COMMERCIAL TERMS AND CONDITIONS FOR SUBMISSION OF OFFER

1.0 QUOTATIONS

Bidders shall submit the offer in **TWO INNER ENVELOPES** as indicated below which shall be sealed in one outer envelope alongwith Earnest Money Deposit (EMD) of Rs. 25,000/- (Rupees Twenty Five thousand only).

Envelope I This sealed envelope should contain all the copies of technical bid together with **un-priced** commercial bid. This envelope should be clearly marked **"Part I - Technical and commercial bid"**, indicating Enquiry No., Due Date and Address & Reference of the Bidder.

Envelope II This sealed envelope should contain <u>price details</u>. This envelope should be clearly marked <u>"Part II - Price bid"</u>, indicating Enquiry No., Due Date and Address & Reference of the Bidder.

Both the envelopes (Part I & II) shall be put in one outer cover, duly sealed, superscribing as Part I and Part II of Enquiry No., due date of opening and the address and reference of the Bidder.

The above offer should reach this office on or before **02.03.07 by 1430 Hrs** (IST). Late offers will not be considered.

Tenders should be free from **CORRECTION AND ERASURES**, Corrections if any, must be attested. All amounts shall be indicated both in words as well as in figures. Where there is difference between amount quoted in words and figures, amount quoted in words shall prevail.

Offers should be in **ENGLISH** and accompanied by detailed technical literature, catalogue and detailed dimensional drawings in **ENGLISH** only.



1.1 EARNEST MONEY: The tenderer shall be required to deposit earnest money of Rs. 10,000/- (Rupees Ten thousand only) through Demand Draft/Pay Order only payable at Goindwal Sahib/Amritsar.

As envelope containing EMD shall be attached clearly marked "EMD" and reference to Enquiry no. Part I bids of those tenderers only shall be considered who have attached EMD envelop.

Bidders from PSUs of Central Government/State Governments shall be exempted from submitting EMD provided that a certificate of ownership issued by concerned government department is submitted in the envelop of EMD.

EMD given by all unsuccessful tenderers shall be refunded normally within 30 days of PO/Contract to successful tenderer.

EMD shall not carry any interest.

EMD shall be forfeited in case of:

- a) Withdrawl/modification of an offer within the validity period.
- b) Successful tenderer does not owner PO/Contract. An acknowledgment of PO agreeing to all terms and conditions shall be sent immediately on receiving PO within the term specified in PO.

2.0 PART I (TECHNICAL & COMMERCIAL BID)

2.1 Technical

This part shall include / indicate the following:

- 2.1.1. Offer should contain complete scope of supply with all technical details, specifications, delivery and other commercial terms and conditions.
- 2.1.2. Point by point confirmation for the Technical Specification enclosed is to be provided. if there are any deviations, the same should be clearly specified. Offers received without confirmation to our specification will be rejected.
- 2.1.3. List of customers to whom same or similar equipment have been supplied along with performance certificates to be enclosed.
- 2.1.4. Relevant catalogues to be attached
- 2.1.5. List of spares parts (with part numbers) for two years operation and maintenance should be attached.
- 2.1.6. Information on shipping weight and cubage (length, width & height) to be provided.
- 2.1.7. In case of foreign bidder offer, the Principal's technical offer only should be enclosed.



2.2 Commercial

This part shall include / indicate the following:

- 2.2.1. Port of shipment / Station of despatch
- 2.2.2. Terms of payment
- 2.2.3. Taxes & duties applicable.
- 2.2.4. Delivery Schedule
- 2.2.5. Offer validity
- 2.2.6. Country of origin
- 2.2.7. Percentage of agency commission if any along with a copy of Agency agreement.
- 2.2.8. A copy of "Un-Priced Part II" i.e., a copy of the Price Bid without the price details to be enclosed.

3.0 PART II (PRICE- BID)

This part should contain the schedule of price particulars and to be co-related to the technical details provided in Part I.

4.0 OPENING OF TENDERS

The Part I - Technical & commercial bid alone would be opened on the Tender opening date.

The Part II - Clarifications if any required by BHEL for Technical evaluation would be sought from Bidders before opening of Part II - price bid. Price bid of technically suitable Bidders alone would be opened. The Technically suitable Bidders would be informed about the tender opening date.

5.0 GENERAL

- 5.1. Incomplete offers will not be considered.
- 5.2. Fixed price: Prices quoted by the bidder shall be firm and not subject to any escalation whatsoever during the period of bid validity and execution of the Purchase Order. A bid submitted with an adjustable price will be treated as non-responsive and rejected. Prices shall be written in words and figures. In the event of difference, the price in words shall be valid and binding. Unit prices shall be considered correct in the event of any discrepancy with regard to total price.
- 5.3. Bid currency: Indian bidders should submit the prices only in Indian Rupees. Foreign bidders may submit their bid in their home currency.
- 5.4. Terms of Delivery: Bidders are required to quote their best delivery period which should not exceed beyond 60 days from date of release of Purchase Order. Foreign Bidders should submit their offer for net FOB / FCA Nearest Sea Port / Air Port. Indian Bidders should submit their offer for FOR Despatching station. Delivery shall be counted from the date of Letter of Intent.
- 5.5. Taxes and Duties: All Taxes and Duties payable as extra to the quoted price should be specifically stated in offers along with Sales Tax Registration No / Tariff



No. etc., failing which the purchaser will not be liable for payment of such Taxes and Duties. Our TIN No. is 03021035905.

- 5.6. Validity: The offers for main equipment and spares shall be kept open for acceptance for 120 days (one hundred and twenty days) from the date of opening of the tender (Part I).
- 5.7. Terms of Payment:
- 5.7.1. Indian Bidders
 - 5.7.1.1. The preferred payment terms are indicated below:
 - 5.7.1.2. 100% payment, within 45 to 90 days, after receipt / acceptance / commissioning of equipment at BHEL, Goindwal against submission of 10% Performance Bank Guarantee on total order value.

Or

5.7.1.3. 80% payment against documents through bank within 45 to 90 days, (after pre-despatch inspection) and balance 20% payment after receipt / acceptance / commissioning of the equipment within 45 to 90 days, against submission of 10% Performance Bank Guarantee on total order value.

5.7.2. Foreign Bidders

An Irrevocable Letter of Credit shall be established for 80% net FOB (excluding Indian Agent's commission) 2 months prior to shipment and valid for 3 months for negotiation against shipment. Letter of Credit shall be opened through a branch of State Bank of India in the country where order shall be placed. In case, in the country where order is placed, State Bank of India is not there, Letter of Credit will be opened through our bankers or as permitted by Government of India. Letter of Credit will not be confirmed by foreign banker. Balance 20% of net FOB value shall be paid through sight draft on receipt / acceptance / commissioning of the goods at BHEL against submission of Performance Bank Guarantee for 10% on total order value, which has to be valid for the guarantee period. All bank charges outside India are to supplier's account. Lump sum erection and commissioning charges, if any, shall be payable after satisfactory erection and commissioning of the equipment by sight draft against certificate issued by the competent authority.

5.7.3 Common to both Indian & Foreign Bidders

E&C charges will be released after deduction of Income Tax as per the Govt. of India rules. The TDS certificate will be issued by BHEL. Applicable service tax on E&C charges will be payable extra. The liability of depositing the same to the Govt. will be of the supplier.



- 5.8. The rating of the company quoting for this tender from a third party) independent agency) preferably by M/s DUNS & Bradstreet (DUN NUMBER) may be mentioned in your offer. This however is not mandatory.
- 5.9. Contract Execution Bank Guarantee (CEBG): The successful tenderer shall furnish a Bank Guarantee for **5%** of the Purchase Order value confirming that the order will be executed as per the terms and conditions and this should be valid till the acceptance of the machine / equipment at BHEL, Goindwal (i.e., after erection and commissioning is completed). In case of foreign supplier, LC will be established only after receipt of CPBG.
- 5.10. Performance Bank Guarantee (PBG): The supplier shall furnish a Bank Guarantee from an Indian Bank approved by BHEL, at no extra cost in a proforma prescribed by BHEL (which shall be sent along with the order), for an amount equivalent to 10% (Ten percent) of the value of the contract. The PBG shall be valid for period of 12 months from the date of acceptance of the equipment at BHEL, Goindwal, with additional claim period of 2 months.

The Performance Bank Guarantee shall be obtained from any one of the following banks that is a member bank in our consortium of banks preferably Punjab National Bank.

- 1) State Bank of India, 2) Punjab National Bank, 3) Standard Chartered Bank
- 5.11. Liquidated damages: It is clearly understood among the parties to the contract the "Time is the essence of the contract". Therefore, the delivery of the goods specified in the purchase order should be made within the time prescribed. Failure to dispatch the materials in the time as per the delivery quoted in our Purchase Order would make the supplier liable to an unconditional penalty at the rate of 1/2% of the value of goods for each week of delay subject to a maximum of 15% of the order value.
- 5.12. Risk purchase: Alternatively the purchaser at his option will be entitled to terminate the contract and to purchase elsewhere at the risk and cost of the seller either the whole of the goods or any part which the supplier has failed to deliver or despatch within the time stipulated as aforesaid or if the same were not available, the best and the nearest available substitute therefore. The supplier shall be liable for any loss, which the Purchaser may sustain by reason of such risk purchases.
- 5.13. Indian Agent & Agency commission: An Indian Agent can represent only one Foreign Manufacturer against a particular Enquiry. Agency commission if any, payable to their Indian Agents, shall be shown separately in the Offer. This will be paid by us in Indian Rupees, on satisfactory completion of the Contract. Copies of current Agency Agreement / Authorization Letter in respect of Agency Commission shall be furnished along with offer. For calculation of Rupee



equivalent of Agency Commission, exchange rate as prevailing on the date of Purchase Order will be taken.

- 5.14. Short shipment / Warranty replacement: In case of any short shipment in the main equipment / spares, customs duty levied on such supplies, shall be borne by the supplier. Any warranty replacement during the warrantee period shall be on FOR., BHEL, Goindwal, basis.
- 5.15. Inspection & Testing: All goods shall be subject to inspection by BHEL or its authorized representatives at supplier's works or at BHEL stores or at any other place in India indicated by BHEL as the case may be. The supplier will not charge for the facilities provided for inspection of goods. Final inspection and acceptance of the machine will be carried after installation of the machine at BHEL, Goindwal.
- 5.16. Test certificates / Operating and Maintenance manuals: The Bidders shall clearly mention in their offer, that Test Certificates and Operating Maintenance Manuals, etc., as called for in the Technical Specification, in the required number of copies will be provided at no extra cost.
- 5.17. Modvat credit: (for Indian Bidders only) The quotation must indicate Tariff item number and rate of Excise Duty applicable. The original Excise Duty Gate Pass will be required to be furnished in case charged to us. If the tenderer is availing MODVAT credit for his input materials, the effect of proforma credit should be passed on to the purchaser.
- 5.18. Packing: The Supplier shall arrange for packing suitably in all respects considering the peculiarity of the material involved for normal transport by sea / rail / road and suitably protected against effect of tropical salt laden atmosphere in the event of shipment being delayed at ports.
- 5.19. Salient points of HSE (Health Safety & Environment) that are to be considered while submission of offer are:
- 5.19.1 Consumption benchmarks related to output shall be provided wherever applicable for key input resources (energy/fuel/chemicals)
- 5.19.2 Competency requirements for operation, maintenance and calibration, if any, shall be communicated
- 5.19.3 If any hazardous chemicals as per MSIHC (Manufacturing, Storage and import of Hazardous Chemicals) Rules 1989/94/2000 are used, the MSDS shall be provided, along with On site & Off site emergency plan (as applicable)
- 5.19.4 The noise level at operator level shall be with in 90 dBA
- 5.19.5 OH&S (Occupational Health and Safety) control measures for safe working of machine as applicable shall be specified.



- 5.19.6 The machine / equipment shall be fitted with guard for rolling and moving parts and shall comply with applicable OH&S legislations and Factories Act 1948
- 5.19.7 The supplier shall submit the layout drawing of operating controls, displays etc. and operating instructions to enable ergonomics evaluation and approval
- 5.19.8 The recommended PPE (Personal Protective Equipment) for the equipment shall be furnished
- 5.19.9 Alarm system (both visual and audible) and Automatic switch off of the equipment shall be provided for any intrusion, overloading, short circuiting or any malfunctioning of the equipment
- 5.19.10 Details of all hazardous / harmful substances discharged as by-products / wastes during operations of the machine / equipment, such as fumes, gases, dust particles, aerosols UV./IR (Ultra violet / infra red) radiations, etc. shall be furnished, along with their concentrations and their TLV, (Threshold Limit Value).
- 5.19.11 Appropriate pollution control measures shall be proposed to keep the emissions from the machinery / processes within the prescribed limit as stated in Environment Protection Rules 1986.
- 5.19.12 Wherever industry specific standards are not available for control of pollutants, general emission standards shall be used
- 5.19.13 Chemicals banned due to their negative impact on the environment shall not be used in the process
- 5.19.14 Fuels, consumables with sulphur content less than 0.05% shall be proposed
- 5.19.15 Details regarding nature of waste generated and appropriate disposal practices available shall be provided, along with the operation procedure of the plant / process.
- 5.19.16 Hazardous chemicals and flammable substances shall be transported only through authorized transporters and all safety practices as laid down in applicable legislative requirements such as Central Motor Vehicle Rules, Manufacture, Storage and Import of Hazardous Chemical 1989, etc. shall be followed
- 5.19.17 Primary materials used in the equipment shall be specified and they shall be eco friendly

5.20. Evaluation of offers shall be on the basis of delivered cost.

- 5.21. BHEL also reserve its right to allow to the Public Sector Enterprises ordering and price preference facilities as admissible under the existing policy.
- 5.22. BHEL reserves its right to reject any tender due to unsatisfactory past performance in the execution of a contract at another project / unit.



- 5.23 BHEL reserves its right to extend the due date for opening of the tender without assigning any reasons thereof.
- 5.24. BHEL shall be at liberty to reject or accept any tender, part or in full, at their own discretion and any such action is not liable for any question or claim against BHEL.
- 5.25 Force Majeure: If at any time during the execution of the order, the performance in which or in any part by either party of any obligations under the contract are prevented or delayed by reason of any war, hostilities, acts of public enemy, civil commotion, sabotage, fires, explosions, epidemics, quarantine restrictions, or acts of God (hereinafter referred to "an events" then provided the notice of happening of any such event is given by either party to the other within 21 days of the occurrence thereof, neither party shall by reason of such event be entitled to terminate the contract nor shall either party have any claim for damages against the other in respect of such non-performance and delay in performance and delivery under the contract shall be resumed as soon as practicable after such event has come to an end or ceased to exist. If the performance in whole or part of any obligation under the contract is prevented or delayed by reason of any such event, claims of extension of time shall be granted for periods considered reasonable by BHEL subject to prior notification by the vendor to BHEL of the particulars of the event and supply to BHEL, if required, of any supporting evidence. Any waiver of time in respect of partial installment shall not be deemed a waiver of time in respect of remaining deliveries.
- 5.26 Disputes: In the event of any dispute and/or difference arising between the Vendor and BHEL as to interpretation and/or execution of the contract and/or the respective rights and liabilities of the parties, such disputes and/or differences shall be referred to the sole arbitrator nominated by BHEL. The provisions of the Indian Arbitration Act and the rules thereunder shall apply to such arbitration. The award passed by the arbitrator shall be final and conclusively binding on all the parties.
- 5.27 Jurisdiction: The court of the place from where the purchase order is issued or is under execution during the contractual period shall alone have jurisdiction to decide any dispute arising out of or in connection with the purchase order.

Confirmation to provide Contract Execution Bank Guarantee (CEBG) for 5%, valid till the acceptance of the machine / equipment at BHEL, Goindwal (i.e., after erection and commissioning is completed), of the Purchase Order value confirming that the order will be executed as per the terms and conditions.

Confirmation that the equipment shall be guaranteed for a period of 24 months from the date of acceptance.

Confirmation that the vendor shall provide necessary drawings, Test Certificates and Operating Maintenance Manuals etc., as called for in the Technical Specification, in the required number of copies at no extra cost.

We (indicate the name of the Bank) (herein after referred to as the Bank) at the request of (contractor(s)) do hereby undertake to pay the Company an amount not exceeding Rs against any loss or damage caused to or suffered or would be caused to or suffered by the Company by reason of any breach by the said contractor (s) of any of the terms and conditions contained in the said agreement.
- 3. We undertake to pay unconditionally to the Company any money so demanded notwithstanding any dispute(s) raised by the Contractor in any suit, or proceedings pending before any Court or Tribunal or Arbitration or before any other authority relating thereto our liability under this present being absolute and unequivocal. The payment under this guarantee would not wait till the disputes have been decided by any Court or Tribunal or in the arbitration proceedings or by any other authority. The payment so made by us under this Bond shall be a valid discharge of liability for payment there under and the Contractor (s) shall have no claim against us for making such payment.



- 5. (i) Unless a demand or claim under this agreement is made on us in writing on or before the we shall be discharged from all the liability under this guarantee thereafter. But where such claim or demand has been preferred by the Company with the Bank before the expiry of the said date, the claim shall be enforceable notwithstanding the fact that the said enforcement is effected after the said date.
 - (ii) For the purpose of this clause, any letter making demand on the Bank by M/s BHEL will be dispatched by Registered Post with Ack. Due or by Telegram or by any Electronic media addressed to the above mentioned address of the Bank shall be deemed to be the claim/demand in writing referred to above irrespective of the fact as to whether and when the said letter reaches the Bank, as also any letter containing the said demand or claim is lodged with the Bank personally.
- 6. We (indicate the name of the Bank), further agree with the Company that the Company shall have the fullest liberty without our consent and without affecting in any manner our obligations hereunder to vary any of the terms and conditions of the said agreement or to extend time of performance by the said Contractor(s) from time to time or to postpone for any time of from time to time any of the powers exercisable by the Company against the said Contractor (s) and to forbear or enforce any of the terms and conditions relating to the said Agreement and we shall not be relieved from our liability by any reason of any such forbearance, act or omission on the part of the Company or any indulgence by the Company to the said Contractor(s) or by any such matter or thing whatsoever which under the law relating would, but for this provision, have effect of not so relieving us.
- 7. This guarantee will not be discharged due to the change in the constitution of the Bank or the Contractor(s)
- 8. It shall not be necessary for the Company to proceed against the contractor before proceeding against the guarantor-Bank and the



guarantee herein contained shall be enforceable against them notwithstanding any security, which the Company may have obtained or obtain from the Contractor shall, at the time when proceedings are taken against the guarantor hereunder be outstanding or unrealised.

- 9. Any claim or dispute arising under the terms of this document shall only be enforced or settled in the Courts at Tarn Taran/Amritsar.
- 10. The guarantor hereby declare that it has power to execute this guarantee and the executant has full powers to do so on its behalf under the proper authority granted to him/them by the guarantor.
- 11. We (indicate the name of Bank) lastly undertake not to revoke this guarantee during its currency except with the previous consent of the Company in writing.
