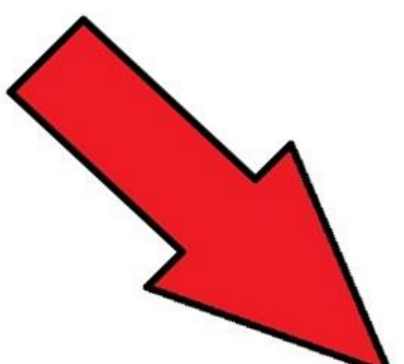

India have begun the One-Day series with a good win over the West Indies. It was a victory where the team won despite playing at perhaps 60% of their skill level and the only concern would be that the concentration was not quite there. The other noticeable aspect was that the batsmen were still in the T20 mode and so were playing too many shots too soon.

Getting the front foot out of the way and freeing the arms for a swing at the ball was clearly seen at the start of each batsman's knock



and it was only after spending some time at the crease that they got their front foot closer to the ball and did not leave a gap from where the ball could sneak through. The Man of the Match Rohit Sharma was the prime exam-

ple of this and for the first 20 runs he looked very vulnerable and the concentration didn't seem to be there. What was impressive was the way he fought back and got his focus and ended up taking India home.

Shikhar Dhawan batted well too, but he threw his wicket away after getting his half-century when there was no urgency and thus missed out on a chance to get a One-Day hundred. He also looks like a player who needs to understand that it is not just his wicket that needs to be preserved but also that of his partner. He tends to take off for a run when he hits the ball but appears not that concerned if his partner is running to the danger end. **PMG**

The four days I spent in Bangalore as the event ambassador for the TCS World 10K Bangalore was an enriching experience and I'll go back with memories to cherish for the rest of my life. I was pleasantly surprised by the welcome accorded to me by the media on my arrival, which also made me aware of the impact of winning the Olympic gold on my athletic personality.

I was also humbled by the infectious enthusiasm displayed by the athletes, young and old, who I met at the Kanterava Stadium and was taken aback by the amount of knowledge they had about my running career. I have only encountered such a response in Japan. Though I had visited India before in 2004, it was as a participant in a professional race and I never imagined distance running could be such a rage in this country, which has yet to produce an Olympic or world champion in the discipline. However, I have learnt that there has been a huge improvement in the performances of athletes like Preeja Sreedharan and Kavita Raut and it won't be long before a world beater emerges from India.

The improvement in performances, to a large extent, is due to the exposure and experience the athletes are gaining from competing against the world's best in their own backyard.
