As per Amendment-02 we have issued Revised as Price Bid-Part-II-Vol-III (REV-01). In this revised price bid –Rev-01 we are now including **additional item no 2.1(e)**. Hence we are now issuing **Revised Price Bid-Part-II-Vol-III(REV-02) which include item no 2(e) and also takes care of Amendment-01.**

Bidders are requested to quote the rates only in Price Bid-Part-II-Vol-III(REV-02) which is issued with this amendment-03 . Revised price bid- REV-02 and amendment-03 are hosted in the web.

Further following clarification are furnished below shall be a part of tender specification:

- 1) As per items covered under 3.0, 7.0 & 8.0 of rate schedule (Price Bid) , as per item description the cement to be used shall be OPC/PSC/PPC/SRC . Now it is clarified that for these items SRC is not required, as such bidder to quote the rate for OPC/PSC/PPC for the items covered under item no 3.0, 7.0 & 8.0 of price bid. This has been incorporated in Revised price bid- REV-02
- 2) Refer item no 19.1 & 19.2 of rate schedule for chain link mesh/ barbed wire fencing is to be tied to RCC/ Steel Post.
Some bidders said that there is no separate item for RCC/Steel Posts

It is clarified that Steel Posts will be paid under item no 6.1(d) & RCC Posts will be paid under item no 3.2 (b)

Bidders may please download these documents from web and enclose copy of same (un-priced) with technical bid duly signed by your authorized signatory and stamped with official seal as a token of your unqualified acceptance of this amendment.

In view of above changes, Due date of offer submission is rescheduled to 19/02/2007-18.00Hrs. Bidders are now requested to submit their offer on or before 19/02/2007.

All other terms & condition of the tender specification shall remain unchanged unless and otherwise expressly amended by BHEL.
