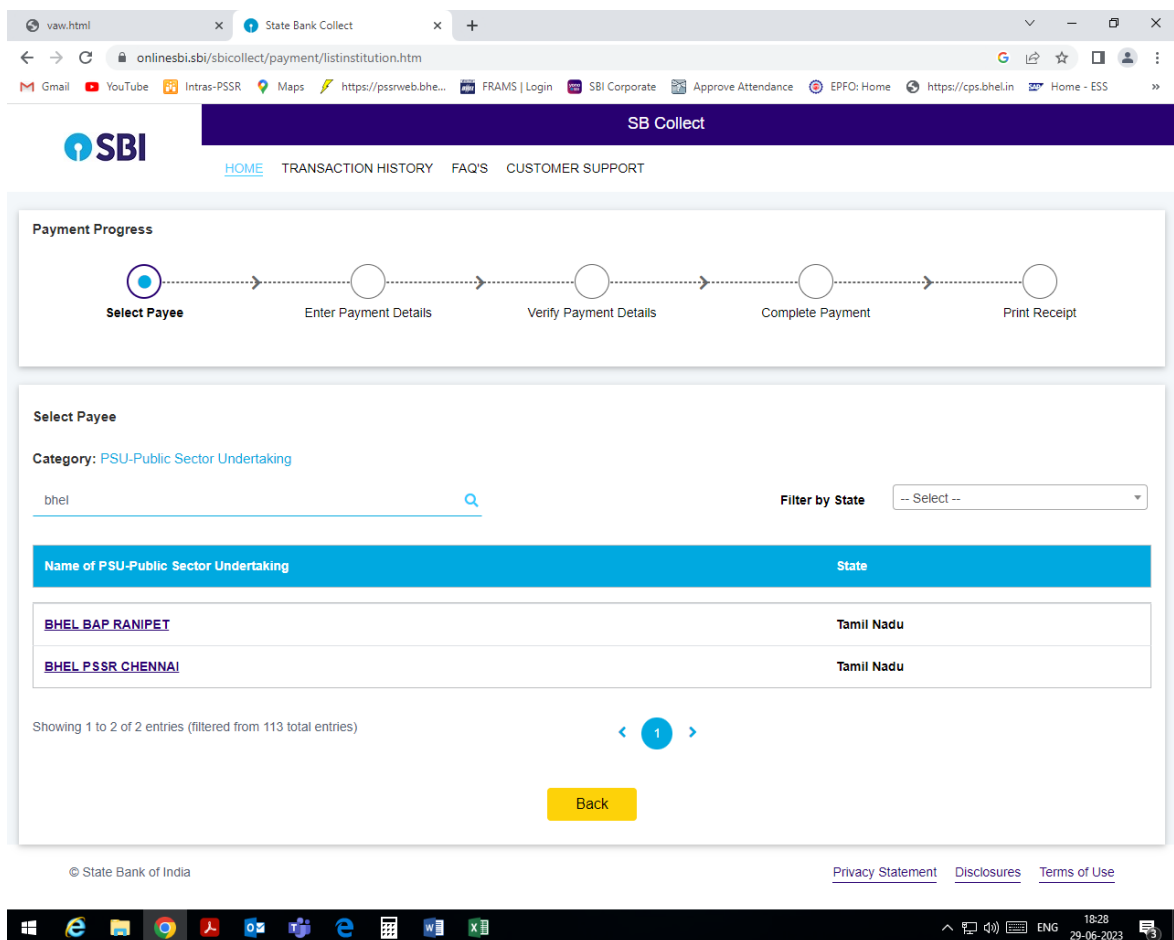

20.0 PREFERENCE TO MAKE IN INDIA:

For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as a Class I local supplier/ Class II local supplier/ Non- Local supplier and purchase preference to Class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make in India), Order 2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent Orders issued by the Nodal Ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but before opening of Part-II bids against this NIT.

Regarding verification of local content, the local supplier at the time of tender, bidding or solicitation shall be required to provide certification as per para 9 of PP-MII order revision dated 16.092020 & 16.112021.

Both Class-I LS & Class-II LS are eligible to bid in this tender. MLC for Class-I LS is 50% and for Class-II LS is 20% for subject Tender/NIT. Subject package/tender in 'Divisible' in nature. Following point to be noted regarding verification of local content: -

21.0 Bid should be free from correction, overwriting, using corrective fluid, etc. Any interlineation, cutting, erasure or overwriting shall be valid only if they are attested under full signature(s) of person(s) signing the bid else bid shall be liable for rejection.

22.0 In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders.

In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss/ draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative(s).

Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be final and binding.

23.0 The Bidder declares that they will not enter into any illegal or undisclosed agreement or understanding, whether formal or informal with other Bidder(s). This applies in particular to prices, specifications,

certifications, subsidiary contracts, submission or non-submission of bids or any other actions to restrict competitiveness or to introduce cartelization in the bidding process.

In case, the Bidder is found having indulged in above activities, suitable action shall be taken by BHEL as per extant policies/ guidelines.

25.0 One Bid per Bidder

A Bidder shall submit only one bid in a particular bidding process. In case of a holding company having more than one subsidiary having common business ownership/ management, only one business entity amongst the holding company and its subsidiaries should quote for a particular tender. Similar restrictions shall apply to closely related sister companies. Bidder's sister/ Associated/ Allied concern(s) participating or applying against the same tender, shall lead to disqualification of Bidders. Sister/ Associated/ Allied concern means a company, society, partnership firm or proprietorship firm having one or more common persons as Director/ Partner/ Member/ Owner. A Bidder who submits more than one bid will cause all the proposals submitted in the particular bid to be disqualified.

In relation to the above, a person will include firm(s) of Proprietorship / Partnership Firm /Limited Liability Partnership / Private Limited / Limited company / Society registered under Society's Act / Statutory Bodies / any other legal entity, as the case maybe, & will be deemed to have submitted multiple bids in a particular bid if a person bids in any of the two formats given below:

- i. individual or proprietorship format and/or
- ii. a partnership or association of persons format and/or
- iii. a company format

Whereby,

- A company shall for this purpose include any artificial person whether constituted under the Indian laws or of any other country.
- A person shall be deemed to have bid in a partnership format or in association of persons format if he is a partner of the firm which has submitted the bid or is a member of any association of persons which has submitted a bid.
- A person shall be deemed to have bid in a company format if the person holds:
 - i. more than 10% (ten percent) of the voting share capital of the company which has submitted a bid, or
 - ii. is a director and / or Key Managerial Personnel of the company which has submitted a bid, or

holds more than 10% (ten percent) of voting share capital in and/or is a director and / or Key Managerial Personnel of a holding company of that company which has submitted the bid.

By making a bid pursuant to the Tender Documents, the bidder / tenderer shall be deemed to have declared that the bidder / tenderer has not made any other bid or multiple bids as understood or deemed in terms of this clause.

26.0 Conflict of interest

A bidder shall not have conflict of interest with other bidders. Such conflict of interest can lead to anti-competitive practices to the detriment of Procuring Entity's interests. **The bidder found to have a conflict of interest shall be disqualified.** A bidder may be considered to have a conflict of interest with one or more parties in this bidding process, if:

TECHNICAL CONDITIONS OF CONTRACT

1.0 SCOPE OF WORK:

Handling and removal of construction debris including civil, structural, mechanical materials and removal of vegetation along the main/approach road of the Plant. The agency has to be equipped with machineries such as JCB, Excavator, Hydra/small capacity crane, Trailer, dumper and man power (The resources may be utilized appropriately as per site requirement).

The process involved for the above work is removal of various scrap by using any suitable machinery and shifting and stacking of the same in the area designated by BHEL. The measurement will be done on the basis of quantity of material handled, the labour will be dealt on day basis.

The scope of work (The item quantity specified in the contract is indicative) will also include, such other related works although they may not be specifically mentioned above and all such incidental items not specified but reasonably implied and necessary for completion of the job as a whole and as desired and as directed by the engineer. The detail scope of work covered above is not a comprehensive list of items of work involved. The detail scope of work may vary considerably depending on the actual construction requirements.

2.0 PERIOD OF CONTRACT:

4.5 QUANTITY VARIATION

11.0 WORKMANSHIP

- 12.1 The workmanship shall be according to best construction practice to the satisfaction of the Engineer.

12.0 SAFETY

- 12.1 The contractor to follow all safety norms as per present norms indicated in GCC and as per revised norms from time to time.

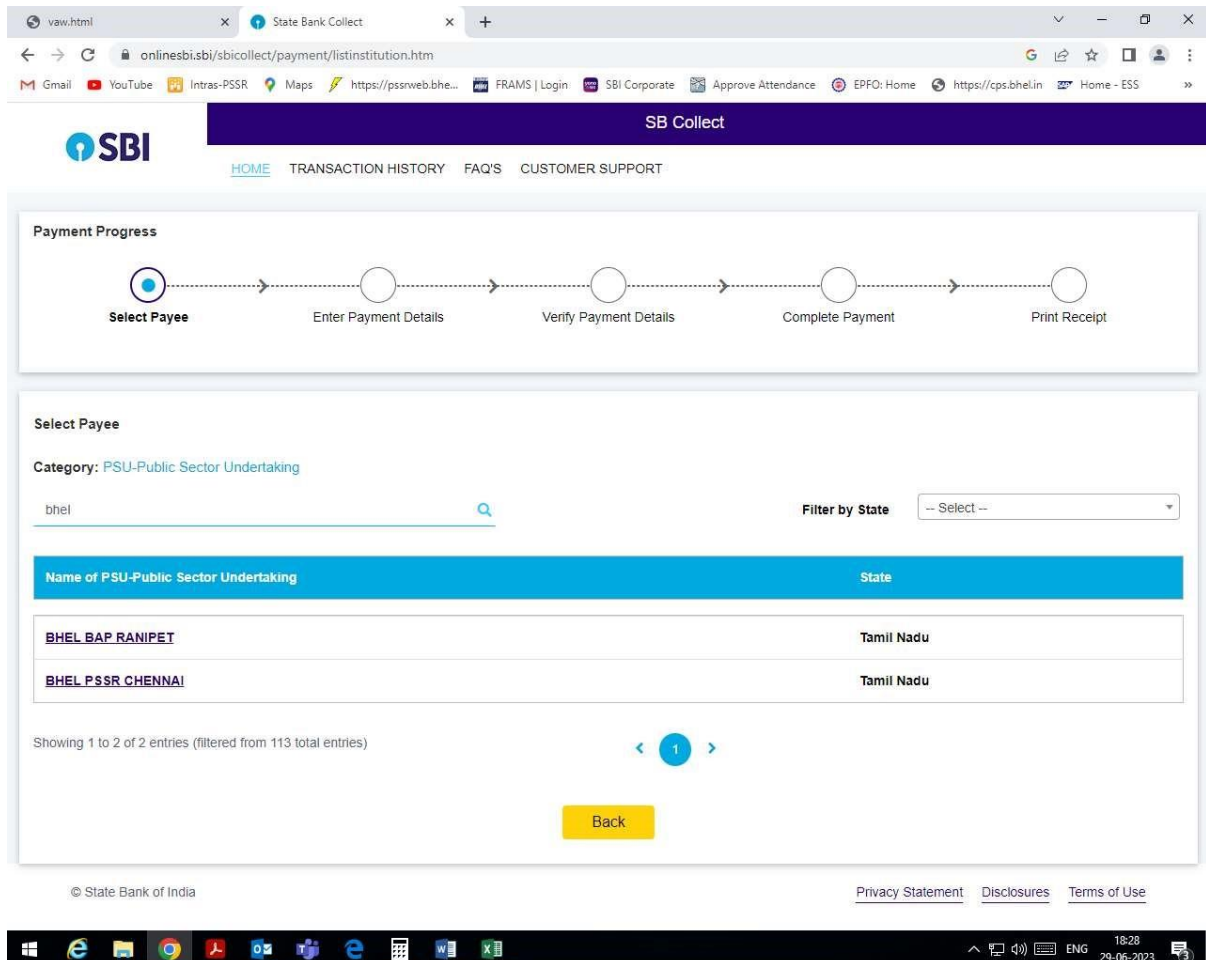
