOSIT:

I. The tenderer shall submit EMD for ₹14,000/- (Rupees Fourteen Thousand only) in the following forms only:

a) Electronic Fund Transfer credited in BHEL account before tender opening (SBI Mandate form attached).

- II. EMD by the tenderer will be forfeited as per NIT conditions, if:
 - a) After opening the tender and within the offer validity period, the tenderer revokes his tender or makes any modification in his tender which is not acceptable to BHEL.
 - b) The contractor fails to deposit the required security deposit or commence the work within the period as per LOI/ Contract.
 - c) EMD by the tenderer shall be withheld in case any action on the tenderer is envisaged under the provisions of extant "Guidelines on Suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors" and forfeited/ released based on the action as determined under these guidelines.
- III. EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within 15 days of award of work.
- IV. EMD shall not carry any interest.
- V. EMD of successful tenderer will be retained as part of Security Deposit.

Note: Micro & Small Enterprises (MSEs) are eligible for exemption of EMD as given below: MSE suppliers can avail the intended benefits only if they submit valid UDYAM Registration Certificate for Micro / Small category for the above subject service along with the offer. Non-submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bid at par with other bidders. No benefits shall be applicable for this enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents is not submitted before price bid opening.

5. CONTRACT PERIOD:

Contract shall be valid for a period of **One Year** from the date of issue of work order or till completion of the contract, whichever is earlier.

6. SECURITY DEPOSIT:

- A. Security deposit means the security provided by the contractor towards fulfilment of any obligations in terms of the provisions of the contract.
- B. The total amount of the security deposit will be **3% of the contract value**. EMD of the successful tenderer shall be converted and adjusted towards the required amount of Security deposit.

C. Modes of Deposit:

The balance amount to make up the required Security Deposit of **3%** of the contract value may be accepted in the following forms:

i) Cash (as permissible under the extant Income Tax Act)

ii) Local Cheques of Scheduled Banks (subject to realization)/ Pay Order/ Demand Draft/ Electronic Fund Transfer in favour of BHEL.

- iii) Bank Guarantee from Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the company's act. The bank guarantee format should have the approval of BHEL.
- iv) Fixed Deposit Receipt issued by Scheduled Banks/ Public Financial Institutions as defined in the company's act (FDR should be in the name of the contractor, a/c BHEL.
- v) Securities available from Indian Post offices such as National Savings Certificates, Kisan Vikas Patras etc. (held in the name of Contractor furnishing the security and duly endorsed/ hypothecated/ pledged, as applicable, in favour of BHEL)

(Note: BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith)

D. Collection of Security deposit:

At least 50% of the required security deposit, should be submitted before start of the work. Balance security deposit can be collected by deducting 10% of the gross amount progressively from each of the running bills of the contractor till the total amount of the required security deposit is collected. Security deposit shall be released to the contractor upon fulfilment of contractual obligations as per the terms of the contract.

E. Refund of Security Deposit:

- i) The security deposit shall be refunded after successful completion of the Contract as per agreement and subject to deduction of any amount due to BHEL.
- ii) Security deposit shall not be refunded to the Contractor except in accordance with the terms of the Contract.
- **F.** The successful tenderers shall furnish Security Deposit within 15 days from the date of Work Order / Letter of Intent. The Security Deposit shall be furnished by the successful tenderers before commencement of work by them.
- **G.** The security deposit shall not carry any interest.

Note: Acceptance of Security Deposit against SI. No. C(iv) and (v) above will be subject to hypothecation or endorsement on the documents in favour of BHEL. However, BHEL will not be liable or responsible in any manner for the collection of interest or renewal of the documents or in any other matter connected therewith.

- **H.** Security Deposit / Bank Guarantee will be released after the maintenance period of 2 months or on closure of contract whichever is later.
- I. Bidder shall agree to submit performance security required for execution of the contract within the time period mentioned. In case of delay in submission of performance security, enhanced performance security which would include interest (SBI rate +6%) for the delayed period, shall be submitted by the bidder. Further if performance security is not submitted till such time the first bill becomes due, the amount of performance security due shall be recovered as per terms defined in NIT/ contract, from the bills along with due interest.

7. Delivery Period for Submission of Test Reports:

a) Delivery of test reports within one week from receiving of samples/ confirmation from BHEL to carry out the test for Tensile test at ambient temperature, Tensile test at elevated temperature & Impact test at minus temperature.

8. INCOME TAX:

Income tax as per statutory requirement will be deducted on each payment made to the Transport contractor and TDS certificate will be issued to this effect.

9. TDS ON GST:

TDS on GST amount as per statutory requirement as applicable will be deducted on each payment made to the contractor. Present TDS on GST is 2%.

10. INSPECTION:

Third Party Inspection for these tests will be taken care by BHEL as applicable. Vendor has to intimate the readiness of samples / tests with minimum 3 days' advance intimation excluding the date of intimation & proposed date of inspection.

11. PAYMENT TERMS:

100% Payment will be released within 45 days for MSE/ 60 days for Medium / 90 days for Large enterprises from the date of submission of bills enclosing copies of supporting documents as below:

- a. RA bills may be submitted for the completed portion of works, certified by Engineer-in-charge.
- b. Invoice (Original copy- 3 no.)
- c. Original test reports
- d. Proof of GST payment as per Annexure GST.
- e. RTGS form

Note: All payment will be released through RTGS / NEFT only.

12. PRICE SCHEDULE, TAXES & DUTIES:

- a. Prices shall be quoted in the price schedule attached to tender for the complete scope of work.
- b. The quoted prices shall be inclusive of all applicable taxes & duties including GST as applicable as on due date of tender submission. GST as applicable shall be payable by vendor & the same will be reimbursed as per Annexure GST.
- c. In addition to existing taxes, any new taxes imposed by Central/ State Govt. shall be payable by the contractor and same shall be reimbursed on submission of relevant documents/proof of payment.
- d. In case, any new tax is imposed instead of existing tax, difference of the amount shall be reimbursed/ recovered on submission of documentary evidence.
- e. Any new tax is imposed by Central/ State Govt. or there is any variation in taxes after expiry of delivery / contract period, the same shall be borne by contractor only.

16. TENDER SUBMISSION:

18. RISK PURCHASE:

In case the contractor fails to execute the work due to any reason, BHEL reserves the right to get the same completed through some other party at the risk & cost of the contractor and any additional expenditure incurred due to the same and overhead charges shall be charged to the contractor. Risk & Cost will be implemented as per BHEL STANDARD OPERATING PROCEDURE FOR IMPLEMENTATION OF RISK & COST of BHEL.

19. SUB-LETTING:

In general, sub-letting of jobs will not be permitted. But in special circumstances, this may be allowed. In such case, the party should obtain written approval from BHEL-HPVP, Visakhapatnam before subletting.

20. LIQUIDATED DAMAGES:

If the Seller/Service Provider fails to deliver the Services within the original/re-fixed delivery period(s) specified in the contract, the Buyer will be entitled to deduct/recover the Liquidated Damages for the delay, unless covered under Force Majeure conditions aforesaid, @ 0.5% of the contract value of delayed quantity per week or part of the week of delayed period as pre-estimated damages not exceeding 10% of the contract value of delayed quantity without any controversy/dispute of any sort whatsoever.

21. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.



GST COMPLIANCE FOR INDIGENOUS SUPPLIERS / CONTRACTORS

- 1. In Response to Tenders for Indigenous supplier will be entertained only if the vendor has a valid GSTIN which should be clearly mentioned in the offer. If any specific exemption is available, a declaration with due supporting documents need to be furnished for considering the offer.
- 2. Supplier shall mention their GSTIN in all their invoices and invoices shall be in the format as specified/prescribed under GST laws. Invoices shall necessarily contain Invoice number (in case of multiple numbering system is being followed for billing like SAP invoice no, commercial invoice no etc., then the Invoice No which is linked/uploaded in GSTN network shall be clearly indicated), item description as per P0, Quantity, Rate, Value, applicable taxes with nomenclature (like IGST, SGST, CGST & UTGST) separately, HSN/ SAC Code, etc.
- 3. All invoices shall bear the HSN Code for each item separately (Harmonized System of Nomenclature)/ SAC code (Services Accounting Code).
- 4. - 6. In case of discrepancy in the data uploaded by supplier in the GSTN portal or in case of any shortages or rejection in the supply, then BHEL will not be able to avail the tax credit and will notify the supplier of the same. Supplier has to rectify the data discrepancy in the GSTN portal or issue credit note (details to be uploaded in GSTN portal) for the shortages or rejections in the suppliers, within the calendar month notified by BHEL.
- 7. For any such delay in availing of tax credit for reasons attributable to supplier (as mentioned above), interest (calculated @ SBI Base Rate + 6%) along with penalty if any will be deducted for the delayed period i.e. from the month of receipt till the month tax credit is availed, from the running bills.
- 8. Under GST regime, BHEL has to discharge GST liability on LD recovered from suppliers/contractors. Hence applicable GST shall also be recoverable from suppliers/contractors on LD amount. For this Debit note will be issued by BHEL indicating the respective supply invoice number.
- 9. This is to inform that GST portion of invoice, shall be released only upon Vendor declaring such invoice in his GSTR-1 and receipt of goods and Tax invoice by BHEL and Confirmation of payment of GST thereon by vendor on GSTN portal. Alternatively, BG of appropriate value may be obtained from vendor which shall be valid At least one month after the confirmation of date of payment of GST by vendor on GSTN portal and receipt of Tax invoice and receipt of goods, whichever is later.
