17.0	Price Evaluation Criteria	The price evaluation shall be done based on the grand total price. Bidders to quote for the complete scope of work as per the tender specifications. The price bids shall be evaluated for the complete scope of work as per tender specifications based on total cost to BHEL. Price evaluation shall be on the total price (all-inclusive incl. freight) excluding Goods & Service Tax (GST), i.e. Basic Price (supply of goods & services), as per price basis mentioned in SCC + + Freight Charges (as applicable) + Loading (if any) + Cost of withdrawal (if any) + Power consumption loading (if any) + Any other taxes and duties (if any) excluding Goods & Service Tax (GST). The evaluation currency for this tender shall be INR. The quoted basic price shall be inclusive of packing & forwarding charges, freight charges, all taxes & duties except Goods & Service Tax (GST). Clause no. 19.1 of Instructions to bidders of General Conditions of Contract (GCC, Rev.01) is not applicable for this tender.
