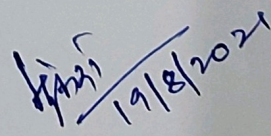

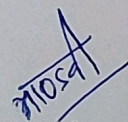

2.6	Delayed Delivery Penalty: LD shall be 0.5 % of the order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of the full order value. In case of any change to the order value, the LD shall be 0.5% of the revised order value per week of delay or part thereof subject to a maximum of 10% of revised order value. 2.17	Guarantee Certificate: The equipment / material including spares shall be guaranteed during defect liability period, which shall extend for 24 months from the date of operational acceptance. Vendor should accordingly submit guarantee certificate.	
2.18	Supervision Charges: Vendor has to quote the supervision charges separately in the price bid. In case the supervision is required during installation / commissioning, the charges for the same will be paid at that time separately on completion of the work.	
2.19	MSE Clause: "MSE suppliers can avail the indented benefits only if they submit any of the following documents along with offer: a. Udyog Aadhaar Memorandum & Acknowledgement. b. Valid NSIC Certificate, c. 2.20	Risk Purchase: In case the successful tenderer fails to adhere to the agreed schedule for supply or fails to comply with the terms and conditions of the purchase order. BHEL reserves the right to source such material/component/equipment/system from any other agency at the risk and cost of the successful tenderer. The cost of such purchases along with 25% overhead charges shall be recovered from the bills pending from any other unit of BHEL. In the event of no amount being out standing from BHEL, successful tenderer shall be liable to pay to BHEL the above amount immediately on demand. The decision regarding applying risk-and purchase clause from BHEL shall be final & binding.

2.23	Non-Disclosure Agreement: All drawings and technical documents relating to the product or its manufacture submitted by one party to the other, prior or subsequent to the formation of contract, shall remain property of the submitting party. Drawing, technical documents or other technical information received by one party, shall not without the consent of the other party, be used for any other purpose than that, for which they were provided, such technical information shall not without the consent of the submitting party, otherwise be used or copied, reproduced, transmitted or communicated to a third party. Patterns supplied by BHEL will remain BHEL's property which shall be returned by the bidder on demand to BHEL. In case dispute is not settled in negotiation, it shall be referred to a Conciliation appointed by BHEL. In case dispute is not settled in conciliation proceedings too, the same shall be referred to sole arbitration of General Manager of the Department/Executive Director of the unit or any person nominated by any of them as per corporate Guidelines of BHEL and the arbitration proceedings shall be taken out as per provisions of the Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 as amended read with BHEL's Corporate guidelines in force. 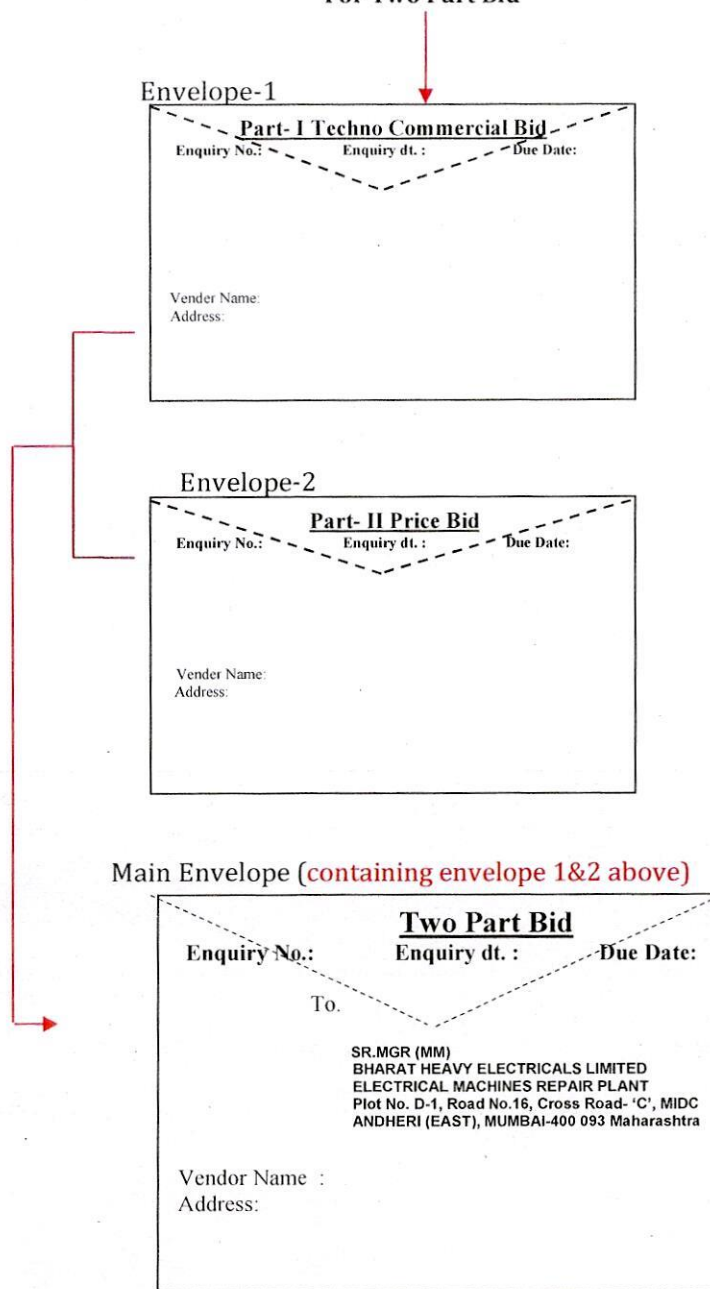

PROCESS: -

- On the due date, after 2:00 pm, the main envelope containing the other two sealed envelopes would be opened. Thereafter, the envelope containing the techno – commercial bid (part – I) would be opened.
- The price bid envelope would be kept sealed which would be opened at a later date for only those suppliers who would qualify in the techno commercial bid. During scrutiny of offer, suppliers are supposed to reply for clarifications, if asked, within a week's time.
- The bids shall be evaluated on total delivered cost to BHEL (HESG rate).
- The offers shall also be suitably loaded for any deviation from the Terms & Conditions to arrive at the HESG rate.
