2.1 Tray Work, Cable Laying & Termination, Junction Box Installation work: - Handling at site & store/storage yard, transportation to site of work, complete erection, testing, commissioning and handing over.		
2.2 Erection part: The work shall conform to dimensions & tolerances given in various drawing & documents that will be provided during erection. If any portion of work is found to be not conforming to drawings or other stipulations, successful bidder shall inform immediately to BHEL engineer and redo the work, if suggested by BHEL. However, workmanship defects if any, will be done by you free of cost or BHEL will be carried out at your risk and cost.		
2.3 Successful bidder shall deploy fire extinguishers of required number in their office, work areas & surveillance will be done throughout the execution period.		
2.4 Successful bidder shall take the full responsibility of execution of the equipment/system by them under the overall supervision of BHEL. In the absence of such filled-up schedule/ format it will be understood and agreed that the bidder's offer is based on strict conformance to the specification and no negotiation would be allowed in this regard. BHEL reserve the right not to recognize any / all deviations submitted after opening of the bid.
05. DEWATERING	Successful bidder shall ensure at all times that their work area & approach/ access roads are free from accumulation of water, so that the materials are safe and the erection/ progress schedule are not affected. No separate claim in this regard shall be admitted by BHEL. No separate payments for dewatering of subsoil, surface water or catchments water, if required, at any time during execution of the work including monsoon period shall be considered by BHEL. All dewatering pumps are to be provided by successful bidder, if required.
06. Tools and Plants (T & Ps)	The awarded party need to arrange and employ necessary T&Ps.
07. Electrical Power for the Job	BHEL will provide construction power free of charges at 415 V level at one/ two strategic point(s) within plant premise shall make their own distribution arrangement to draw electricity.

08. Tray Work, Cable Laying & Termination, Junction Box Installation work:

- a. Laying, dressing of cable-on-cable tray glanding & termination as required. Cable laying, dressing & cable tagging will be as per BHEL Engineer.
- b. Cable laying job includes supply & installation of required clamps
- c. Cable termination shall include drilling/making of holes in gland plates, fixing of glands, ferrules and lugs, fixing of cable tags and connection to the equipment without implication of extra cost to BHEL. Material required for making ferrule and cable tag are to be arranged by the successful bidder without any extra cost to BHEL.
- d. All testing & inspection has to be arranged by successful bidder & joint protocol has to be prepared between BHEL & end customer.
- e. All required testing like continuity check, megger test if required has to arranged by the successful bidder & it will in cabling erection job scope. No, extra payment will be made in this regard.
- f. Fabrication, erection, and painting of GI perforated or ladder-type cable trays (with or without covers), using all required fixing accessories as per drawings. Includes site modifications for bends, turns, or custom profiles to suit the layout.
- g. Installation of various types of junction boxes (**Electrical/FRP, MS/Fiber/GI, Cold Junction Compensation Boxes, MTM, etc.**), with or without canopy as required.
- h. Fabrication, erection, and painting of structural steel (**angles, channels, flats, plates, etc.**) with steel free supplied by BHEL.
- i. All consumables **like welding electrodes, Tag Patti & Ferrules & Cable Lugs up to 2.5 sq.mm** etc. has to arranged by the successful bidder. No, extra payment will be made in this regard.

09. PROTOCOL:

In each erection, testing protocol, joint signatures of successful bidder, BHEL as well as Customer are required.

10. Safety of the Work-area

For the Safety of the Work-area and the Job itself, the awarded L1(lowest bidder) Vendor need to adopt following means of procedures as follows: -

- a. The successful bidder has to take workmen insurance policy for their employees/workmen for working in Sagardighi Site.
- b. All these Employees of the Vendor with valid Insurance, need to have Gate Pass too, for safe entry and exit in the premises of Sagardighi Site.
- c. All these Employees of the Vendor should have necessary Safety PPEs and required Height/Hot-Work Passes, as needed from time to time.
- d. The awarded L1 Vendor need to obtain Safety Work Permit (applied for a pre-determined day with description of the Job), every day before the commencement of the Job with the number of Employees working on that particular day, as mentioned thereof.
- e. After the end of the Job every day, remaining tools and tackles and the Materials & Consumables need to be secured safely at Vendor's designated Place.

11. Security

The awarded party will take necessary precautions/ due care to protect the material at Project site, while in his custody from any damage/ loss till the same is handed Over to BHEL/ customer at Project site. BHEL will reserve the right to Recover the loss from the contractor as detailed below in case the damage/loss is due to negligence/ carelessness on the part of the contractor.

In case of theft of material under contractor's custody, the same shall be reported to police by the contractor immediately and copy of FIR shall be submitted to BHEL for taking up further at BHEL. However, this will not relieve the contractor of his contractual obligation for the materials in his custody.

For the Security of the Materials and the Manpower, during the ongoing job at the said Area, contractor will deploy own Security Personnel round the clock (24 hours) for the Security and Surveillance purpose.

12. Contract period of the Job

The postulated duration of the Job will be 180 days from the start of work.

15. Bidder shall submit copy of GST and Trade License along with Tender documents.

16. Payment Terms with the Certification of Work done

- a. Progressive monthly payment can be claimed by the awarded party for the executed BOQ quantity Jobs on certification by BHEL- Engineer. 5% of the amount of the certified bill will be kept as retention amount on progressive billing which will be released on successful completion of the awarded job.
- b. **Payment Break up for cabling: 60 % on laying, 20% on loop checking & termination 20% on Dressing & Clamping**
- c. **Payment Terms for Tray & JB erection & Structural Steel Fabrication: 60 % on Erection/Fabrication with support, 20 % on Fixing loose items & 20 % completion of all jobs including painting.**
- d. On basis of the actual work done, as certified by the BHEL Engineer, the awarded L1 Vendor need to raise the Invoice along with copies of GST and Trade License along with the certified copy of work-measurement.

- d) TDS under Income Tax shall be deducted as per prevailing IT rules from bills.
