Please note that the procurement is a sample-based procurement i.e. sample qualification is inherent part of techno-commercial qualification of offer.

Annexure-"B"

Special Terms & Conditions:

- 1. BHEL Corporate Office, New Delhi intents to enter into a rate contract for procurement of souvenir for BHEL employees of various units across all over India on the occasion of New Year as per specifications enclosed at *Annexure-A*. The maximum amount for the said souvenir is fixed to be Rs. 2000 (all-inclusive) and the required item shall be supplied strictly in accordance with the technical specifications enclosed at Annexure-A. The purchase orders shall be placed by individual BHEL units located all over India. No cartage / transportation charges shall be paid by BHEL separately. The bidder shall build all the relevant charges into the UNIT price quoted in the price bid.
- Tenders shall be received up to 15:00 Hrs of 02-11-2023 and techno commercial (Part-I) bids shall be opened at 15:30 Hrs of 02-11-2023 i.e. on the same day in the presence of bidders or their authorized representatives whom so ever may like to be present.
- 3. <u>Procedure of bid submission:</u> Bids shall be submitted latest by 15:00 Hrs. on or before the due date, in two parts as follows:
 - a) Part-I (Techno-Commercial Bid): This part shall contain the following:

All pages of tender document along with documents sought in PQR, except Price Format at Annexure-E, duly filled, signed & stamped by an authorized representative as an acceptance of all tender terms & conditions. This part shall be submitted in a separate sealed cover / envelope with bidder's Seal super-scribed with correct Enquiry No, due date of opening and 'Part-I: Techno-Commercial bid'.

It is important to note that this procurement is a sample-based procurement and the sample is an integral part of the technical bid. Since it will be bulky & may not fit in the same envelope. The sample shall also be submitted to tender issuing authority well within the last date of bid submission i.e. 15:00 Hrs of 02-11-2023-. Non-submission of sample within the prescribed time frame above shall result in rejection of offer on technocommercial ground.

- b) Part-II (Financial Bid): Part-II shall contain Prices only as per Price Format (Annexure—E) and should not contain any technical details and / or Commercial Terms & Conditions. This part shall be submitted in a sealed cover / envelope with bidder's Seal super-scribed with correct Enquiry No., due date of opening and 'Part-II: Price Bid'. Rates shall be quoted both in words and figures.
- c) Both Part-I & Part-II sealed covers / envelopes should be then put in another master sealed cover / envelope with bidder's seal super-scribed with correct Enquiry No., title of tender and due date of opening.
- d) Bid shall be submitted at BHEL House, Siri Fort, New Delhi 110049 in the Tender Box at Gate 3 Reception area, well before the due date & time of submission. The tender shall not be handed over to any individual at BHEL & only be put in the tender box. Sample shall be handed over to tender issuing authority.



IMPORTANT NOTE:

- i. No additional documents shall be submitted with Part-I and Part-II bid other than the documents enlisted above for both bids by the bidders. Additional documents if found any, shall not be considered for evaluation purpose.
- ii. Bidders are requested to quote in two parts as given above. However, for quotation submitted in single bid against our requirement of two-part bid will be considered only if the bid is techno-commercially accepted without seeking any clarifications/missing documents from the bidder. Otherwise, the bid is liable to be rejected.
- 4. Delayed tenders are liable to be rejected.
- Deviations, if any, shall be listed out separately as per Annexure "F" which may or may not be accepted by BHEL. Deviations mentioned anywhere else other than Annexure F shall not be considered.
- 6. Packing and Marking: The supplier shall arrange for securely protecting and packing the items to avoid loss or damages during transit. Each item shall be in an individual packaging box with handle or individual packaging box with carry bag. BHEL logo & New Year wishes shall be printed/pasted on packaging box/carry bag. The design of logo shall be communicated to the successful bidder at the appropriate time.
- 7. The cost of each offered souvenir item payable by bidder shall be maximum Rs. 2000/-inclusive of all taxes & freight, packing with BHEL logo & New Year wishes printing/pasting, forwarding charges etc. The vendor has to quote the best suitable item at the above cost.
- 8. Bidders are requested to quote their offer price on F.O.R. Destination (BHEL/Stores) basis. It is being reiterated No cartage / transportation charges shall be paid by BHEL separately. The bidder shall build all the relevant charges into the UNIT price quoted in the price bid.
- 9. BHEL reserves the right to inspect the material at vendor's premises/manufacturing location during manufacturing and/or before dispatch of material. However, dispatch clearance by BHEL before actual dispatch shall be mandatory. Cost of TA/DA/Stay of BHEL individuals coming for inspection, if any, shall be borne by BHEL.
- 10. The successful bidder shall supply the material as per technical specifications. The required item, if found of inferior quality, will be rejected by BHEL and the same to be replaced free of cost. No payment shall be made against rejected / defective supply. The sucessful bidder shall supply the brand-new items.
- 11. Successful bidder shall abide by all the rules/regulations/status imposed by the Govt./or other concerned authorities. The contractor will be responsible for all requirements of local municipalities/ Govt. or any other law regulating bodies.
- 12. **Qty Required**: BHEL intents to buy a total of 5023 no's of souvenir with a quantity tolerance of \pm 30 % for its employees. This implies that BHEL at his discretion may place order for any Qty falling between 3516 no's & 6530 no's.

13. Agreement tenure & Contract Period: This contract shall commence on the date of awarding of contract and shall remain in force for a period of 03 months. However, this



contract/agreement shall be liable to be terminated earlier by BHEL at any time by giving minimum 30 days' notice period to the contractor without assigning any reason therefore and without prejudice to the rights of the BHEL to recover any amount becoming due under this agreement.

- 14. <u>Delivery Period & Liquidated Damages:</u> The P.O. shall be placed by individual BHEL unit. The required items shall be supplied within 30 days on placement of PO. In case of supply is delayed beyond this period; BHEL reserves the right to levy LD @ ½% per week or part thereof of delayed quantity subject to maximum of 10% of ordered value of that PO.
- 15. The offers of the bidders who are on the banned list and also the offer of the bidders who engage the services of the banned firms, shall be rejected. The list of banned firms is available on BHEL website www.bhel.com.
- 16. <u>Validity of offer:</u> The offers submitted by the parties shall be valid for a period of 60 days from date of opening of bids. Price bid opening shall be limited to techno-commercially acceptable bidders only. Further, BHEL reserves the right to reject the offer of bidder(s) without assigning any reason.

17. PAYMENT TERMS:

- a) GST Compliant Invoice complete in all respect along with all the requisite documents submitted by the vendor will be paid within 30 days of its receipt and final acceptance of BHEL. The payment shall be made by the individual unit of BHEL.
- b) The 95% payment would be made on the basis of actual number of items provided by the vendor as per tender terms & conditions. Rest 5 % of the payment (from each bill) shall be Retention Money. This shall be released after 3 months of successful completion of the contract, including replacements of all defective items. However, this retention money can be released against Bank Guarantee.
- c) The Contractor will have to intimate the NEFT details to enable BHEL to credit the payments into the account.
- d) No interest shall be payable for delay in making the payment. The Contractor shall not be entitled to any interest with respect to any money which may be due to him from BHEL.
- e) <u>Procedure for Submission of Bills by Contractor</u>: The Contractor shall raise the bill, in triplicate, along with all the necessary documents. The Contractor shall submit the GST compliant invoice to BHEL unit placing P.O. On receipt of the bills/invoices along with all the supporting documents, BHEL will verify and process the bill(s) in line with contractual terms & conditions.

18. TAXES & DUTIES

- a) Price shall be all inclusive, except GST. The amount towards GST shall be indicated separately as specified in the price format.
- To enable BHEL to avail GST input tax credit, vendor shall submit GST compliant invoice containing all the particulars as stipulated under Invoice Rules of CGST Rules, 2017 as



amended from time to time. Such invoice shall be submitted within prescribed time limit in the name of BHEL, Corporate Office, BHEL House, Siri Fort, New Delhi.

- c) Digital tax invoice shall be preferred or e-invoice, if applicable.
- d) To protect BHEL's interest for GST input tax credit, GST portion amount shall be withheld and the same shall be released only after confirmation from GST website/portal that such invoice has been declared in GSTR-1 return filed by vendor within the stipulated time for the relevant period and tax amount thereon has been paid by vendor to Govt. within the stipulated time for the relevant period as per GST Law.
- e) BHEL reserves the right to protect its interest against any loss on account of availability of GST credit. In case of any loss to BHEL on account of non-compliance by vendor, the same shall be to vendor's account. BHEL has a right to take necessary steps to protect its interest at the time of release of payment.
- f) GSTIN of BHEL will be provided to the vendor along with the work order.
- g) Any statutory changes as and when made applicable by the Government shall become applicable against documentary evidence.
- h) While making the payment, statutory deductions as applicable, shall be made by BHEL. Payment to the vendor will be subjected to TDS as per rules in force from time to time. The Tax Deduction at Source (TDS) shall be done as per the provisions of Income Tax Act & GST, as amended from time to time and a certificate to this effect shall be provided to the vendor by BHEL.
- Invoice submitted should be in the format as specified under GST Laws viz. all details as mentioned in Invoice Rules like GSTIN registration number, invoice number, quantity, rate, value, taxes with nomenclature – CGST, SGST, IGST mentioned separately, HSN (Harmonized System of Nomenclature) Code/SAC (Services Accounting Code) etc.
- j) All applicable taxes and duties other than mentioned in the contract document, shall be payable by the Service provider and the BHEL shall not entertain any claims whatsoever with respect to the same.
- k) Any Statutory variation in the rate of GST, taking place between the Bid Submission by service provider and Bid End Date, shall be to the Service provider's account. Hence, Service provider must ensure that any Statutory variation in the rate of GST till Bid End Date is duly incorporated in the bid submitted by the service provider. In case service provider fails to incorporate the same in bid, the service provider will not be eligible for claiming any change in price due to such Statutory variation.
- 1) Statutory variation in the rate of GST, taking place between the Bid end date and the original refixed delivery period, shall be to the BHEL's account. For claiming any change in price due to such Statutory variation, the service provider shall have to lodge claim before the BHEL providing documentary evidence of change in rate of GST taking place after Bid end



date and the date of supply within the original / refixed delivery period along with an undertaking that the provisions of anti-profiteering clause under GST Act have been complied with.

- m) No increase in price on account of statutory increase in the rate of GST taking place during the period of delivery period extension with liquidated Damages shall be admissible. Nevertheless, the BHEL shall be entitled to the benefit of any decrease in price on account of reduction in GST taking place during extended delivery period.
- n) The Bill Form / On-line invoice shall be generated by the Service provider which may interalia include the following confirmations from the Service provider:
 - i) Certified that the Goods and Services Tax (GST) charged on this Bill is not more than what is payable under the provision of the relevant Act or the Rules made there under.
 - ii) Certified that the goods on which GST has been charged have not been exempted under the GST Act or the rules made there under and the charges on account of GST on these goods are correct under the provisions of that Act or the Rules made there under.

iii) Certified that the Service provider is registered with above indicated GSTIN as dealer in the State where in their Billing address is located for the purpose of GST.

- iv) The service provider shall provide an undertaking that the provisions of antiprofiteering clause under GST Act have been complied with.
- o) Service provider shall comply with all the necessary statutory compliances, including but not limited to, GST registration in line with the extant provisions of GST Act, providing GST invoices or other documentation as per GST Law relating to the supply of Goods or Services, uploading the details of the invoices, payment of taxes, timely filing of valid statutory returns for the tax period in the GST portal, etc.
- p) In case the Input Tax Credit of GST is denied or demand is recovered from BHEL on account of any act/ omission of the Service provider in this regard, the Service provider shall be liable in respect of all claims of tax, penalty and / or interest, loss, damages, costs, expenses and liability that may arise due to such non-compliance. BHEL shall have the right to recover such amount from any payments due to the Service provider or from Performance Security, or any other legal recourse from the said Service provider. If any tax is required to be paid by the Service provider in pursuance of any demand from tax authorities, on account of Service provider's suppression of facts, fraud or wilful misstatement of facts while offering the products/service or submitting the bids, then the same shall not be passed on to BHEL through debit notes or Invoices or Supplementary Invoices and the service provider shall be solely liable for payment of the same.
- 19. <u>Warranty:</u> Warranty of all items should be 5 year or as provided by manufacturer, whichever is higher.
- 20. <u>Sample:</u> The bidder shall submit one or more than one sample marking them as A / B / C etc. and separate sealed cover for each of such alternatives the quoted item meeting all the technical specification enlisted in Annexure A. The sample shall reach the tender inviting authority before due date of bid submission indicated in the tender document & non-receipt of



sample before due date shall result in rejection of the bid. It is important to note that the bidder has to quote only one price in the price bid and there shall be no provision to quote for different items. Hence, this implies that the bidder shall agree to supply any of the "sample item" at their quoted rates as BHEL is free to choose any of the item offered.

For compliance to BHEL required features / properties (of item) as per Annexure-F, the bidder is to submit duly filled, signed & stamped copy of Annexure-F. Also, to support the same, documentary evidence like marketing brochures, leaflets, etc. may be submitted. Non-compliance to any of the listed required features / properties, shall lead to disqualification of bid. Non-submission of any of sample is liable for rejection on techno-commercial ground.

Note: The sample shall be properly packed along with details of items offered properly affixed on the packing box. Brochure/User Manual of the product mentioning the Technical specifications, warranty card, etc. shall be supplied within/on the packing box. Packing of sample shall be same as it will be supplied if the bidder gets selected and order is awarded to him/her. Technical data / brochure shall be furnished along with techno commercial bid for the item offered. Manufacturer's name, trade Mark or Patent No. if any, should be specified. The tender sample box shall be marked with permanent marker/sticker, with details, as Name of Supplier, Tender No., Brief Description of Item etc.

21. Service Centre: The bidder shall provide list of service centre of the OEM across the country.





Annexure-"C"

General Terms & Conditions

(1) TERMINATION OF CONTRACT:

BHEL reserves the right to terminate the contract any time if the execution of work is unsatisfactory or the schedule is not strictly adhered to.

(2) SELECTION PROCESS:

All bidders to note that the process for procurement of souvenir is primarily a 'sample' based procurement. This procurement shall involve selection based on various indeterminable parameters by a selection committee constituted by BHEL. The vendors would be required to submit their offers as under:

- a) The bidders would be required to submit their best samples as per tender terms and conditions within the stipulated price of ₹2000/- (all inclusive) and quote their best price for the same in a separate sealed cover. The successful bidder shall deliver the items at all the delivery locations mentioned elsewhere in this tender. No additional cost shall be paid by BHEL in this regard.
- b) Techno-Commercial evaluation of bids & samples shall be done as per tender terms and conditions.
- c) Selection of Item: All the items of techno-commercially qualified bidders would be displayed for the selection committee. The items would be displayed without disclosing the names of the vendors. The committee shall select any number of samples up to a maximum of five.
- d) Financial Evaluation: The price bid (Part II Bid) of only the samples selected by the selection committee would be opened and order would be awarded to the bidder having quoted the lowest price.
- e) The unsuccessful bidders shall collect their sample from tendering authority after award of order at their own risk and cost.

(3) EVALUATION:

- a) Bidder shall quote their prices in the prescribed format only i.e. Price Bid (Annexure-E) enclosed for items given therein. Price quoted in any other format shall not be considered for evaluation.
- b) Evaluation shall be done on the basis of "Grand Total (all inclusive)" based on rates quoted by bidder. Calculation of "Grand Total (all inclusive)" will be done by BHEL.
- c) In the course of evaluation, if more than one bidder happens to occupy L-1 status, effective L-1 will be decided by soliciting discounts from the respective L-1 bidders. In case more than one bidder happens to occupy the L-1 status even after soliciting discounts, the L-1 bidder shall be decided by a toss / draw of lots, in the presence of the respective L-1 bidder(s) or their representative(s). Ranking will be done accordingly. BHEL's decision in such situations shall be representative.



d) The evaluation currency for this tender shall be ₹. i.e. INR

(4) DISCREPANCIES & ADJUSTMENT OF ERRORS:

Price to be given in words as well as in figures without any correction / overwriting. Care should be taken to ensure that the amount in words and figures match with each other. In case of any mismatch between the prices quoted in figures and words, higher of the two will be considered for evaluation and lower of the two will be considered for placement of the order and no objection would be entertained by BHEL in this regard. Similarly, if there is an error in calculation, the calculation shall be corrected by BHEL. In such a case (i.e. in case of calculation error in the amount quoted by the bidder and corrected by BHEL), higher of the two will be considered for evaluation and lower will be considered for placement of the order and no objection would be entertained by BHEL in this regard.

(5) For this procurement, the local content to categorize a supplier as Class I local supplier/ Class II local Supplier/ Non-Local supplier and purchase preference to Class I local supplier, is as defined in Public Procurement (Preference to Make In India), Order2017 dated 04.06.2020 issued by DPIIT. In case of subsequent orders issued by the nodal ministry, changing the definition of local content for the items of the NIT, the same shall be applicable even if issued after issue of this NIT, but therefore opening of part-II bids against NIT.

(6) ARBITRATION:

a) Except as provided elsewhere in this contract, in case amicable settlement is not reached between the parties, in respect of any dispute or difference; arising out of the formation, breach termination, validity of execution of the Contract; or, the respective rights and liabilities of the parties; or, in relation to interpretation of any provision of the Contract; or in any manner touching upon the contract, then, either party may, by a notice in writing to the other party refer such dispute or difference to the sole arbitration of an arbitrator appointed by Head of the BHEL Unit/Region/Division issuing the Contract.

The Arbitrator shall pass a reasoned award and the award of the Arbitrator shall be final and binding upon the Parties.

Subject as aforesaid, the provisions of Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 (India) or statutory modifications or re-enactments thereof and the rules made thereunder and for the time being in force shall apply to the arbitration proceedings under this clause. The seat of arbitration shall be at New Delhi.

The cost of arbitration shall be borne as per the award of the Arbitrator.

Subject to the arbitration in terms of Clause above, the Courts at New Delhi shall have exclusive jurisdiction over any matter arising out of or in connection with this contract.

Notwithstanding the existence or any dispute or differences and /or reference for the arbitration, the Contractor shall proceed with and continue without hindrance the performance of its obligations under this contract with due diligence and expedition in a professional manner except where the Contract has been terminated by either party in terms of this Contract.

b) In case of order/contract on Public Sector Enterprises (PSE) or a Govt. Deptt., the following clause shall be applicable: -



In the event of any dispute or difference relating to the interpretation and application of the provisions of the Contract, such dispute or difference shall be referred to by either party for arbitration to the sole arbitrator in the department of public enterprises to be nominated by the secretary to the Government of India in-charge of the Department of Public Enterprises. Arbitration and Conciliation Act 1996 shall not be applicable to arbitration under this clause. The award of the arbitrator shall be binding upon the parties to the dispute, provided, however, any party aggrieved by such award may make a further reference for setting aside or revision of the award to the Law secretary, Deptt. Of Legal Affairs, Ministry of Law & Justice, Government of India. Upon such reference the dispute shall be decided by the Law Secretary or the Special Secretary or Additional Secretary when so authorized by the Law Secretary, whose decision shall bind the parties hereto finally and conclusively. The parties in the dispute will bear equally the cost of arbitration as intimated by the arbitrator

(7) JURISDICTION:

Indian laws both substantive and procedural, for the time being in force, including modifications thereto, shall govern the Contract including Arbitration proceedings. Notwithstanding any other court or courts having jurisdiction to decide the question(s) forming the subject matter of the reference if the same had been the subject matter of a suit, any and all actions and proceedings arising out of or relative to the contract shall lie only in the court of competent civil jurisdiction in this behalf at DELHI and only the said Court(s) shall have jurisdiction to entertain and try any such action(s) and/or proceeding(s) to the exclusion of all other Courts.

- (8) BREACH OF CONTRACT AND TERMINATION: Following cases shall be considered as terms of breach of contract:
 - a) Contractor/ supplier's poor progress of the work vis-à-vis execution timeline as stipulated in the Contract, backlog attributable to contractor/ supplier including unexecuted portion of work/ supply does not appear to be executable within balance available period (#) considering its performance of execution.
 - b) Withdrawal from or abandonment of the work by contractor before completion of the work as per contract.
 - c) Non-completion of work/ Non-supply by the Contractor/ supplier within scheduled completion/delivery period as per Contract or as extended from time to time, for the reasons attributable to the contractor/ supplier.
 - d) Termination of Contract on account of any other reason (s) attributable to Contractor/
 Supplier. If at any time the service provider defaults in proceeding with the work with due
 diligence and continues to do so or commit any default in complying any of the tender terms
 and conditions even after the notice in writing is given, BHEL may, without prejudice to any
 other right to remedy which shall have accrued or shall accrue thereafter to BHEL, to
 terminate the contract by giving 15 days' notice in writing. The notice will be deemed to have
 Ne been served as and when sent to the address given in the tender.



- e) Assignment, transfer, subletting of Contract without BHEL's written permission resulting in termination of Contract or part thereof by BHEL. The Contractor is solely responsible to BHEL for the work awarded to him.
- f) Non-compliance to any contractual condition or any other default attributable to Contractor/ Supplier.

Recovery in case of Breach of Contract

In case of breach of contract, 10% of the contract value shall be recovered from the contractor. The recovery shall be made from Security Deposit (if any)/ Retention Money (if any)/ available bills in the unit pacing P.O. In case 10% amount is not recovered from these instruments the balance amount shall be recovered from the bills available in any of the BHEL unit(s)/Division(s).

Further, levy of liquidated damages, debarment, termination, de-scoping, short-closure etc., shall be applied as per provisions of contract
