- 1. **The First envelope** shall contain Part-I (Technical bid documents shall be signed on all the pages and affix vendor's seal) and shall be sealed and super scribed as Part-I (Technical Bid for NIT/Enquiry No. and name of the supply).
- 2. The second envelope shall contain only Part-II (Price bid) for the above supply and to be quoted as per the format given in price bid. Any other information in price bid will not be considered. The envelope shall be sealed and super scribed as Price Bid for NIT / Enquiry No and name of supply. Price bid should not be clubbed together with Technical bid.

All the above Two envelopes shall be kept into one cover, sealed and super scribed as Tender Document for the work as per NIT (NIT/Enquiry No. and name of the work).

The Tender (envelope containing Part I & II) should reach The Tender Opening Cell / MM on or before the due date and time. These documents should be sent either by Registered post / Speed Post / courier / in person. Tenders received after due date and time will not be considered for evaluation.

- 3. Any deviation to this tender terms & conditions and schedules of this tender will lead to total rejection of the offer submitted.
- 4. Contract will be awarded for a period of **one year** from the date of award of contract and supply rate shall remain firm for the entire period of the contract.
- 5. Price bid shall be valid up to Three months from date of Tender opening.
- 6. Rates should be quoted as per Price Bid Format only and the Rate quoted is inclusive of GST, other Taxes if any, Transportation, Loading, Unloading, etc. No additional claim will be allowed. Rates quoted in any other form will not be accepted and will be rejected.
- 7. Any change in applicable rates of Tax or any other statutory levies (Direct / Indirect) or any new introduction of any levy by means of statute and its corresponding liability for the deliveries beyond the agreed delivery date for reasons not attributable to BHEL will be to vendors account. BHEL will not reimburse the same and any subsequent claim in this respect will be summarily rejected.
- 8. BHEL does not guarantee any minimum quantity.
- 9. No other pre conditions along with your offer will be entertained by BHEL.
- 10. Tenderer who have been suspended or black listed or issued with "Show Cause Notice" by BHEL, Tiruchirappalli - 620014 or any other unit of BHEL or Government of India will not be allowed to participate in the tender. Even during the course of evaluation/ finalization of tender if it is found that some of the parties are black listed/ barred from business transaction/ under business hold, BHEL will not consider them for further participation in the tender.
- 11. Should a tenderer find discrepancies or omissions in the tender documents or should there be any doubt as to their meaning, he should at once address the authority inviting the tender for clarification well before the due date, so as to submit his tender in time. No extension of time shall be given for submission of the tender on any account.
- 12. All pages of this tender documents and supporting documents shall be dully signed, stamped and Submitted as technical bid.
- 13. Documents not signed and stamped by the authorized signatory of the bidder shall not be accepted and considered for evaluation of bid.
- 14. If a tenderer deliberately gives wrong information in his tender or creates conditions favorable for the acceptance of his tender, BHEL will reject such tender at any stage.

- 15. Words imparting singular number shall be deemed to include plural number and vice-versa where the context so requires.
- 16. Canvassing in any form in connection with tenders is strictly prohibited and the tenders submitted by the Contractors who resort to canvassing will be liable for rejection.
- 17. The tender schedule and the tender shall be deemed to form an integral part of the contract to be entered into for this work.
- 18. Tenderer shall sign and affix the seal in the tender documents for having accepted the conditions and submit the same along with Technical Bid. In case of corrigendum issued to this tender, corrigendum shall also be signed and seal affixed by tenderer (other than extension of tender opening schedule) and to be submitted along with Technical bid. Supporting documents must be self-attested by tenderer.
- 19. Tender can be cancelled at any stage due to unavoidable circumstances.
- 20. Bidder are advised not to wait till the last minutes or last few seconds w.r.t tender closing time to submit their offer to avoid complications related with Road Traffic or any other conditions.
- 21. All future communications / corrigendum related to this tender if any would be posted in BHEL Website / Central Public Procurement Portal only. Tenderers are advised to regularly visit the BHEL Website / Central Public Procurement Portal for all future communications / Corrigendum.

- 3. The quality of instant coffee powder (Strength/colour/flavour and taste) will be checked by sample evaluation committee. The committee's recommendation is final and binding.

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Annexure - 1C

Administrative instructions:

- 1. We require Approximately 500 Kilograms per month of Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture in the respective ratio of 60:40.
- 2. Required quantity may vary based on our actual requirement and Quantity mentioned in the purchase order shall be final. BHEL does not guarantee any minimum quantity.
- 3. Normally the supply should be made once in a month unless otherwise mentioned in the indent.
- 4. Samples in 2 nos of ¼ Kg in each pack of coffee powder in the ratio of 60:40 (coffee + chicory respectively) to be submitted on or before the tender submission schedule. Samples less than 2 nos of ¼ Kg in each pack will not be accepted.
- 5. More than one type of sample will not be accepted
- 6. After opening the technical bid, documents will be verified and the samples would be subject to necessary quality & taste test. The technical bids and samples both found acceptable alone after evaluation will be considered for Price bid opening.
- 7. The contract will be awarded for a period of one year from the date of award of contract and supply rate shall remain firm for the entire period of the contract.
- 8. Price bid shall be valid up to 90 days from date of Tender opening.

Annexure - 1D

Technical Terms and Conditions

- 1. The Soluble Coffee-chicory Powder/agglomerates shall confirm to the following analysis:-
 - (a) Moisture, percent by mass, max 4.0
 - (b) Total Ash, percent by mass Not less than 7.0 (On dry basis) and not more than 10.0
 - (c) Caffeine (anhydrous), percent 1.4 by mass (on dry basis), min
 - (d) Solubility in cold water Shall be soluble with at 16°C ± 2°C moderate stirring in three minutes.
 - (e) Solubility in boiling water Shall dissolve readily in 30 seconds with moderate stirring.
- 2. Vendor should submit the copy of the test report of sample within 2 months from award of the contract obtained from CFTRI, Mysore or NABL accredited food testing laboratory. Payment shall be made on submission of above certificate only.
- 3. The Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture in 60:40 proportions should be supplied in factory bulk pack of ½ (Half) Kg (30% of supply) & 1 (One) Kg (70% of supply) only, which should be in line with the sample given along with the Technical Bid. FSSAI norms to be followed in each Pack.
- 4. Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture shall conform to the standards specified in the "Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules 1955. If needed BHEL may select sample at random from the supplied Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture by the successful tenderer for testing the conformity of the supply with the standards specified in the Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules 1955 by CFTRI, Mysore or FSSAI notified NABL accredited food testing laboratory.
- 5. In the event of the CFTRI, Mysore or FSSAI notified NABL accredited food testing laboratory certifying that the sample is NOT CONFORMING with the standards of Prevention of Food Adulteration Rules 1955, the unused Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture will be returned to the tenderer. In such a case the rate for the already used will not be paid.
- 6. Instant coffee should be supplied within a month from the date of manufacturing and which can be well utilised for six months from the date of manufacturing. In case of any other defective supply, the full quantity is to be replaced by the successful tenderer immediately and then only the rejected stocks will be returned.
- 7. In case of any defective / quality issue or etc found during the usage of Instant coffee power, full quantity to be replaced within 2 days from the date of intimation to the suppliers which will be intimated to the supplier within two months from the date of supply.
- 8. Moreover, any tenderer failing in the quality test by CFTRI, Mysore or NABL accredited food testing laboratory more than once during their supply, suitable action will be taken against the tenderer as per the extant guidelines of BHEL.

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Annexure - 1E

General Terms and Conditions

- The Tenderer may quote fixed rate for a period of one year for the Instant Coffee-Chicory Mixture to be supplied. The rate should include transport, handling, packing, gunny bag cost, profit margin inclusion of all taxes and delivery at BHEL Canteen stores. Price quoted will be valid and firm for the period of one year from award of contract.
- 2. The contract will be awarded for a period of one year from the date of award of contract and supply rate shall remain firm for the entire period of the contract.
- 3. BHEL does not guarantee any minimum quantity.
- 4. Normally PO will be issued 15 days in advance through email indicated in the tender enquiry and the supply to be made within the scheduled date. Delivery should be made as per PO any excess materials brought inside the Stores will not be returned at any cost and No payment will be made for the excess quantity.
- 5. For any clarification you can contact to sound@bhel.in Contact nos. 04312577327.
- The payment for the supply shall normally be made within 45 days from the date of receipt of Instant Coffee Powder at BHEL canteen stores and the payment will be made only through EFT mode (Electronic Fund Transfer).
- 7. The successful tenderer shall report at 08:30 AM and complete the delivery of items as per our delivery schedule at our Canteen Stores on the scheduled date of supply before 12.00 Noon. The delivery schedule will be communicated along with our purchase order to the successful tenderer later.
- 8. The bulk supply should be made in standard carton box / food grade plastic packing only.
- 9. It shall be the responsibility of the successful tenderer to weigh the Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture properly before loading at their end for supply to BHEL Canteen Stores. Delivery Challan / Credit bill in triplicate should accompany the supply.
- 10. The successful tenderer shall also arrange his own transport and unload the entire quantity first in the Stores receipt area and after weighing each bag in the electronic balance of HRM Canteen Store and then keep the bags inside the Store room. The supply is said to be completed only if the entire material has been kept inside the store room after completing the above formalities with respect to delivery requirements.
- 11. The delivery is to be made in BHEL Canteen Stores. In case of failure in supplying the materials as per our Delivery Schedule date indicated in the Purchase Order or replacement not done in time, which will be considered as contract has been breached by the supplier.

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12. The tenderer should possess the correct address of the Firm / Shop, all requisite licenses, Tax Certificates, Registration Documents, etc., for supplying the Instant Coffee Chicory Mixture.

- 13. Offer submitted late beyond the due date & time will be summarily rejected. Submitting more than One (1) type of sample will be also summarily rejected.
- 14. These general terms and conditions shall be applicable for the bids, however BHEL reserve rights to add, cancel or modify the same at any time without assigning reasons.

15. BHEL reserves the right to

- I. Increase or decrease the tendered quantity.
- II. Cancel the tender enquiry at any stage or cancel the contract at any time during the execution of contract without assigning any reason.
- III. Negotiate or re-float the tender opened if L1 price is not the lowest acceptable price to them inter-alia other reasons. The decision of BHEL in awarding the contract is final and BHEL reserves the right to reject any or all tenders without assigning any reasons.
- IV. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L1 bidders. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss / draw of lots, in the presence of L-1 bidders or their representatives. Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final and binding.
- 16. Disputes or differences arising from this tender or in any manner connected therewith, our Head of HR's decision is final and binding.
 - I. Any dispute shall initially be discussed amongst parties and settled amicably.
 - II. If no amicable settlement or if there is no scope for amicable settlement, then any party may refer the dispute to sole arbitrator to be nominated by the Head of HR, BHEL, Trichy. The place of arbitration shall be at Trichy. All arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
 - III. The arbitration award shall be final and binding upon the parties and each party will bear its own costs of arbitration and equally share the fees of the arbitral tribunal.
- 17. All disputes shall be subject to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Trichy.
- 18. The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications, certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process. In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

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19. Risk Purchase Clause & Cancellation of contract

In case of breach of contract, wherever the value of security instruments like performance bank guarantee available with BHEL against the said contract is 10% of the contract value or more, such security instruments to the extent of 10% contract value will be encashed. In case no security instruments are available or the value of the security instruments available is less than 10% of the contract value, the 10% of the contract value or the balance amount, as the case may be, will be recovered in all or any of the following manners:

- a. from dues available in the form of Bills payable to defaulted supplier against the same contract.
- b. from the dues payable to defaulted supplier against other contracts in the same Region/Unit /any other region/unit
- c. In-case recoveries are not possible with any of the above available options, Legal action shall be initiated for recovery against defaulted supplier.
- d. In case Vendor fails to fulfil any of the specified terms and conditions of PO / contract then, the PO/Contract shall be cancelled / short closed and appropriate cost shall be deducted from the vendor's pending bills in BHEL Trichy (or) across the BHEL units.

Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure, etc., will be applied as per provisions of the contract.

20. Liquidate Damages

If the supplier fails to deliver / replace the materials within 15 days from the date of issue of PO, Liquidated Damages of a sum equivalent to 0.1% of the PO value per day will be deducted from the supplier subject to maximum of 10% of total contract value.

21. Termination of Contract on Death of Contractor:

Without prejudice to any of the rights or remedies under this contract, if the Contractor dies, or if the firm is dissolved or the company is liquidated, BHEL shall have the option of terminating the contract without compensation to the Contractor.

22. Arbitration: -

Disputes or differences arising from this tender or in any manner connected there with shall be subject to the following dispute resolution mechanism:

- > Any dispute shall initially be referred to the designated Senior Management of the parties for amicable settlement. Parties shall nominate two persons each from their senior management within 10 days of a dispute arising.
- ➢ If no amicable settlement is arrived at within 30 days, then any party may refer the dispute to sole arbitrator to be nominated by the Head of HR, BHEL, Trichy. The place of arbitration shall be at Trichy. All arbitration proceedings shall be conducted in English in accordance with the provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act, 1996.
- ➤ The arbitration award shall be final and binding upon the parties and each party will bear its own costs of arbitration and equally share the fees of the arbitral tribunal. All the disputes shall be subjected to the exclusive jurisdiction of courts at Trichy.

23. Fraud prevention policy:

24. SUSPENSION OF BUSINESS DEALINGS WITH SUPPLIERS / CONTRACTORS:

Penal action can be initiated on the suppliers / Contractors in line with extant 'Guidelines for Suspension of Business Dealings with Suppliers/ Contractors. The abridged version of extant 'Guidelines for suspension of business dealings with suppliers/ contractors' has been uploaded on http://www.bhel.com on "supplier registration page".

25. SPECIAL PROVISIONS FOR MICRO AND SMALL ENTERPRISES (MSE) BIDDERS REGISTERED AS PER MSME ACT:

- 25% of the tendered quantity is earmarked for MSE suppliers (Manufacturers Only) as per the latest MSE guidelines.
- II. If L1 is MSE vendor, total tendered value shall be awarded to L1 vendor.
- III. If L1 is Non-MSE vendor, in case MSE vendor participating in the tender quotes within the price band of L1 + 15%, they will be allowed to supply the portion of the requirement subject to acceptance of L1 price by MSE vendor. In case of more than one such MSE, the supply shall be shared equally.
- IV. In case of any change in the MSE status of the bidder, it shall be the responsibility of the bidder to notify the change as a part of the bid document. If at a later date it comes to the knowledge of BHEL, that the change in the status has not been intimated by the bidder and the order is obtained under the premise of an MSE then BHEL would cancel the pending order against this tender and take necessary steps for suspension of the business dealing with the bidder as per the procurement policy of BHEL.
- V. In case of none of the MSE vendor participates or none of the eligible MSE vendor accept the L1 price, total quantity will be ordered on L1 Non-MSE vendor.
- VI. For availing MSE benefit, MSE vendor under manufacturer for tendered items should submit copy of Udyam Registration number along with Technical bid.
- VII. Non submission of such documents will lead to consideration of their bids at par with other bidders and No benefits shall be applicable for the enquiry if any deficiency in the above required documents is not submitted before the price bid opening. This provision for MSE will apply subject to the condition that the participating MSE meets the tender requirements.

26. Preference to Make in India:

For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a class I local supplier/class II local supplier /Non-local supplier and purchase preference to class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent Orders issued by the respective Nodal Ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of part II bids against this NIT. (Local content declaration Format is given in

27. Conflict of interest -

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of procuring entity's interests. The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified. A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

- a) they have controlling partner (s) in common; or
- b) they receive or have received any direct or indirect subsidy / financial stake from any of them; or
- c) they have the same legal representative/agent for purposes of this bid; or
- they have relationship with each other, directly or through common third parties, that puts them in a position to have access to information about or influence on the bid of another bidder; or
- e) Bidder participates in more than one bid in this bidding process. Participation by a bidder in more than one bid will result in the disqualification of all bids in which the parties are involved. However, this does not limit the inclusion of the components / sub-assembly / assemblies from one bidding manufacturer in more than one bid; or
- f) In cases of agent quoting in offshore procurement, on behalf of their principal manufacturers, one agent cannot represent two manufacturers or quote on their behalf in a particular tender enquiry. One manufacturer can also authorize only one agent/dealer. There can be only one bid from the following:
 - 1) The principal manufacturer directly or through one Indian agent on his behalf; and
